Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL has grown from what started as a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In its 94th year with 68 clubs, 241 teams and over 10,000 registered players, the WAAFL caters for players as young as 16 years to provide a quality high standard competition whilst accommodating considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

For many players the WAAFL provides a superior football competition for those not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study commitments, career commitments or simply a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The WAAFL is also the beginning point for many well-known WAFL and AFL personnel, starting their careers in amateur football and becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

High profile players and our Colts League name-sakes include Phil Scott, Drew Banfield, Laurie Keene, Brett Jones and two-time Sandover Medallist Ian Dargie all who played for the West Coast Eagles.

Other household names, and current AFL players, include Tendai Mzungu (Fremantle) and Nick Kommer (Essendon)

On Monday August 31 the WAAFL hosted the sixth annual Hall of Champions Dinner. The Hall of Champions honours those individuals who have made long, significant and commendable contributions to the WAAFL, to help make it the strong and respected sporting body that it is today. This year the WAAFL inducted four new members into the Hall of Champions.

Brad Dunn began his involvement in the WAAFL with the Mt Lawley Amateur Football Club in 1979. Dunn made a mark from his first season in the WAAFL. He was runner up in Mt Lawley's A-Colts fairest and best in 1979. The following year he was selected in the WAAFL State Colts Team and won his first of nine premierships as a player in A Colts. In 1982, Dunn began his state representative career. He would go on to represent WA seven times in the WAAFL State Team, and was senior coach in 2000 and 2001. He was selected as an All Australian Amateur in 1985, 1986 and 1988.

He also coached Mt Lawley's A Colts to three grand finals and a premiership in 1984 as well as coaching Mt Lawley's B Grade to a premiership in 1997. He finished his career playing 220 games for Mt Lawley and being awarded club Life Membership in 1989 and induction into Mt Lawley's Hall of Fame in 2013. He is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a Champion.

Keith Slater is recognized as one of WA's best sportsmen, he commenced his senior football career in 1954 with the Midland Junction Amateurs before being recruited by Swan Districts Football Club the following season.

Slater went on to play 166 games for Swan Districts and won the club's fairest and best on three occasions in 1956, 1957 and 1960. During the same period, he also played test cricket for Australia. He represented WA in 21 matches in which he captained three. In 1964 after 166 games with Swans Districts, Slater accepted the role as Captain/Coach at Subiaco Football Club. He played a further 52 WAFL games with Subiaco. He ended his career back at Swan Districts in 1967 to complete a football career totalling 239 games and an impressive 257 career goals.

Whilst thoroughly immersed in football, Slater was also a fantastic cricketer for WA. His cricket career spanned 13 years where he accumulated 2198 first-class runs and took 140 wickets. Slater is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a High Achiever.

David Perry began his WAAFL playing career with

the North Beach Amateur Football Club in 1985. His 93 games for North Beach between 1985 and 1990 achieved many team and personal accolades at the highest level of amateur football in Australia.

In 1986, Perry was selected in the WAAFL State Team to play in the Australian Amateur Football Council Carnival in Melbourne. He was recognised as WA's best player of the carnival and selected in the All Australian Amateur Team. Later that year, he was awarded North Beach's Aitken Medal for Champion Footballer and runner-up in the club's A Grade fairest and best.

He won the C. J. Jamieson Medal in 1986 and 1989. He was part of North Beach's first A Grade Premiership in 1989 and won another premiership in 1990. In 1988 he was awarded North Beach's Aitken Medal for the third consecutive year and won his club's A Grade fairest and best for the second time. He is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a Champion.

Neil Donaldson became involved in amateur football with the UWA Football Club in 1954. First as club Secretary with University before being elected as the club's Vice President. He was elected University Club President in 1963 and coached the club's inaugural C Grade team. He held the Presidential role until 1965 and he coached the club's new D Grade team from 1964 to 1968.

In 1968, Neil's 252 games and tireless efforts for University were acknowledged as he was honoured Life Membership of the UWA Football Club. Donaldson biggest legacy will be remembered as coach and mentor. He led University teams to seven consecutive grand finals, winning premierships in 1969, 1970, 1971, 1974 and 1976. In 1975, he took a year off from coaching, and was an A Grade selector and Team Manager.

The WAAFL Life Membership was bestowed on Donaldson in 1972. His efforts continued to be recognised as he was awarded National Football Council Merit Award for services to amateur football in 1990. In 2000, Neil was awarded an Australian Sports Medal from the Australian Government, and in 2003 was awarded AFL Recognition to Volunteers of Australian football. In 2012, Donaldson was honoured with WA Football Commission Life Membership.

In 2014, he was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) for his service to Australian Rules football in WA. He is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a Champion.

WAAFL INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

WAAFL Integrated Football has enjoyed a watershed year in 2015 with many highlights and achievements that have assisted this wonderful community program in becoming one of the leading recreational pursuits in Perth for people with intellectual disabilities.

The In Season Program this year featured seven teams, Warnbro, High Wycombe, Kingsway, Coolbinia West Perth, Fremantle CBC Gold and Fremantle CBC Green.

Fixtures were increased to eleven games per team with High Wycombe playing twelve, the season began in line with WAAFL Grades on April 11 with the final home and away fixture played on Saturday 22nd August.

All games are played with a focus on participation for all players adopting AFL Laws together with some modifications i.e. players may only bounce the ball twice before they must dispose. The most pleasing is the continued development of all players and the spirit of good sportsmanship that exists within all the teams.

A major milestone was achieved in 2015 with the inaugural WA State Integrated Team participating at AFL National Inclusion Carnival in Melbourne in August. The WAAFL are grateful to have received fantastic financial support from Disability Services Commission, National Disability Insurance Agency and Redimed which enabled the trip to occur.

Additionally Inclusion WA and AUSRAPID for their expertise in the area of Disability Classification ensuring all players met the guidelines for selection at a National Event.

Led by Program Co-Ordinator Greg Gilbee and inaugural WA State Coach Jamie Wynne, the opportunity to send a representative team to Victoria provided sixteen players with a unique life time experience that many could only dream about.

The week long carnival of football was played between all States on former VFL Grounds culminating with an AFL9s exhibition match on the MCG at Half time of Carlton v Collingwood game before finishing with a final series play off at Punt Road Richmond on Sunday 9th August.

The WA Team were fantastic wearing the Black Swan proudly on their jumpers and giving their all in every match. The Team won their first game against Tasmania then defeated Queensland in the playoff for fifth place.



In what has become an eagerly anticipated event is the AFL Curtain Raiser at Domain Stadium generously supported by West Coast Eagles Football Club. This year the event was held prior to West Coast Eagles v Carlton match on April 10, once again all teams were represented, we took a further step this year in classifying players to provide an evenness between the two teams producing a closer and more competitive game.

Count Me In Round a joint initiative of the Disability Services Commission and the WAFU celebrating Inclusion for all provided opportunities for several WAAFL Integrated Teams to participate in half time activities at a number of WAFU matches.

The Count Me In Round coincided with the WA State Integrated Team's final lead up to the AFL National Inclusion Carnival enabling terrific media opportunities with Channel 7's Today Tonight Program, The West Australian Newspaper and a visit to the West Coast Eagles Football Club who once again demonstrated their support of WAAFL Integrated Football including a visit by star player Mitch Brown to a State Training session.

The WAAFL Integrated Grand Final was played on Sunday September 6th at Yokine Reserve, Coolbinia West Perth won the premiership over Fremantle CBC Green.

Recognition must be given to all our clubs, coaches and passionate volunteers who give of their time unconditionally. We would also like to extend thanks to the WAFU district staff, Disability Services Commission, the Department of Education and Inclusion WA who play key roles in ensuring Integrated Football remains vibrant, enjoyable and a sport that encourages people with intellectual disabilities to participate.

A FORTUNATE 1000 FOR ROD CLARKE

When Rod Clarke answered an advertisement calling for WAAFL Field Umpires in 1987, little did he know that his phone call would be the start of a journey that has led him to achieve one of the rare milestones in Australian Rules football.

On July 25, Rod umpired his 1000th game of community football, officiating in the WAAFL B-grade game between Hamersley Carine and Swan Athletic.

Rod developed an attachment to Australian rules football in the mid 60's when he played for North Innaloo and Karrinyup Junior Football Clubs, before coaching Tuart Hill under 12's in 1976, a team that had Darren Bewick (Essendon League player) running around in.

Rod returned to football in 1984 as a ruckman for two seasons with Girrawheen FC, before becoming an umpire in 1987 to combine his love, fitness and understanding of football into one package.

Back then WAAFL umpires had no official uniform, but they had a code of dress, white shirt, wrist bands and shorts and black socks. The "ACME Thunderer" whistle was the tool of the trade.

From 1987-1994 Rod umpired for eight seasons as a single field umpire in the WAAFL. In those days the field umpire was the sole WAAFL representative on game day, which meant not only was he an umpire but he was the WAAFL's liaison officer, problem solver and game day trouble shooter as well.

By the end of 1994 Rod had umpired 175 WAAFL games, predominantly as a single umpire and his body was telling him it was ready for retirement. In 1995 the WAAFL announced that all panel appointed games would be umpired under a two umpire system which was the good fortune that saved Rod from retirement.

Rod continued as a field umpire in the two umpire system until the end of the 2006 season. After 20 seasons of field umpiring, Rod had finally hit "the wall" of running and was satisfied that his panel umpiring appointments of 516 field, plus 20 boundary appearances would be his final tally of games.

Rod was approached in 2007 and accepted a role with the WA Football Commission to manage the Level 1 accreditation of community field umpires. Rod



went to preseason training at the start of the 2007 season and it was then that Rod decided he wanted to become a goal umpire.

The following day Rod rang Terry Tomlinson and advised him of his decision and to seek his endorsement to learn to become a panel goal umpire. Terry assisted Rod to learn the craft of goal umpiring and with persistence and support has been, and still is, a steady influence that has seen Rod achieve this impressive milestone.

Rod sees his role in umpiring over the years as providing a vital community service to ensure the club leadership team, the players and spectators are provided with a competent, fair and honest interpretation of the rules of this great game they play.

He has sought extended self-improvement for providing this service by observing WAFL and AFL umpires in action and completing four umpiring education courses. Rod considers that each moment in a game presents itself as a new challenge, and it is the satisfactory achievement of each challenge that motivates him to want to continue umpiring for as long as he can.

Above all else Rod says it is the people who are part of Australia's national sport that has kept him in the game. He takes solace from the historic Aussie Rules Motto; "A game for the people by the people".

The "Old Hand" Terry Tomlinson was appointed in 2015 as Senior WAAFL Goal Umpires Coach. With Peter Jeffers by his side they prove to be a formidable force in the Goal Umpire Coaching scene. With their ability to get goal umpires to work at the highest level, this has proved to be invaluable to the WAFL Goal Umpiring Department as they have been able to supply some of our up and coming talented umpires
