Rule Exemptions

AFL rules apply except;

Players are required to wait for the flags to be waved before the ball is kicked back in

No free kick from a deliberate rush behind

Umpires will not be applying the new 10m rule in junior football

Deliberate Out of Bounds will be applied at the discretion of the Umpire

3rd Man up rule will apply,

- Players are not required to nominate
- If a “3rd” player gets involved in the contest, a free kick will be awarded

Rule Exemptions

As per the AFL Laws of the Game, if a player swears within a game (and is overheard by an umpire) then a free kick will be paid against the player as a means of positively addressing the game day environment with Junior Football. Under the AFL Laws of the Game there is provision for this to occur under:

15.10 FREE KICKS – GENERALLY

15.10.1 – A free kick shall be awarded against a Player or a Team where the field Umpire is of the opinion that:

(d) a free kick to be awarded against a Player who uses abusive, insulting, threatening or obscene language and/or gesture.

8.3 - The JCC Executive may re-grade sides to ensure a balanced competition. This will be conducted at the discretion of the JCC Executive

Rule Exemptions

22.6 - Both the Home team and the Away team are responsible for providing an interchange steward (youth only). Only one steward per team is permitted inside the interchange area where they must remain for the duration of the match. In the event an interchange steward is not in attendance the appointed timekeeper/s will be responsible for the recording of the send-off details and make notes of any issues that would usually be the responsibility of the interchange steward

22.12 - Each team is permitted to have a maximum of three coaches (one head coach and two assistant coaches) inside the Coaches box.

45.9 - Only the Captain or Team Manager from either team can approach an umpire during the breaks in a match. The Captain or Team Manager **cannot** question decisions, interpretations or question the free kick count. If the team, the coach or the club has questions about these elements of umpiring then they can be followed up with the District Umpire Manager during the week. Sanctions can be applied at the discretion of the JCC if there is a breach of this.

Rule Exemptions

Super 15 Rule exemptions;

Game times will be the same as per the 18-a-side competition

Ground size will be the same as per the 18-a-side competition

When 10 or less players are in attendance, this will constitute a forfeit of the team with the aforementioned amount of players

Umpires have been instructed to apply the following to the player positions (5 forwards, 5 backs & 5 midfielders - 3 inside square & 2 wings)

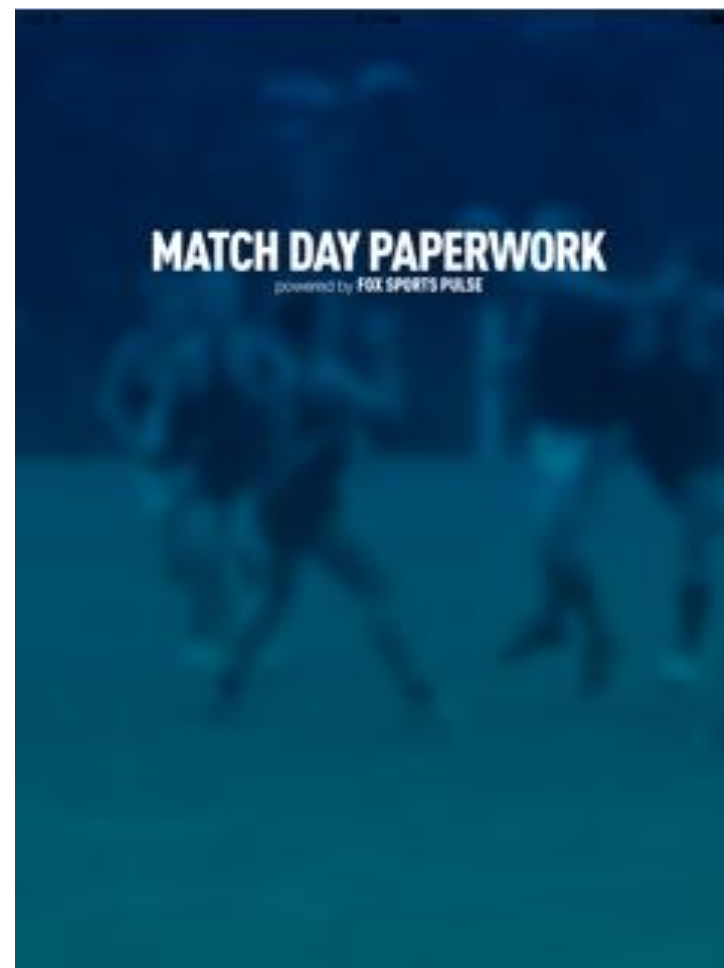

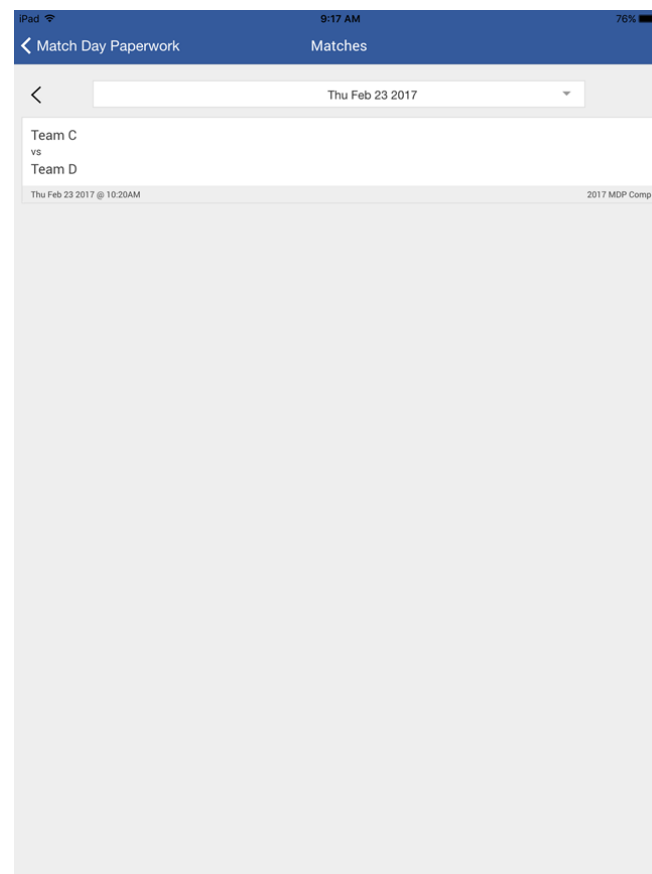
Match Day Paperwork App

- Team Manager to download the app if they have an iPhone/android
- Search “Match Day Paperwork” in iTunes store
- Home team managers to ensure that Umpires have submitted the Umpire Report after every match
- If Umpires do not have a device to submit that report on, home team managers to provide them with a phone/iPad/tablet to borrow



Match Day Paperwork App

- Junior clubs are required to provide **internet** and an **electronic device** (Ipad, Iphone, Tablet) so that umpires can input the information
- Team Managers are responsible for making sure that Umpires have submitted relevant information
- **HOME** club is required to retain scorecards



Team Manager Procedures

- Prior to Game
 - Team Sheet – to be loaded on the IPAD.
 - JLT Match Day Check List
 - Score Cards (2 x Goal umpires and 1 x independent scorer)
 - Boundary Umpire / Goal Umpire / Time Keeper
- Start of Game
 - IPADs made ready for the Interchange Stewards
- End of Game
 - Team Managers to hand IPADs to the umpires ASAP so they can complete their app.
 - Email Interchange data to mpower@wafc.com.au within an hour of the game finishing
 - No cash payments to the Field Umpires

Central Conference Tribunal

- All tribunal hearings will be convened by the “Central Conference Tribunal”
- Club/s and players will be informed by 12pm Monday
- All hearings will be held @ the Inglewood Bowls club on Wednesday night from 6pm

Umpire Appointments

- Yr 10, 11 & 12 games will be the priority to be serviced by the Umpire departments
- Umpire appointments will be made with the following factors in mind; district the games are played, umpire experience, ability to service the most games across all grades
- All umpires will be paid through direct debit (fortnightly)

Fixtures & Results

- Will be published on district websites
- Please make sure to review fixtures weekly
- All age groups will be placed under “Central Conference” link on Fox Sports Pulse

Fairest & Best Awards

- Joint awards night/s will be held at the end of the season to acknowledge the winners across the 11 conference competitions

Interchange App – by Shedworx

- Clubs will be required to have access to an Ipad on match day (**Note: the Interchange App is only compatible to Ipad's and requires version iOS 9, which is the latest version)
- Masterclass to include
 - How to upload team sheets from FSP to Interchange App
 - Match Day functionality (players ON/OFF)
 - Dual Screen capacity (optional)
 - Yellow / Red cards
 - Injuries
