BRIEF HISTORY & OUTLINE

WAAFL 1922 – 2008

- Formed in 1922 with five teams as the Mercantile Football Association
- 1924 – name changed to the Perth Districts Football Association
- 1929 – name changed to the W.A Amateur Football Association
- 1971 – name changed to the W.A Amateur Football League (Inc.)

In 2008 the WAAFL is in its 87th year of operation. With 44 clubs, 167 teams and over 10,960 registered players, the WAAFL has grown from a four team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

The WAAFL is an important part of the metropolitan based community football with the stringent amateur standard and quality competition.

The WAAFL is a member of the Community Football Council with other members including the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, West Australian Football Association, WA Masters Football, Women's Football League and the Mercantile Football Association.

VALUE OF AMATEUR FOOTBALL

The WAAFL provides organised football on Saturday where anyone whatever ability, can participate or contribute to the football industry.

The system in place allows players to play in senior football at any level they are capable of achieving. Colts (U19) learn the fundamentals of amateur football and its responsibilities after graduating from junior ranks. While the WAAFL also provides a quality high standard competition for those players not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL (second tier state competition) training due to study or career commitments or simply a lifestyle that considers football a recreational pursuit, it is, however, in a position to bridge the gap between amateur football and the champions of tomorrow.

Many well known WAFL and AFL personnel began their careers in the WAAFL. Former West Coast Eagles and Hawthorn coach Ken Judge began his coaching career at an A Grade amateur club. Former Dockers coach Gerard Neesham played several seasons of amateur football and played at state amateur level.

Other high profile players starting in the Amateurs include Troy Wilson (West Coast Eagles), Gary Buckenara (Hawthorn), Shane Parker (Fremantle), Simon Beasley (Western Bulldogs), Sandover Medallists Ian Dargie, Alistair Pickett and Shane Beros.

Former Amateur players who have gone on to be senior administrators include former Chairman of the WA Football Commission Dr Peter Tannock, current WA Football Commission Chairman Dr Neale Fong (a triple A Grade Fairest & Best medallist with the WAAFL), current Chairman of Sydney Swans Richard Colless and former West Coast Chairman and AFL Commissioner Terry O'Connor are just a few who have gone on to contribute to football at a higher level.

The WAAFL is continuing to focus on the future and how the League uses its leadership and resources to set new standards of excellence and relevance for its member clubs and various committees. The League's Strategic Plan has been successful in stabilising the League's financial position and the establishment of a Club "culture" that will ensure a long and viable competition.

The future strategic plan will build on this strong foundation and ensure that the WAAFL continues as the main contributor to Community football.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT



The Western Australian Amateur Football League concludes another successful season of community football with teams from all parts of the metropolitan areas from north with Quinns Districts, South to Warnbro and East to Swan View. The League continues to grow with forty-four clubs fielding one hundred and sixty seven teams in our League's 87th season.

Amateur Football continues to play an important role in developing and encouraging participation either as a player, official or administrator of our unique Australian game. Clubs provide facilities and coaches along with other activities in their local areas at minimal cost enabling all participants, administrators and followers to enjoy their sport.

Many thanks to all those associated with the forty-four clubs. Your work and energy has continued to enhance the teams, our League and your communities, making sure we remain a strong and vibrant part of grass roots football. Club Presidents (and their committees) are unheralded volunteer community leaders and are important ingredients in providing a great public service that is often forgotten by local residents when small issues arise.

Running of the WAAFL is made easier with the WA Football Commission continuing to give the League invaluable support in crucial administration and financial areas, allowing us to operate more efficiently. Their assistance has given the Board of the WAAFL full support in becoming the leaders and driving force in community football. We appreciate their confidence that has allowed us to provide all clubs with programs to improve their knowledge and make their roles easier. Financial assistance has also allowed key staff members to attend both local and interstate related administrative courses to further develop their experience and skills and enhance the standing of the League within the football family.

The valuable partnership with Fosters Australia continues to provide product and financial support for the League and member clubs. It has been a long term partnership which we appreciate and look forward to their continued support.

The ongoing success and growth of the League's four colts divisions and Under 23 State Representative program would not be possible without the support of the West Coast Eagles Football Club. Their provision of a corporate box at home games has enabled us to further support and retain our other valuable sponsors.

Park Auto Centre, Cougar Sportswear, Sherrin, Toyota Auto Parts, Keystart Homes, Office National Booragoon and West Coast Surgical and Medical Supplies, are other partners whose support is greatly appreciated by the WAAFL.

Congratulations to the winners of WAAFL Fairest & Best medals in all grades, along with the two senior grade goal kicking awards. Congratulations also to all involved with our representative football programs, particularly the successful West Coast Eagles State Amateur U/23s Team and U/19s players, coaches Wayne Langborne and Andy Leinasars, and the support staff. Finally congratulations to the five WAAFL players who were chosen to represent Australia with the U/23 All Australian Amateur International Rules team that toured Ireland in October.

All members of the elected Board actively give their time in a volunteer capacity like all fellow club officials. They direct and formulate policies and the direction of the WAAFL in a truly ethical way, bearing in mind what would be best for the League at all times and all levels and the affect it would have on all shareholders. As in previous years Vice President Trevor Howard, Board members Brett Fullarton, Bill Armstrong, Graham Hill, Deborah Pett, Peter Grosser, Bruce Wainwright, Mark Herron and Milton Saunders continue to use their wide ranging management and business expertise as well as a great understanding of amateur football to serve all clubs fairly.

The office staff under CEO Brendan Cullinan, are to be commended for their work in serving the clubs by providing a professionally organised competition for all levels of ability. The efforts of Operations Manager Geoff Palmer, Events & Finance Natalie Couch, Operations & Tribunal Coordinator Matt Henson in conjunction with Operations Assistants Melanie Thomas, Dylan Mellon and Administration Assistants Gemma Frediani and Sarah White have continued to enhance the image of the League both within and outside our football fraternity.

Through professional planning and astute advice and support from sponsors the financial position of the WAAFL is a healthy one. It was only in 2002 that the League found it was in a very difficult position. Steps undertaken then, along with actively seeking greater sponsorship, additional funding, working closely with clubs and policy changes have brought about the dramatic positive financial situation, whereby now the Board is in a position to return dividends back to the clubs, via programs and incentives through the Quality Clubs Environment Program.

Many personnel contribute and make up numerous sub-committees, once again in voluntary roles. P & D Tribunals, Investigative Tribunals, media, State Football Committee, Re-instatement Committee, Community Football Council and District Development Councils, give unlimited hours for the support of our league.

Our umpire's panel under the coaching direction of Terry Battle, Terry Tomlinson and Warren Beckwith have made a great impact on recruiting an increasing number of young umpires into Community Football. They have worked extremely hard since the pre-season when there was acute shortage of competent umpires.

The WAAFL is a major force in the Community Football Council, in partnership with the Sunday Football League, Peel Football League, Masters Football, WA Womens Football League, Western Australian Football Association and the Mercantile Football Association. With the Future Directions report being partially implemented by the various leagues, there are many interesting days ahead, all pointing to the better provision of services and viability of community football at our level.

The League would not continue to grow and be seen as a respected community organisation without the hard work by many hundreds of volunteers. To everyone who has contributed to the success of another season, we thank you and look forward to working with you again next season.

President's Highlights during 2008 include:

- The appointment of the WAAFL first woman Board Member, Deborah Pett.
- Our West Coast Eagles U/23 State Amateur Team ventured to Tasmania for the first time since 1988 to play a Northern Tasmanian team. The WA team was successful 11.10 (76) to 9.11 (65) in Davenport.
- The West Coast Eagles gave support to U/19 Representative Team for the first time.
- The continued growth of our colts (19's and under) competition with 6 new team. Several existing clubs fielded a second colts team for the first time.
- Five players were selected from the West Coast Eagles State U/23's to tour Ireland with the All Australian Amateur team in October with Coach Wayne Langborne appointed as assistant coach and WAAFL "Umpire of the Year" Colin Gray appointed tour umpire. Peter Grosser was again in the role of Team Manager.
- At the end of the 2007 season Graham Hill was appointed to the WAAFL Board with expertise in IT and Finance.
- The largest number of invited guests, sponsors, club officials, players and supporters of the WAAFL attended the League's Annual Presentations and Awards evening at the Perth Convention Exhibition Centre.
- Two of the traditional Amateur clubs, North Fremantle and University produced historical books. North Fremantle released "Hell for Leather – The Forgotten Footballers of North Fremantle" while University released their club history entitled "The Green Machine".
- The 2008 season marked the 60th anniversary of the introduction of the send off rule in the WAAFL.
- North Beach Amateur Football Club under Coach Bill Duckworth won their 5th 'A' Grade Premiership to create a new record for successive premierships. Bill has now coach 8 titles in 10 seasons.
- Continued implementation of the Quality Club Environment program further enhancing the management of all clubs.

CEO'S REPORT



The continued growth of the Western Australian Amateur Football League this year further endorses the WAAFL as the premier senior community competition in the state. With the Kingsway Football Club joining the competition, the WAAFL now has forty-four clubs fielding 167 teams in seven senior and four colts' grades.

Following feedback from the clubs last year, the lower grades were re-structured to endeavor to create more equitable competitions. This resulted in the reformation of E grade with league and reserves, with two new grades, F and G. Anecdotal feedback from the clubs noted that this re-structuring was successful and allowed the inclusion of additional teams in the lower grades.

The sustainability of all clubs via good management continues to be a major aim of the Board. The continued implementation of the Quality Club Environment Program highlights management issues that each club must address in order to create enjoyable environments both on and off field on match days.

The administration of player details and match day paperwork was enhanced this season with the successful implementation of the Sporting Pulse on-line management system. All clubs should be congratulated for the positive manner in which they embraced this new initiative. Further advancements to the program will ensure that it continues to meet the needs of the League while being user-friendly for the volunteers.

The quantity and quality of umpires continues to be a major concern for all levels of amateur football. This season the League drafted a Memorandum of Understanding with the Senior Community Umpires Association with the aim of supporting the Association to attract and retain more quality umpires. The management of clubs umpires requires further attention with strategies to be implemented as part of this year's strategic review.

The direction of senior community football continues to evolve as the Community Football Council continues to implement the recommendations of the Future Directions Report. The rationalization of existing competition structures on Saturday and Sunday being managed by an appropriate administration and governance model are key outcomes that the CFC is on the verge of completing.

The Board is currently undertaking a review of its strategic priorities and key policy and operational issues. Prudent financial management has resulted in the League being in a strong financial position. The Board intends to use this financial strength to further enhance services to the clubs and assist the volunteers to continue improving the quality of the competitions while easing the administration burden.

Corporate support continues to be strong for the League. Major partners, Fosters Australia and the West Coast Eagles Football Club have maintained their tremendous support for amateur football. Sherrin, Park Auto Centre, Toyota Genuine Parts and Service, Cougar Sportswear, Office National Booragoon and West Coast Surgical and Medical Supplies are gratefully acknowledged for their support of the WAAFL.

Of course the successes attained this year would not be possible without the many fantastic people involved with amateur football. John Davies as President continues to provide great leadership in challenging the Board to seek continual improvement in all areas. The community football staff, Geoff Palmer, Matt Henson, Natalie Couch, Dylan Mellon, Sarah White and Gemma Frediani, continues to provide great support to the clubs in a friendly, efficient manner. And to the many hundreds of volunteers at the clubs, particularly the Presidents who provided great leadership, I thank you for your support and look forward to working closely with you again next season as the League enters another exciting era of community football.

UMPIRING REPORT



Congratulations to all players, coaches, volunteers and umpires for their Senior Community Football participation and achievements in season 2008.

I am pleased to advise that there has been approximately 32 Field Umpires, 52 Boundary Umpires and 8 Goal Umpires being Panel appointed umpire recruits to Senior Community in season 2008 that were not part of the 2007 umpire panel.

These recruited umpires together with existing umpires provided sound service throughout the season. Whilst being involved in the game at close quarters, the umpires have benefited through their friendships made, improved levels of fitness and the ongoing personal growth opportunities from their involvement in umpiring.

Umpire Colin Gray through his achievements has experienced a particularly exciting year with the opportunity to travel both interstate and to Ireland to umpire representative matches.

On a disappointing note, despite three successive years of strong recruitment of umpire numbers the challenge of having enough umpires remains. As the game grows, this challenge will continue.

Retention of umpires through appropriate recognition and sound coaching is the way forward, together with appropriate game environment measures that make the experience enjoyable for all concerned.

The West Australian Football Commission decision to create the new position of a full time State Umpire Coach a few seasons ago is paying dividends. Darryl Sinclair has lead Senior Community Umpire Coaching staff with coaching practices adopted at the WAFL umpiring level, and has also directly conducted a number of coaching sessions with coach and club appointed umpires in 2008.

The tireless efforts of the Senior Community Umpire Coaches including Terry Battle (Field Coach) John Lawniczak (Assistant Field) Terry Tomlinson (Goal Coach) Warren Beckwith (Boundary) Simon Stewart (Fitness) and all other match day coaches and support staff is to be applauded. Lead by Terry Battle with the able assistance of Sav Borg and Jason Tyrrell (District

2008 AAFC IRELAND TOUR

Australia has come away from the inaugural AAFC International Rules series with a record of three wins and one loss. The Australia team which consisted of five Western Australian players (Steven Wood, Simon Jones, Scott Horsburgh, Jarrad Heller and Captain Brad Wedgwood) defeated Bishop Town and the National University of Ireland before finally succumbing to County Champions Donaghmore Ashbourne by five points. The series concluded in the capital of Ireland (Dublin) with Australia taking on and defeating the DCU Academy, consisting of the best Irish youth players in the country.

The Australian's were sure not to pass up on this once in a life time opportunity, beginning the tour with a day of shopping and sight-seeing, taking all that Cork had to offer before their first match against Bishoptown. The series got off to a great start, the crowd was one of the best of the series, the contest was hard fought and Australia – Led by Captain Brad Wedgwood – came out the victors by 10 points. Up front Wedgwood starred with two unders (6 points) and two overs (3 points each), Scott Horsburgh chipped in with two overs himself, and down back a solid game by Collegians star Jarrad Heller showcased the talent that W.A.A.F.L had to offer.

The weather tried it's best to help the National University of Ireland over the line in match two of the series, with rain coming down so hard in the days prior to the match that no point posts could be erected making it possible to score only unders and overs. The picturesque ground played host to a frantic and high intensity match, both teams were struggling with their skills due to the constant pressure and blustery conditions. Scott Horsburgh showcased why he was selected, again, putting a stamp of class on the game that led an Australian rally late in the second quarter.

The second half was much like the first with both teams missing scoring chances and a strong breeze wreaking havoc with the ball. It was again West Australian star Scott Horsburgh putting the ball over creating a run of goals to Australia including another to the Wesley Curtin gun. Coach Bob Cross gave the Australian team license to be creative in the last quarter, encouraging them to run the ball in for scoring opportunities. Bob Cross' advice was taken onboard, Australia missed some chances through skill error but piled on one over and three unders to take the second match by 42 points.

The third match of the series pitted Australia against a star-studded side in Donaghmore Ashbourne, the Meath County Champions. Three all Ireland stars (That play the AFL in the International Rules) donned the jumper for Donaghmore Ashbourne and their skill, pace and experience was clearly evident early on. Both

teams struggled with the pace of the first half and coaches rang in multiple changes as the players began to tire. The perfect conditions continued for the second half and Ireland kept on running the tired Australian's off their legs. A mark and over to University gun Simon Jones kept Australia in it but so many matches in such a short time took its toll on the Australian bodies, going into the last break 12 points down. Jones again marked strongly and converted an over as Australia tried to claw back the lead, but Ireland pushed numbers back and ran out eventual winners over a very gallant and brave Australian side.

Australia took on the DCU Academy in the heart of Ireland, Dublin. In wet, windy and heavy under foot conditions, the DCU Academy gave the sore and tired Australian side a hard fought match despite missing players due to inter-county finals. The AAFC side controlled most of the first half, Horsburgh again potent up front and Captain Brad Wedgwood kicking a classic under and leading Australia into the halftime break by 15 points. With the breeze blowing at their back Australia took control in the third, 6 over's and another under took the lead out to 19 points heading into the last quarter of an excellent tour. With a sense of pride the aim of the quarter was to enjoy it, the DCU academy played with an extra player and despite bringing the margin down, it was never in doubt. University and Australian representative Simon Jones scored a over to cap off a wonderful tour for not only the Australian, but Western Australian boys as well as they took the final match by 21 points.

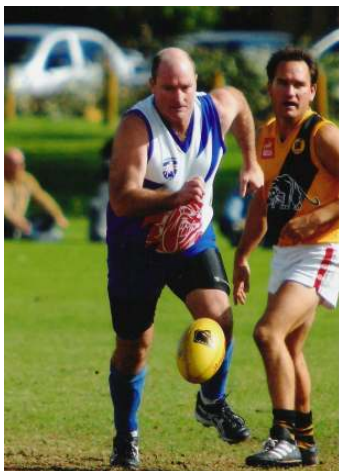

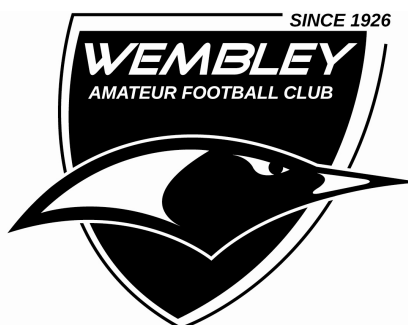
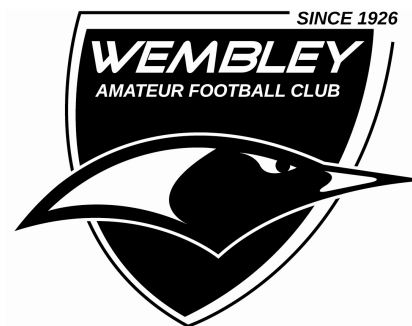
