

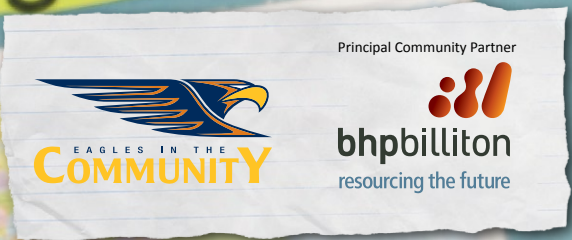

Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL has grown from what started as a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In its 93rd year with 66 clubs, 235 teams and over 10,000 registered players, the WAAFL caters for players as young as 16 years to provide a quality high standard competition whilst accommodating considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

For many players the WAAFL provides a superior football competition for those not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study commitments, career commitments or simply

a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The WAAFL is also the beginning point for many well-known WAFL and AFL personnel, starting their careers in amateur football and becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

High profile players and our Colts League name-sakes include Phil Scott, Drew Banfield, Laurie Keene, Brett Jones and two-time Sandover Medallist Ian Dargie all who played for the West Coast Eagles.

Other household names, and current AFL players, include Tendai Mzungu (Fremantle) and Nick Kommer (Essendon).

On Wednesday May 7 the WAAFL inducted five new members into its Hall of Champions in front of more than 150 guests at the City West Receptions.

The WAAFL Hall of Champions was introduced in 2010 as a way to recognise the outstanding contribution to amateur football by players, coaches, umpires and administrators, as well as those who began their careers at an amateur level before going on to higher tiers.

Speaking to guests, President of the WA Amateur Football League John Davies said that the Hall of Champions was a unique way of honouring significant people for their unselfish contribution to amateur football over many years.

“We reflect on the people who set the firm foundations for amateur football over our 92 years of existence and look forward to hearing about the roles these men played in the years gone by.”

Ken Mathews, Bob McDonald and Trevor Howard were all inducted as Champions for their impressive contributions to amateur football.

Ken Mathews has been a solid contributor to the WAAFL as a player, president, WAAFL State Team Selection Panellist and WAAFL Tribunal Member. He was awarded WAAFL Life Membership in 2000 and in the same year was recognised by the AFL with a certification acknowledging his contributions.

1996 WAAFL Umpire of the Year, Bob McDonald has

been involved with WA football since 1953. Playing 302 senior games, Bob then went on to become a member of the WAAFL Goal Umpires Panel, officiating in over 1600 games, and himself umpiring 37 WAAFL grand finals.

WAAFL stalwart Trevor Howard began his football career with Mt Lawley in 1970. He has been heavily involved in the WAAFL, WAWFL and WAFL throughout his time, holding the Presidential title of the WAAFL, WAWFL and the AAFC.

Another two former WAAFL greats were recognised in the High Achievers category, as players who began their career at an amateur level before going on to higher tiers.

Previous WAFC Chairman Neale Fong and WANFL Premiership player Tony Parentich were inducted into the Hall of Champions as High Achievers.

Also recognised at this year’s Hall of Champions were Alan Lewington and Alan Ralph, who were both awarded WAAFL Life Memberships for their extensive dedication to amateur football in Perth.

The WAAFL would also like to further acknowledge Trevor Howard who was also awarded with AAFC Life Membership on the evening.

WAAFL INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

WAAFL Integrated Football continued its journey in 2014 with Coordinator Greg Gilbee at the helm. The program welcomed Coolbinia West Perth as they played their first full season of fixtures against existing teams Fremantle CBC Gold, Fremantle CBC Green, High Wycombe, Kingsway, Lynwood Ferndale and Warnbro.

Wembley Football Club established a core group of 10 players who regularly trained and participated in development style games of AFL9s. These games were played against established teams and the Kingsway Integrated youth team, a team of younger players also keen to develop their skills and enjoy the opportunity to participate.

Ocean Ridge AFC and Quinns Districts AFC also expressed interest in forming teams and whilst this did not eventuate in 2014, it was fantastic to see Clubs considering Integrated Football and the opportunities it brings to their Club.

Pleasingly the existing teams continued to grow their playing numbers, although the challenge is now to ensure even growth amongst all our teams. Playing numbers are now approximately 160 as the benefits of Integrated Football are shared throughout the community.

The main curtain raiser this year occurred on Easter Saturday before the West Coast Eagles v Port Adelaide AFL game. As always, this is a fantastic and unique opportunity for Integrated Footballers. To add to the excitement, the players were invited to wear a brand new set of integrated jumpers to mark the occasion.

The WAFL, in partnership with the Disability Services Commission, invited the Integrated Football program to participate in a “Count Me in Round” to acknowledge and encourage inclusion for all abilities in football. The main highlight of this round saw Kingsway host Coolbinia West Perth at Medibank Stadium in a twilight fixture following the round 21 Subiaco vs Claremont league game.

Together with the WAFC and West Coast Eagles, Gilbee conducted several clinics at education support centres across Perth to introduce football to students and staff, to raise awareness and identify recruits for our teams.

The Integrated Football season concluded with the highly anticipated Grand Final held at Kingsway Reserve between Kingsway and Coolbinia West Perth. The game was hard hitting and highly competitive with both teams eager to claim bragging rights and the inaugural P.L. Grosser Cup. After four strong quarters, Kingsway kicked a last minute goal to secure the win and walk out Premiers 4.3 (27) to 3.5 (23).

Recognition must be given to all our clubs, coaches and passionate volunteers who give of their time unconditionally. We would also like to extend thanks to the WAFC district staff, Disability Services Commission, the Department of Education and Inclusion WA who play key roles in ensuring Integrated Football remains vibrant, enjoyable and a sport that encourages people with intellectual disabilities to participate.

WEST COAST EAGLES STATE U23 AMATEUR TEAM



The West Coast Eagles State U23 Amateur Program commenced in April this year, training and preparing for eight weeks in the lead up to the all important game against South Australia Amateur Football League.

In their first game of the season, the West Coast Eagles State U23's played a night game at Anning Park against the WA Country Football League.

Unfortunately the West Coast Eagles State Amateur U23's were beaten by the bigger bodied WACFL side, finishing 15.6 (96) to 9.5 (59). Best on ground was awarded to Chaz Flint (University).

Head Coach Wayne Langborne was happy with how the team handled themselves against a solid WACFL side, and was confident the final team would put up a tough fight against South Australia.

The night game against the SAAFL was played at Kingsway Reserve with both teams eager to claim the win and bragging rights. Although the SAAFL team got out to an early lead, by three quarter time the scores were equal and the game was either teams to grab. SAAFL stamped their dominance in the second half of the final quarter to win SAAFL 14.19 (103) to WCE U23s 13.6 (84). Thomas Curtin (University) was awarded WA's best on ground.

Head Coach Wayne Langborne was extremely proud of the playing group, with nearly all players being eligible for the Carnival in Tasmania next year.

The program has seen many WAAFL players rewarded with All-Australian selection, some of which have also gone onto WAFL, and AFL clubs, including Nick Kommer who was drafted by the Essendon Football Club in the 2012 National Draft.

Brentwood Booragoon Football Club legend Roger Beer became the club's first player to reach 500 WAAFL games when he took the field in the Round 8 of the 2014 season.

The match up against East Fremantle at Karoonda Park was part of Brentwood Booragoon's Life Members and Past Players day, a fantastic way to celebrate such an impressive milestone.

A veteran of two WAAFL clubs, Beer has had a decorated career including receiving honorary Life Membership at Brentwood Booragoon in 2006 and winning a Premiership with the Brentwood Booragoon D Reserves in 2007.

President of the Brentwood Booragoon Amateur Football Club Tom Atkinson said that Beer is a key player at the club involving in training, playing and coaching.



"Beer holds down a key position in our Reserves side, trains every week he would be one of the fittest players at the club despite being 50 years old". He said

"We won't let him play Veterans or Thirds as he is still too good."

Beer's playing career began at Manning Amateur Rippers Club in 1983 where he played 321 games across a variety of grades.

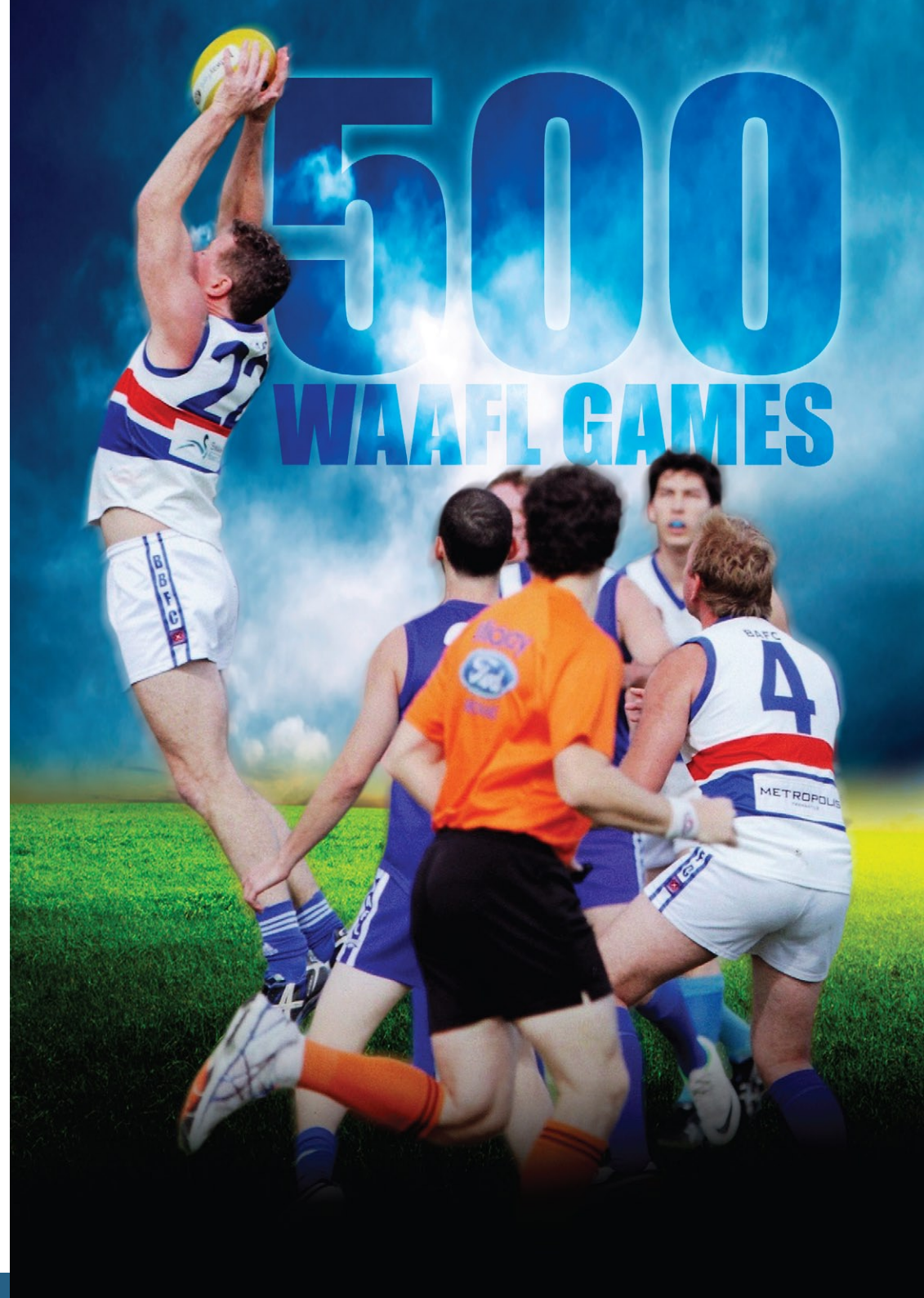
For his efforts and contribution to the club, Beer was awarded with Life Membership at the Manning AFC. In 2001, Beer transferred to Brentwood Booragoon FC as part of a mid-life crisis, and simply needing a change of environment for his football.

Although being involved with the Manning Rippers off-field happenings including holding positions as a committee member and club captain, Beer decided his time at Brentwood Booragoon would be solely dedicated to playing the game, and has not taken on any official role.

Having now played over 180 games with Brentwood Booragoon, Roger doesn't think he'll make the 550 game mile stone with his body no longer willing to put up with the hard hits from football.

Playing a number of games with his son Jack during 2013 was a memorable moment for Roger who has stated that although potentially not playing next year, he would love to remain active within the club and train with the boys.

Congratulations from the WAAFL for a fantastic achievement, not often do we see players take to the field for 34 consecutive years.

The 2014 season started off at Dianella open Space with a 4km time trial in the heat. Henry Brown our strength and condition coach pushed us hard throughout our pre-season. We then moved to Hamer Park where the running continued and our group coaching sessions started.

Cameron Douglas was reappointed in 2014 to Senior WAAFL Field Umpires Coach, which was reward for a good 2013 season. Cameron has matured as a coach this year, notwithstanding his very young age. He continues to appoint in excess of 60 field umpires on a weekly basis. He has excellent knowledge of the rules and their interpretations which has helped the group greatly in the 2014 season. Thanks to Cameron and his assistants, Graham Regan, Tyler Wilson, John Lawniczak, Andrew Kirkland and Chris Patten who all worked tirelessly as Field Match Day Coaches in 2014.

Robbie McDonald was again reappointed in 2014 as Senior WAAFL Boundary Umpires Coach. He is well respected and has the ability to develop young talent pathway umpires. He appoints approximately 70 boundary umpires each week which at times can be difficult. Thanks Robbie! I must also thank Peter Pooley and Paul Boland as Boundary Match Day Coaches in 2014.

Peter Jeffers was reappointed in 2014 as Senior WAAFL Goal Umpires Coach. With Peter as the General and assistance from his Lieutenant General Terry Tomlinson, they prove to be a formidable force in the Goal Umpire Coaching scene. With their ability to get goal umpires to work at the highest level, this has proved to be invaluable to the WAF Goal Umpiring Department as they have been able supply some of our up and coming talented umpires to assist in umpiring WAFL Colts. Thanks Peter and Terry. I must also thank Des Deering for his assistance as a Goal Umpire Match Day Coach in 2014.

Bruce Wheatland was appointed as Club Umpire Coordinator in 2014. His role was to provide support and comprehensive information to the club umpires.

With WAAFL funding support, three club umpire coaches provided match day coaching of club umpires. This is still an area were the WAAFL and WACFUA believe could evolve and play an important role in the development of club umpires.
