Building on the momentum from last year's President's workshops the same structure will remain for these in season 2024.

In last season's workshops we received very positive feedback around the opportunity that clubs had to engage with nearby clubs while also hearing about issues and opportunities that appear locally. These workshops helped the PFL narrow focus to areas of club importance with a number of by-law changes also resulting.

These workshops are each clubs opportunity to provide input into the shaping of the competition going forward. As a precursor to these workshops, a survey that has been built based largely of feedback that has been received to date will be sent in advance to these workshops. The responses to these surveys will help set the tone for the workshops.

Once all four workshops are completed, based on the data collated from both the surveys and the workshops, a range of recommendations will be made. These recommendations will be presented back to you at the end of year presidents forum for further discussion.

Finally, after considering all feedback, the confirmed changes whether it be to By-Laws or other mediums will be communicated to all clubs prior to the commencement of next season. These changes will have had direct input from you, the clubs.

PFL staff will guide the workshops exploring a number of themes with a focus on female participation, vilification and umpiring.
