brief history

Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL is now in its 88th year of operation. With 57 clubs, 213 teams and over 13,000 registered players, the WAAFL has grown from a four team competition to the largest organised football league in WA, catering for players from the age of 16 years, as well as considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

Many well known WAFL and AFL personnel began their careers in the WAAFL. Former West Coast Eagles and Hawthorn coach Ken Judge began his coaching career at an A Grade amateur club. Former Dockers coach Gerard Neesham played several seasons of amateur football and played at state amateur level.

Other high profile players include Drew Banfield, Brett Jones (West Coast Eagles), Phil Scott, Troy Wilson (West Coast Eagles), Gary Buckenara (Hawthorn), Shane Parker (Fremantle), Simon Beasley (Western Bulldogs), Sandover Medallists Ian Dargie (2), Alistair Pickett (2) and Shane Beros.

Former Amateur players who have gone on to be senior administrators include current WA Football Commission Chairman Dr Neale Fong (a triple A Grade Fairest & Best medallist with the WAAFL), former Chairman of the WA Football Commission Dr Peter Tannock, current Chairman of Sydney Swan Richard Colless and former West Coast Chairman and AFL Commissioner Terry O'Connor are just a few who have gone on to contribute to Football at a higher level.

The WAAFL is continuing to focus on the future and how the league uses its leadership and resources to set new standards of excellence and relevance for its member clubs' and various committees.

Operations Manager, Geoff Palmer, Office manager Natalie Couch, Operations Coordinator Matt Henson, Assistants Dylan Mellon, Sharni Rowe and Jasmyn Davidson have teamed together in their usual efficient way.

The WAAFL has played a major role in the Community Football Council (comprises WAAFL, Womens FL, Mercantile FA, AFL Masters and Peel FL), working closely together for the growth through the metro and outer metro areas.

In concluding, the WAAFL has grown to 57 clubs with 213 teams with over 13,000 registered players. All this achieved by the hard work contributed by a huge number of dedicated volunteers and supporters which benefits the local community, families and individuals whilst growing our great game.

2009 highlights

- Continued growth of our competition with new additional divisions in the West Coast Eagles Amateur colts and the number of overall teams reaching 213.
- The WAAFL West Coast Eagles U/23 State Amateur team defeated the VAFA U/23's by a point at South Fremantle Oval. That win was the second successive defeat by our team over Victoria. WA now Leads the National Championship series.
- Our U/23's also defeated a Peel Football League representative team in the inaugural clash in a close encounter.
- We introduced the WAAFL integrated football program. Western Australia's first football competition for the intellectually disabled took a great leap towards reality this season with "Come and Try" days across metropolitan Perth proving to be a huge success. 5 games were held with the hope of introducing a permanent full fixture competition in 2010.
- Five teams from the dissolved Sunday Football League were admitted into the WAAFL at late notice. Despite initially fixturing problems they have all achieved finals positions with three clubs winning premierships.
- The Western Australian Football Association (single seam competition) was also successfully absorbed into the Amateurs.
- Wayne Molloy (former Sunday FL Chairman) was appointed to the WAAFL Board early in the season.
- The WAAFL conducted its first night Grand Final in a very successful venture, Rossmoyne 8.7 (55) and North Fremantle 8.5 (53) to claim H Grade honours on a historical night.
- North Beach A Grade continued with Premiership success. Under Coach Bill Duckworth they won their 6th flag in a row, also making it 9 titles in 11 seasons.
- Our largest and most successful Annual Presentation Night with in excess of 750 guests attending the event at the Perth Convention & Exhibition Centre.
- The announcement of the inaugural Hall of Champions which will honour champions of the past from amateur football in the categories of coaches, administrators, players, media and umpires.
- Brett Fullarton became the first sitting Board Member of the WAAFL to be nominated and elected a Commissioner of the WAFC.
- The Australian Amateur Football Council (AAFC) made a decision to select an all Australia U/23 team to tour South Africa at the end of the 2010 season.
- Two new sponsors' entered into partnership agreements to compliment our already valued list. Welcome aboard Midway Ford and Power Play Sports.
- WAAFL Executive Officer Brendan Cullinan resigned after the football season. For nearly four seasons he has served the League well, help guiding it through a great period of change, exceptional growth and financial stability. We appreciate the time he spent with us.
- Bassendean stalwart, Dean Martin played his 500th game for the club.
- Wesley Curtin's Trent Cooper continued his impressive record of WAAFL achievements. A former state player won the league's E Reserve Fairest & Best medal to go along with his Leading Goal Kicker medal from 2005 and Fairest & Best medals from 2002, 2003 and 2005.
- Mark Sinden from Brentwood Booragoon, winner of 11 club Fairest & Best's and WAAFL C Reserve Fairest & Best winner played his 400th club game.





ceo's report

The 2009 season will be remembered as a watershed year for metropolitan community football in Western Australia. The successful integration of three traditional and historic competitions into one body without the loss of any club is a credit to all involved who volunteer their time to manage clubs and to the Board and staff who oversaw this historic event.

The integrated leagues under the Western Australian Amateur Football League resulted in fifty-seven clubs with two hundred and thirteen teams and over thirteen thousand registered players to be one of the largest senior football competitions in Australia. Excluding the clubs from the former Sunday Football League and the West Australian Football Association, the WAAFL grew by a staggering twelve senior and three colts teams in 2009. A great testament to the hard work of all volunteers in recruiting players and ensuring the WAAFL maintains to be viewed as a quality competition.

The growth of the colts resulted in the **West Coast Eagles Amateur Colts** competition expanding from four to six divisions. Former University player and current West Coast Eagles squad member, Brett Jones, was privileged to have a grade named in his honour. Forty one clubs fielded colts' teams with eleven clubs fielding two teams in different divisions.

Corporate partnerships continue to be a major focus of the League. The support by major partners, **Fosters Australia**, **West Coast Eagles Football Club**, **Keystart Home Loans** and **Sherrin** ensure the League is in a financial position to safeguard the clubs against any major increase in affiliation fees. These partners are supported by **Park Auto Centre**, **Powerplay Sports**, **Midway Ford**, **Cougar Sportswear**, **Toyota Genuine Autoparts**, **Office First Booragoon** and **West Coast Surgical and Medical Supplies**. To all of our corporate partners, we thank you for your continued support.

The League would not continue to operate so successfully without the many people working behind the scenes. To all presidents, committee members, coaches, team managers, umpires, trainers, and all other people who assist each week in so many ways, thank you for your support and the pride you take in your work each week. I would especially like to acknowledge retiring presidents who have committed many hundreds of hours of work over the years to lead their clubs.

To the key leaders of the League – the WAAFL Board, thank you for your support throughout the season. As volunteers, the Board under the leadership of President John Davies continue to evolve and strategically lead the League.

To all the supportive and friendly staff at the Community Football Office – Geoff Palmer, Natalie Couch, Matt Henson, Dylan Mellon, Sharni Rowe and Jasmyn Davidson – all should be congratulated for what has been achieved this year under sometimes taxing circumstances.

As this will be my last report as Chief Executive Officer, I would personally like to thank everyone for their personal and professional support over the past four seasons. I have thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to work with all the clubs, Board and staff to overcome the many challenges that we have faced together. What has been achieved this year is only the start of a new era in community football with amateur football leading the way.

umpiring report

2009 was an extremely successful season for the WAAFL Umpiring Team. The main success evolved from the integration of the Field Umpire Talent Squad into the existing umpiring team allowing these young up and coming umpires to join those experienced campaigners. Both sides of the equation benefited immensely with the young guys vastly improving facets such as communication and man management, with the more experienced guys stepping up to greater fitness levels leading to better on field performance. WAAFL Umpiring is now the final stepping stone for umpires of all 3 disciplines on the talent pathway before they reach WAFL level.

Further to this there were a number of other successes. The number of matches covered by coach appointed Field and Boundary umpires was at an all time high. We also returned to covering C Grade (both divisions) and further divisions of Colts football in the Field umpire discipline and the 3 Field umpire system was successfully implemented in a minimum of one A grade fixture each week.

Also, the Club Umpire Policy which included 9 coaching sessions was run throughout the season at varies geographic locations, Goal umpires again covered 4 divisions of League and Reserves football, record numbers of umpires were promoted to get a taste of A grade football and finally a strong relationship continued between the League and the Umpires Association.

In 2009 the role of Senior Community Umpire Manager became full-time. This allowed the role to be expanded and for a greater hands-on approach to be implemented. As a result Umpiring had a greater input with the Community Football Office and the Community Football Council and a real direction going forward in areas that can be controlled. The challenge will always remain with the game day environment but the WAAFL has shown that it is committed to supporting umpires going forward which will go a long way to helping retain the current team and build on it.

A big thank you again needs to go to the Mount Lawley Amateur Football Club for renegotiating the MOU for a further 2 seasons

to allow the umpiring group to use their facilities at Hamer Park for training and learning. The facilities are first class and with the growth in numbers of umpires attending training in 2009 this venue provided all the resources required to service such a large group.

I would like to also take this opportunity to thank my 3 main coaches for this season in Terry Battle (Field), Des Morgan (Boundary Co-ordinator) and Terry Tomlinson (Goal) for their efforts. The amount of hours and effort these gentleman put in is remarkable and they should be congratulated by all. I would also like to thank all the other coaching and support staff who are too many to name including assistant coaches, match day coaches, training and support staff and administrative assistants who have all contributed to the highly professional team that the Senior Community Umpires are.

A big congratulations also goes to the West Australian Community Football Umpires Association headed by President Matt O'Mara who provide great support to all their members and ensure that a number of functions take place during the season to allow the Umpiring Team to enjoy great fellowship.

Thanks also to all those involved in Amateur Football. To Brendan Cullinan and his team at the Community Office, to John Davies and his Board, to all of the Clubs, Players, Officials, Volunteers and Spectators who along with the Umpires make Amateur Football what it is.

Finally to RICK HART who once again has been the major sponsor for Umpiring in WA and has provided crucial funding to ensure umpiring needs are met including those of the WAAFL Umpires.

western australian integrated football

Western Australian's first football competition for people with an intellectual disability will commence in 2010.

Following the success of four "Come & Try Days" and a trial match conducted this season, four teams will participate in the inaugural competition next year. Three WAAFL clubs – Lynwood Ferndale, Fremantle CBC, and Kingsway, will field teams while a team will be established in the Peel region. It is expected that, similar to the success of this type of competition in Victoria and South Australia, the number of teams will grow in future years as community awareness of the competition increases and more WAAFL clubs offer support. The competition format will consist of fortnightly matches involving all teams.

A collaborative approach by key stakeholders has ensured that this concept has successfully evolved. The Department of Sport and Recreation has provided a grant and logistical support. The Recreation & Sport Network, Disability Services Commissions, East Perth and Perth District Football Development Councils, and the respective WAAFL clubs have all worked collaboratively to ensure that the concept was successfully promoted and the "Come & Try Days" were professionally managed.

The WAAFL Board's plan is to establish a permanent division of teams hosted by existing WAAFL clubs within the next three to five years.



west coast eagles under 23 state amateur team



This year's program ran for seven weeks with training commencing on the 22nd April. Program included seven training runs, one internal scratch match, two competitive games against the WACFL & Peel Football League. In excess of 70 players attended training from 24 clubs and in the final game against Victoria we had representatives from 11 clubs.

The practice matches are an integral part of the program. Although we lost against the WACFL it was again a quality contest and showed we had some hard work to do. With this loss to the country boys we could not rest any players and we played our best squad against Peel. This game was a tough hit out and because the boys were challenged it enabled them to gel together, finally getting on top in the second half to record a narrow victory. This gave the boys a lot of confidence leading into the game against Victoria.

The game against Victoria was a very tight contest all day, the tackling, pressure and overall quality was as good as ever seen at representative football level. It was played in excellent spirit with both sides upholding the amateur ethos of fairness and competitiveness and both sides should be commended for the way they conducted themselves.

The first quarter was very even with the VAFA holding a slender quarter time lead. In the second WA pretty much dominated the game and should have put the game out of the Vic's grasp but didn't due to poor goal conversion. 2 goals 6 points against a late Vic goal saw us go into the half time break with an 18 point lead. The Vic's were always going to come back and to their credit they reduced the margin to 9 points at the final break.

Although the momentum was with the Vic's, WA kicked the first goal of the final quarter. The Vic's refused to give up and got within a point with a minute to go. Somehow we managed to hold on to record an exciting win.

One of the best parts of the win was the coaching staff went in with a specific game plan and the players carried out these instructions to perfection and won the game.

All players should be extremely proud of what they achieved.

I would like to thank John Davies and Board & CEO Brendan Cullinan for your support of me and the program. I'd like to also thank my support team comprising Glenn Stephens, Nick D'Angelo, Andrew Maoirana, Stewart Johnson and Warren Eddy. Your efforts played a significant role in the teams overall success.

Also to Peter Grosser, Geoff Palmer and Guy Ziati thank you for the organization of the program which again ran like clockwork. Nothing is ever a problem for you guys and I appreciate the time you give to the program.

In closing special thanks must go to the West Coast Eagles Football Club, all players, coaches and the WAAFL clubs for your continued support of our State program. This is the reason for amateur football being the leading community based competition in Western Australia.

In 2009 the West Coast Eagles State Amateur Colts program entered into its third year, again proving a success with the team taking home the Neil Judge Shield while also providing important development opportunities for colts aged players.

The program has been heavily backed by the WAAFL board with the belief it would help young players not only at club level, but by providing a pathway to the West Coast Eagles U/23 State Amateur side. The opportunities are also there for players to continue on to All Australian football and represent their country at an international level and also the possibility of continuing on to the WAFL.

Coaches also benefit from the state programs, gaining knowledge and experience at a higher level and being able to take this back to their amateur clubs.

This years' program ran for 10 weeks with three matches taking place, developing players skills both on and off the field in a positive environment whilst hopefully helping them to realise their maximum potential.

The first match of the program took place against the CBH WACFL Colts team, the West Coast Eagles State Amateur Colts side managing to claim victory in a classic encounter. In a see-sawing affair it was the WAAFL colts who managed to snatch victory in the dying seconds, winning the match by 4 points and taking home the Neil Judge Shield for the first time in 10 years.

The next outing was against the Perth Colts, an invaluable part of the program giving players insight to total commitment and various playing styles, challenging themselves as to where they're at in their football. Unfortunately the West Coast Eagles Amateur State team couldn't overcome the Perth colts but the experience will be vital in the players', and coaches, future development.

A match against the WA State 16's Academy Squad concluded our program and provided an exciting challenge for the West Coast Eagles State Amateur Colts team. The State 16's Academy

Players are highly skilled, committed and professional and no doubt littered with future AFL and WAFL stars. Although losing the encounter by a narrow margin the WAAFL colts team should be applauded for their magnificent effort, displaying skill, courage and professionalism in a hard fought match.

The end result and effort throughout the entire 10 weeks tells the coaching staff the players have learnt from the experience and that Amateur football is in good hands as the players who came through the system will without question go on to become outstanding players, and teachers, at their respective clubs.

I would like to sincerely thank WAAFL President John Davies and his board for once again showing faith in me this year, as well as WAAFL CEO Brendan Cullinan and State Team Co-Ordinator Peter Grosser who have supported the program fantastically.

In 2010, the WA Amateur Football League is proud to announce it will introduce a WA Amateur Football Hall of Champions, recognising the elite players, coaches, umpires and administrators of amateur football.

The concept will closely follow that of the West Australian Football Commission's Hall of Fame with recipients of the award being known as "Champions of WA Amateur Football" and being inducted in a special event held annually.

The nominations for players, coaches, umpires and administrators will come from within amateur football, with all clubs invited to nominate players and officials they believe should be considered as Champions. Members of the general public will also have the opportunity to submit nominations for any player or official since 1922, the beginning of amateur football in WA.

From the nominations received, the sub committee will select up to eight inductees to become the first Champions of WA Amateur Football at the inaugural event to be held in 2010.

Over the years amateur football has produced many great players, coaches and administrators, the WA Amateur Football Hall of Champions will endeavor to recognise and reward the Champions, many of whom were volunteers and never received proper recognition.

Whilst individual clubs have honour boards within their clubs, to be named a Champion of WA Amateur Football will give a new status to the heroes of our great game.
