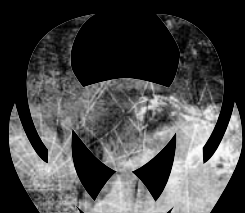

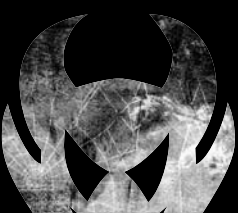

Financially it has been a difficult year as well as the gate and bar receipts were affected by our on field performance and at the time of writing I am unable to report the actual results for the year.

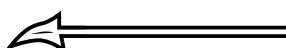
The club also needed to find replacements for Brian Leys, Darren

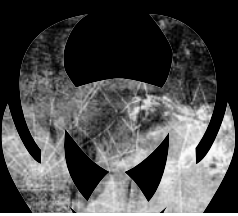

Congratulations must go to Ben Noakes and Dean Kent for winning the Reserves and Colts competition best and fairest awards.

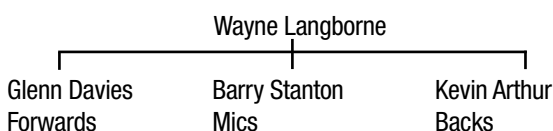

League Coach's Report

The 2012 season started with high expectations, after a strong finish to the previous season and an excellent recruiting campaign over the summer months.

With a strong focus on making sure our club was committed to the return of our ex AFL players we were successful in securing the services of All Australian Collingwood Great Leon Davis which was a step forward in a area that we had failed at in the past. This then lead to Brennan Stack and Ali Smith returning home to their WAFL club of origin. To add to the quality of this list, we were fortune to also gain the services of Sydney Swans premiership player Paul Bevan. In addition to this impressive line up we were able to recruit Tim and Ben Noakes along with WAFL Premiership Ruckman Lane Spaanderman.

With a strong pre season under way there was an air of confidence around the Perth Football Club that we were set for an exciting season, lots of positive media coverage and hipe.

With a fit and health playing list we made our way to Jurian Bay for pre season camp and then a week later we entered the preseason competition. With a new and exciting list we knew it was going to take some time to gel as a group and play consistent football.

Round one we encountered reigning Premiers Claremont on an extremely hot Sunday afternoon that took its toll on our boys, after three excellent quarters of football we sadly lost one of our most senior players in Scott Sierkierka for the season with a extreme hamstring injury and Chris Vidot with a groin injury.

The week later, injuries went against us losing Jarrod Kayler-Thomson with a season ending shoulder injury. The injury toll would unfortunately go on to haunt us for the rest of the season, with a significant number of players taking little or no part in the season. Haydn Busher, Andrew Mc Dougall, Rob De Jong, Seamus Young, Jarrod Kayler -Thomson, Scott Sierkierka just to name a few, were all players we could not afford to lose.

Although at league level we did not live up to expectations there was still a number of positives to come from season 2012. For the first time in my 10 years at the club we had both Colts and Development teams play finals and the next step to that achievement is to have all three grades play finals football. Ben Noakes and Dean Kent where judged the best players in the Colts and Reserves competition. We had seven young boys make their league debut with Reece Richardson and Sean Holland from the 2011 Colts program stepping up to League ranks quickly. Our Development program's 14-15-16 also continue to improve with some exciting talent which will develop into future League footballers at the Perth Football Club.

The future looks bright with a strong foundation being built from the ground up through the Rob Wiley Development Foundation. A special mention to Gary Poole who unfortunately has not continued in his role as Pathway Development Officer but has done a outstanding job setting up some great program's that can be continued in years to

A special thanks to Alex Tough for doing my match up board on game day as well being a runner for the Colts team. Thanks also goes to Michael Broadbridge for his game day assistance mentoring the coaching group.

Special thanks to our medical team led by Dana Pimley and Steve Allen, your team have done a excellent job this season. We are fortunate to have three great team managers in Steve Ransted, Kevin Dack and Ash Dinning who have all done a professional job this season. How can I thank the huge job of our long lasting property man Arthur Ransted assisted by Douglas. Arthur typifies all our club values and is treasured by our players.

Finally a big thank you to the playing group and the Board for showing faith in me as the Coach of the Perth Football Club.

Like every other season we see staff members come and go and the Perth Football Club has a great history of seeing people move up to the AFL and beyond, this season being no different. Congratulations to Dana Pimley who has moved on to the Dockers after 10 years at our club. Sam Robertson moves into his new role at Golf Australia and Steve Allan joins the Eagles in a new Physiotherapy role. Development Coach's Report



Adam Pickering, Development Coach

We always had the vision for this team that it would be a development group and that results would be secondary. The coaching group encouraged a 'team first' mentality, but, also along the way, to coach, teach and develop individuals within that team structure, to help them improve as players.

I adopted a group that was very tight and played for each other. Although being tight knit, they embraced new players from outside the group, whether they be first year out of colts like Cameron Jones, Sean Holland, Tyler Chrimes, Matthew Boyle, Kerwin Stuart, Reece Richardson and Dylan Warner, or their first year at the Perth Football Club like Ben Noakes, Ben Fraser and Jaxon Ramsay. Although there were some testing times throughout 2012, especially early in the year, I see the year as being a success, as:

1. We played finals football.
2. Eight players, who started off in the development group made their league debut.
3. There was continual improvement in deficiencies throughout the year.

During the year, we continually played individuals in positions that they were not accustomed to. We saw this as a development area, not only physically, but mentally. By having a player play in a position where he is not comfortable has a number of benefits including:

1. He can work on areas of deficiencies.
2. He can become a more rounded footballer.
3. He has to prepare mentally for something that is a relative unknown.

I can say that almost every player in the development group took this on and embraced it throughout the year, and by doing so strengthened their mind which then helped when it came to finals and other big games.

So, after 20 games we had finished 3rd on the ladder. There were some highlights along the way, with great wins against Claremont in Rounds 1 and 18 and also against East Fremantle at East Fremantle Oval.

Going into a finals campaign for the 2nd year in a row for this group, we stuck to our original philosophy we had at the start of the year, 'This is a development group and the results would come secondary'. The match committee selected a side of younger players who had played the majority of the year in the development squad. Although some 'senior' players had qualified for finals football, we saw more benefit for the younger brigade to play finals football, for their continual development.

Semi Final v East Perth

This was the most pleasing day of the year for me. The group went into this game full of confidence against a very strong East Perth side. 6 weeks earlier we had lost at home to East Perth with a kick after the siren. On that day we coughed up a 4 goal lead with 15 minutes to go. Came the last quarter in this game, we were in a very similar

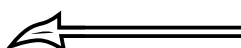
situation, a slender lead and East Perth coming hard at us. The game was in the balance and we were under extreme pressure and it felt like déjà vu. However on this occasion, the boys showed what we were all about, they had learnt from our previous loss and did not panic, we controlled the ball for long periods of the last quarter and held on for a hard fought victory. Onwards to the Preliminary final.

Preliminary Final v East Fremantle

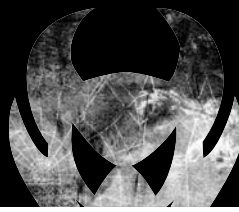
This was the proudest moment of the year for me. Again, going into a final against very strong opposition, the boys showed that it doesn't matter who is put out on the ground, if you play as a team with a strong will and the right mental attitude, you can compete with anyone. The game was affected by a strong breeze to one end and it was a real arm wrestle as each side took real advantage of the wind. After some undisciplined acts in the 3rd quarter we found ourselves 34 points down going into the last quarter. The boys then rallied and responded like they had all year. They showed in that last quarter that this group of young men have character. We fought back and gave ourselves every chance to win that game of football, and won every stat except for the goals category on the day, which is the most important one.

After that loss, I told the players that I was extremely proud of them, however if we are to get better as a football club, we can never accept failure, no matter what level it is. In saying that, we cannot lose sight of what this group is all about, Development. There are some very good footballers who are coming through this group, but, as I said to them all year, 'Playing WAFL football is not easy', it takes hard work, commitment, sacrifice, a strong will, and most importantly, the right mental attitude and application. I am confident many will make it.

Colt Coach's Report



Wayne Langbourne, Colts Coach

Although the 2011 season was not good result wise it did enable us to expose a number of 16 year old boys to Colts football and we approached the 2012 season with much anticipation.

With the knowledge that 18 boys had played at least one game of Colts football in 2011 we started the 2012 season with a much more experienced group than the previous year.

The preseason was extremely solid under new Strength & Conditioning Manager Tom Fleming with the emphasis on short & long distance running, cross fitness training, core strength and flexibility during the structured four sessions per week program. This coupled with a focus on competitive drills where the coaches could fast track the quality player identification process, enabled us to select a final squad of 53 players plus five train on boys from an original training number in excess of 90 boys.

Once the season commenced, the first two games against the previous seasons Grand Finalists saw us lose by 15 and 8 goals; and having won only one of the first five games it certainly wasn't the start we were looking for.

That said we were confident that the boys that were playing just needed time to gel together and get used to the very high colts standard and thankfully this is what happened, with them winning the next seven games in a row to firmly entrench themselves in the top four.

Along the way we reversed the early season loses against quality opposition and although we had a number of injuries towards the end of the season, the upside of this was it enabled us to again blood a number of young boys with the knowledge they would see the benefit in 2013.

Although we were very disappointing in our first semi final loss, the 13 in-season wins & exposure to finals intensity will certainly benefit the boys going around in 2013.

Along with achieving our goal of playing finals there were numerous positives to the 2012 season which included:

- A total of 50 boys represented the Perth Football Club Colts in 2012.
- 21 of these boys are eligible to play representatives in Chris Yarran, Brandt Colledge & Sam Garstone.
- Dean Kent winning the Jack Clarke medal for the best & fairest in the Colts competition and also myself being named as the Colts Coaches Award winner.
- Both Dean & Joel Kalajzic being named in the Colts Team of the Year.

Assistant coaches Kevin McArthur, Barry Stanton & Glenn Davies along with Rucks coach Terry Gabriel & forward scout Cam Palmer were all outstanding in their commitment to the boys and the knowledge they

were passing on.

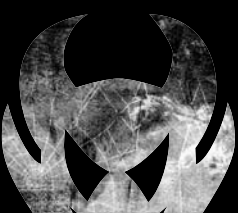

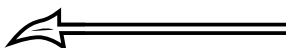
We wish Damien McMahon well for the overdue achievement of senior finals action with a stabilised squad retaining and promoting only those with the "right stuff".

And yes, we intend to re-open the "Red Legs" Bar from the first Thursday training run at the club in January 2013!

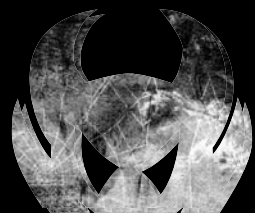

The Demons District Football Development Council (DDFDC) vigorously develops football across the Demons region

In 2012 the DDFDC in conjunction with the Perth Football Club and the Western Australian Football Commission supported game development across age groups from Auskick through to Masters football. In doing so the District provided enhanced playing environments for Auskick, juniors, youth, community football, multicultural programs, school programs, women's football and the AFL 9s competition.

The number of playing participants in 2012 was 11,142. This total is a 9.6 per cent increase on 2011 and augers well for participation levels moving forward.

Auskick, modified rules and youth player participation remained strong and significant growth in school based programs saw 5,675 students participate in football through the support of the Demons District.

Our thanks go to the District Manager Scott Faulkner for the strategic leadership of these programs and to District Officer Anthony Balcombe and the team of clinic coordinators who deliver quality programs and competitions to our District schools.

Volunteers are the heart and soul of a successful District. 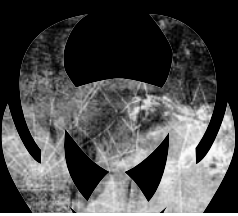

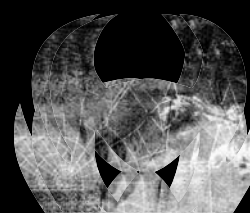
exposing our development squad members and coaches to the Perth

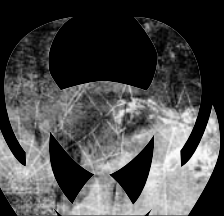
Robert Wiley Foundation Dinner

Doncon was captain of the Northern Suns Carnival side that went to Country Week.

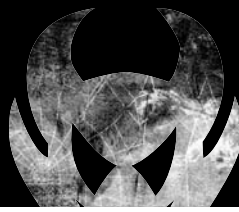
