PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Mark Stewart

We will never forget 2020. It has certainly been a very challenging year for our club so it was heads down as we navigated these difficult times. Tough times reveal character, and it was the character of our people that's got us through this year.

As our people pulled together to control our circumstances, it became clear that the Board's purpose was to steer us through this year's crisis and to find a positive outcome from what was, and continues to be, a very strange time in our lives.

To our wonderful players, coaches, support staff, members and volunteers who either reduced their payment to help the Club or donated funds through the Go Fund Me fundraiser. Thank you. In our hour of need, when we needed your help, you were there to support us, and for that we are eternally grateful, and this money will now be set aside for our Future Fund to protect us if a second wave of Covid arrives, or used for funding towards the Redevelopment of our new facility over the next 2 to 3 years.

On field, our Seniors improved in a lot of areas, but not in the win/loss, but we do believe we are now on the right track, and we hope that you will see a good young crop of League players who are between 19 and 23 progress into 100 to 150 games players for the Club.



Thanks again to Brad Dodd and Bill Monaghan and the Football Department for working through all the difficult scenarios that were thrown your way and coming out the other end.

To all the coaches and support staff under Bill and Brad for their continued professional support throughout 2020. You are all passionate Sharks supporters who offer their time willingly each season, and it is greatly appreciated.

Facility Upgrade

The facility is in constant need of repairs and maintenance and I must thank the following groups for their outstanding support in this area.

Since November last year the Club, our Sponsors along with the Past Players group, with great financial support from East Fremantle Town Council have upgraded our facility by spending well over \$150,000 on maintenance or new upgrades (see facilities report on upgrades).

The Club has now completed 70% of our EFFC Physical Environments Projects. The document recommended upgrades and improvements to the physical outlook of buildings and surrounds of New Choice Home Park.

Redevelopment of East Fremantle Oval Precinct

I am also pleased to announce that the Town of East Fremantle is about to publish a fully costed Business Plan for the Redevelopment of East Fremantle Oval Precinct.

The plan has been through several community consultation workshops / meetings to make sure all views were

considered in the Redevelopment.

The Business plan has been approved by Council and they have committed funding, we now wait on funding proposals with the State and Federal governments for the project to get the green light.

Financials

I am pleased to announce a significant surplus this year of \$250,748 after depreciation for the 2020 season. This surplus includes the Go Fund Me donations of \$107,000 which have been moved out of this year's P/L into a Future Fund.

The reason for the surplus is mainly due to the State Government incentives when COVID 19 hit for Not for Profit (NFP) organisations, as we were able to get Jobkeeper for staff and players and a reduction in BAS quarterly payments.

We understand that 2021 will be a very difficult year financially with a reduction in grants from the WAFC and a foreseeable loss in sponsorship and membership from patrons who are in financial difficulty.

A big thank you to the Finance Sub Committee of Mark Stewart, Michael Brennan, Bob Uittenbroek, Mark Murphy and Steve Nugent.

Sponsorship

A special mention to our sponsors who were outstanding in the support of the Club throughout the pandemic.

The Club was able to retain 95% of our sponsors throughout the season.

A big thank you to our Business Development Team of Renee Ciesla, Kim Chatfield and Dave Edinger for all their work in this area.

Junior District

Our Junior Districts Clubs continue to provide excellent talented players for our development squads, but more importantly are a vital link to our community with links to thousands of volunteers who co-ordinate junior football each weekend. Thank you to the chairman of the District Council in Geoff Wolfenden for his guidance to the District Admin team of Bradd Gardiner, Tom Atkinson, Daren Bell and Jaxon Liddelow throughout the year.

Country Zone

In a difficult year for all Country Leagues, the GNFL were able to get a season going from July onwards.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY FOR 2020

The impact of COVID-19 in March 2020 created a massive change to how the Club conducted their operations, with the Board reacting by setting up a "Go Fund Me" campaign to raise funds for the Club if they were not able to raise income throughout the year. Full-time employees, including support staff were on reduced wages during the first couple of months of the pandemic. The "Go Fund Me campaign" raised a total of \$107,000. The Club received Federal Government's Job keeper and cash flow boost subsidies, which allowed the Club to produce a healthy profit for 2020. As such the funds generated from the campaign were not utilised. These funds had been placed in a future fund account for the Club.

The Masterplan for the Redevelopment of East Fremantle Precinct is now complete and approved by the Town of East Fremantle, with the Redevelopment in front of State and Federal government for funding. The Club is about to start a Redevelopment Fund for members and supporters to purchase large step pavers for the entrance to the new facility.

Below is a summary of our results in each category, along with a comparison to the 2019 financial year.

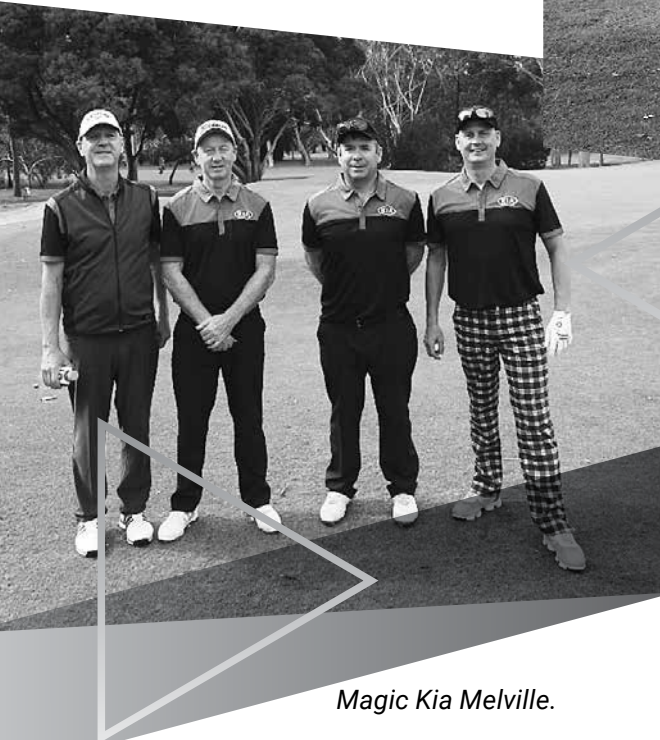

COLTS

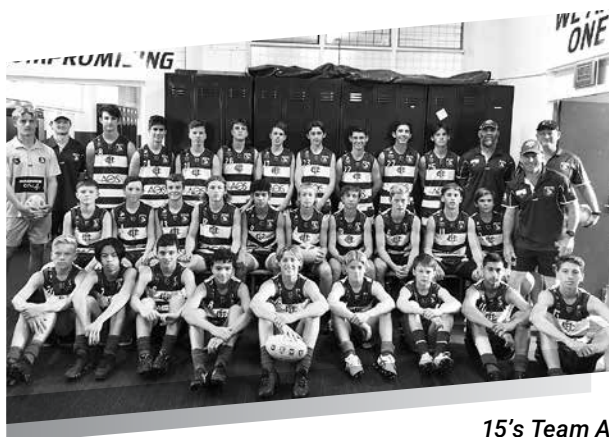

FOOTBALL OPERATIONS - *Brad Dodd*

After a promising finish to the 2019 season, we attacked the off season with renewed optimism and determination to continue on our path of improvement. We appointed a new Strength and Conditioning coach in Matt D'Aloia, who was in charge of North Adelaide when they won a SANFL flag in 2018. Matty went about driving our weights program, an area we felt we needed to make ground up on to compete with the top teams. Bill Monaghan and his coaching group worked hard with the playing group on our ball movement over the pre-season. We were happy with our pre-Xmas work.

We had only added a few players in the off-season. We still felt we had considerable natural improvement in our young squad. Durak Tucker was recruited from the Sydney Swans. An exceptional talent, Durak had been injury ravaged over the previous 2 seasons and had played very little football. We saw Durak as a key piece to our back 6. Brodie Riach came to us from the West Coast Eagles. Brodie is a good endurance athlete who had a basketball background. He had spent 18 months on West Coast's list and was looking to continue his football journey with us. Finally, we added Jordan Mills who had spent 10 seasons at West Perth. A key back, Jordan offered us coverage down back as we expected Matthew Jupp to miss the first half of the season after having a toe operation.

Everyone was really looking forward to the season starting as we headed into our first practice game against Subiaco in mid March. As we all know, the game was cancelled and soon after it appeared we were unlikely to play a season at all. It was a strange few weeks as we all watched

what was going on around the world as our football season took a back seat. As a club we engaged our players on Zoom as weekly meetings with the WAFL provided little concrete information. Over time we gradually got access back to the players, being able to do some skill work in groups of 10. Staff was limited to myself and Bill Monaghan. Again, we still had no start date to work to. This was a real mental challenge for the players - training with the real possibility of no season. De-motivation was an issue that we continued to address. Eventually there was light at the end of the tunnel and a season was announced. After various work groups and discussion, West Coast withdrew from the competition and an 8 game season was announced commencing at the start of August. But there was a final twist, with the season being brought forward 2 weeks and starting mid July.

With a short lead in, there was a lot of discussion around what our training program would look like. The AFL season had started and there was a spate of soft tissue injuries. There was concern that the strength base had been eroded and we were unlikely to make the ground up. The players had been made to make do with makeshift home gyms but the ability to squat and power lift had been severely restricted. Soft tissue injuries were an issue for us early in the season.

Over the off-season, we had tried to recruit Cody Leggett from Perth. It was a long drawn out process that saw us lose at arbitration and unable to come up with a deal with Perth. This wasn't through lack of trying but Perth had decided

to make a stand - which was well within their rights. Though it was disappointing to get Cody the way we did, my position is that the players best interests need to be taken into consideration more and I don't think they were in this case.

We decided to play 2 practice games leading into the season. Claremont and Subiaco would give us the opportunity to play against 2 genuine contenders leading into a Round 1 game against South Fremantle. We had a great hit out against Claremont before a poor showing against Subiaco. Nevertheless, we were pretty confident going into the Round 1 derby. To say the game was a huge disappointment was an understatement. It was an unacceptable performance.

The next 3 games saw us win against Peel before another poor loss against East Perth. Heading into the must win match against Perth, we were 1-2. After Perth had held us at bay for most of the day, the boys came storming home only to not be able to land the knock out blow. A 6 point loss saw us head into the bye with a 1-3 record.

After the bye we again came up short in the next 3 games. We held a 5 goal lead in the 3rd quarter against West Perth to throw it away and lose by 4 points before again finishing strongly to lose to Claremont by 5 points. It was only the 2nd time in WAFL history a club had lost 3 games in a row by 6 points or under. Against Subiaco we had played great football for 3 quarters before falling away badly in the last. Our final game saw us close the gap on



Swans in the last quarter before they kicked away again. 1-7 certainly was a disappointing season and fell short of internal expectations. But it also showed us all that we need to continue to strive for improvement. The challenge to our young group is to measure themselves against the best in the competition. It will certainly be a focus heading into 2021.

At the end of every season, staff and players depart for various reasons. While we have retained nearly the whole squad for 2020, there are 2 departures that I'd like to acknowledge. Nick Krummenacher has been our Senior physiotherapist since 2018. Nick has worked closely with the playing group to ensure they're ready for battle each week. We all wish Nick and his wife, Helen all the best with their first foray into parenthood.

As was announced leading into the last game, Jon Griffin has also retired. Big Griff has been an absolute warrior on the field across his career and a fantastic ambassador for East Fremantle on his journey through the Adelaide, Central Districts, Fremantle and Peel Football Clubs. Leading the club since his coming back in 2018, Griff has set a high standard on and off the field. We're hopeful of Griff being involved in some capacity in 2021.

Congratulations to the individual winners at our Best and Fairest night. Jarrad Jansen was a worthy winner of the Lynn Medal. Jarrad is an emerging leader who has only just scratched

the surface at League level. He will be a key component to our resurgence. 2nd place, Milan Murdock continues to improve and spent more time in the midfield this year. At only 20 years of age, the Rising Star winner has many great years of football ahead of him. Despite not doing a pre-season, Cody Leggett came in and had a consistent year to finish in 3rd place. His best football at half-back is still very much ahead of him. Jordan Snadden and Blaine Boekhorst rounded out the top 5.

Jakob Ah Chee took out the Reserves award, winning the Henry Jeffery Medal. A popular member of the squad, he won over the players and coaches with his fierce competitiveness. Reuben McGuire and Adam Sereda came 2nd and 3rd and both have bright futures should they continue to improve.

Finn Gorringer had an outstanding season in the Colts to win the Len Anderson award. 16 year old, Jed Hagan came in 2nd while skipper, Keanu Haddow, Josh Browne and Brandon Walker rounded out the top 5. We wish all the players eligible for the draft all the best and look forward to those that don't get picked going into the Senior program.

Thanks finally to the playing group. I have an unwavering belief in this group and I know we will get there. I can't wait for 2021.



2020 YEAR REVIEW - by Jarrad Jansen

The 2020 WAFL season was a season like no other. Nothing could have prepared our football club for what was coming. On the eve of our first scheduled practice match, we received the news that our game was cancelled and the start to our season was to be delayed. After completing four months of preseason training, the news was less than ideal. However, we understood that COVID-19 might just be larger than WAFL football.

From a football perspective, the unknown start date of our season or if we were to have a season at all, was difficult to deal with as we had to maintain as much of our strength and fitness from our preseason without an end date in sight.

After 10 weeks of not knowing whether a season would commence, we received the news that a shortened season was to begin in August, although, a one week suspension earned in the final round of 2019 would see me start in round two.

My role in 2020 changed from previous seasons as my minutes as an inside midfielder were reduced to allow me to spend more time playing as a key forward and second ruckman. The coaching group identified a missing link in our game after round three as

our small forwards were unable to find reward for effort after working into good positions around forward 50 contests. This triggered the change in my role and when Bill delivered the news to me, his message was simple – create a contest. I have always prided my game on being able to win and create contests so I made the most of the opportunity by being more physical in aerial contests and following up my work at ground level.

A secondary role as a backup ruckman was also assigned to me by Bill to relieve Jon Griffin of his duties. It was a role that I hadn't played since my junior playing days. With my experience in the midfield, I was able to play a hybrid role as a ruckman/fourth inside midfielder which gave us a different look at attacking the opposition in the centre square and around the ground. I have always played my football with a team first mindset and this allowed me to adapt to my new roles and have an impact on the game.

As a playing group, the challenges we faced throughout the preseason were none different to those faced by the eight other WAFL clubs. Our 1-7 win/loss record is extremely hard to accept as a senior player. We were unable to find reward in

the wins column for our improvement and development over the past two seasons. Near enough was not good enough as we fell short against three of the top four sides by less than one goal; and a fourth quarter fade out against Subiaco saw another opportunity missed.

Despite the tough losses, we have taken key learnings and great belief in knowing that we are able to match it with the top sides of the competition. It reaffirmed that we are tracking in the right direction as a playing group, and that our reward for effort is excruciatingly close if we stick to the process.

We have an exciting group of players who have added to their experience at league level; more young talent continuing to work hard to develop into league players; and a group of senior players that is committed to lifting and driving the standards required for success at this level.

On a personal note, I am extremely proud and humbled to have won the Lynn Medal for season 2020, however I am far from satisfied as we have been unable to find team success since my return to the club. I could not be more motivated and excited to attack the 2021 season to help our great football club return to where it belongs.

EFFC Facilities Update

- John Ipsen - Director of Strategic Projects

It is an understatement to suggest that this year has been an extremely challenging year and perhaps one that we will never again see in our lifetime.

Even with such a difficult year, the East Fremantle Football Club (EFFC) continue to gain traction around finding certainty for our future facilities. As reported at last years' AGM, we have engaged with the Town of East Fremantle (ToEF) to work in coordination with the development of the East Fremantle Oval Precinct.

The development of an Integrated Community, Sport and Leisure Precinct within the Town at the East Fremantle Oval precinct will provide significant economic, social and health benefits. This redevelopment is being actioned as a high priority project by ToEF.

East Fremantle Oval Precinct

Background - 2018-2019.

During this extensive consultation and co-design process, the community expressed strong support for upgrades to club facilities, passive recreation space for walking (including with dogs), general exercise activities, enhanced access to club sports and recreation activities. Interest was also expressed in adding a shed activity space, a fitness facility, casual shared-use hard courts, a nature play space, flexible outdoor community event space, a modest skate park, a function room / café and multi-purpose areas for performances

Business Planning.

In early 2020 the vision was developed and refined, in collaboration with expert consultants, to prepare a high-level **Concept Design** to support the drafting of a business plan and funding document.

Schematic Design.

Following the appointment of a Multidisciplinary Design Team (MDT), an **updated Concept Design** was released for community review.

The MDT are in the process of preparing a draft Schematic Design following a review of the public submissions.

The **draft Schematic Design** will then be open for public comment for a period of at least two weeks. The MDT will then finalise the **Building and Precinct Schematic Design** following their review of any additional feedback.

Summary

ToEF continue to be mindful of the significance of the project and its importance to the community. Consultation has been extensive throughout the process and to date community feedback has been overwhelmingly positive.

During the extensive consultation and co-design process, the community expressed strong support for:

- Upgrades to club facilities,
- Providing passive recreation space for walking (including with dogs), general exercise and other activities,
- Supporting active lifestyles through enhanced access to club sports and recreation activities.

In essence, with the EFFC committing to being a community organisation, the ToEF and the community in general have embraced the entire oval precinct. Whilst we wait for the final design, layout and cost, we are now in no doubt that with the public government support, this new facility is highly likely to be funded and built within a three year time frame.

Strategic Projects

In late 2019, we had the launch of the EFFC **Physical Environment Upgrade**. A document on recommended upgrades and improvements was completed with the clear aim of improving the physical outlook of buildings and surrounds.

For 2020, we initially intended to

complete 12 Physical Environments Projects, but have committed to and completed many more. Some of the key improvements this year were:

- Bitumizing of Car Park behind changerooms - **\$45,000** – Thanks to the ToEF
- Painting of entire Building(s) - Classic Contractors and Dulux. – Approximately **\$100,000** worth of paint and services.
- New Sound System in Main Bar - **\$14,000**
- New Partitions for Main Function Room - **\$5,000**.
- New Door for Players Entrance allowing access by FOB key - **\$10,000**.

All of these refurbishments were made possible by our valued sponsors, volunteers and supporters.

Another key initiative of the EFFC was the recruitment of the Leeming Senior High School Special Education students. A small group of students attended the Club every Friday to engage in horticulture projects around the club. The aesthetic improvement to our gardens along Moss Street is obvious and our many thanks go to the LHS and their students, a job well done!

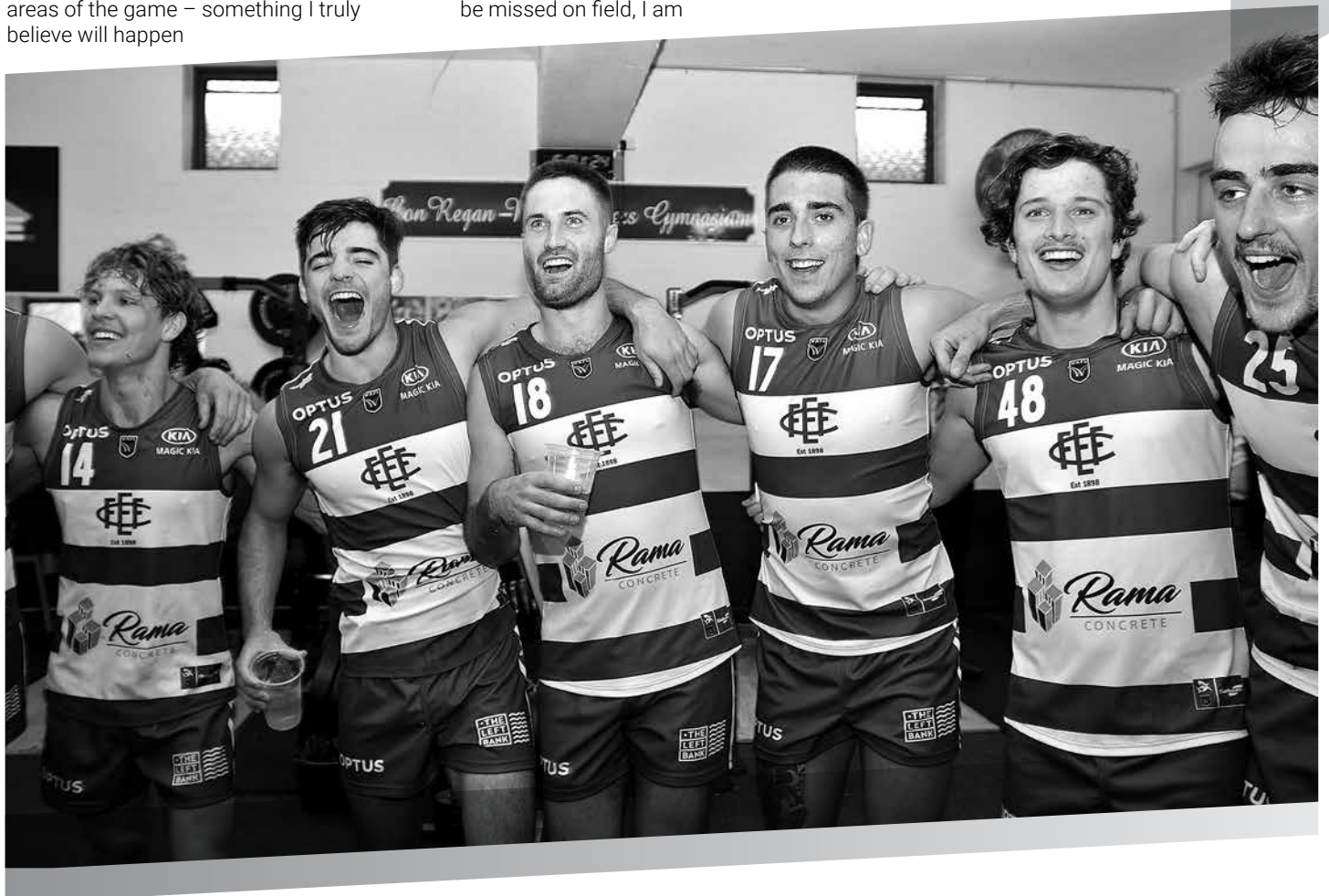

RESERVES REPORT - Brad Dodd



Our Development program is something that we are committed to investing in. We see it as a key component to rising up the ladder. Over the past 10 years only Peel Thunder have won a League premiership when their Reserves team didn't make the finals. A strong Reserves creates a competitive environment, a cornerstone to any team success.

Our aim is to fast track the development of a potential 100 game League players. The challenge is to identify those players early and set them on the path of improvement. We do this by creating a Development Group within our Senior squad. Between 20-25 players are divided up amongst our development coaches. These coaches work closely with their players over the season, providing feedback, working on strengths and weaknesses and going through vision. It's an individual approach within the team environment.

Match day is where we get to monitor the improvement. We throw a lot of challenges to different players. At the breaks we encourage the players to drive the conversations. Can they think outside of their own game to provide feedback on the team performance? Our Reserves team was the youngest in the competition this year - a lot of our young guys are still trying to work it all out - so it was great to see the growth in this area.

Our program is still in its early stages but already we have seen improvement. The level of depth is building. Though the results at Senior level haven't come as quickly as we'd all like, they will. We will continue to look for ways to improve our program and challenge our players.

I'd like to congratulate Jakob Ah Chee for taking out the Henry Jeffery Medal for the Fairest and Best player for the Reserves. Jakob was new to the club this year and embraced everything we asked. He was one of those players that you would love to have as a team-mate - his level of competitiveness never waivers and he is driven to improve.

Runner up, Reuben McGuire had a great first season in the Senior program, getting close numerous times to a League debut. He was shifted all over the ground but looked most comfortable down back where he was able to drop off an intercept mark at a high level. I look forward to seeing Reuben play League football in 2021.

In 3rd place was Adam Sereda, who is a great example to our playing group about perseverance and dedication to improving his game. In 2019, Adam didn't make the Senior squad. Disappointed, he went away and worked on his game and was invited back to try again in 2020. He trained strongly over the pre-season and made

our squad of 55. Playing down back, Adam has always been an excellent one on one defender. This year he managed to drop off and impact more and started to find more of the ball.

Rounding out the top 5 were Matthew Burton and Cody Smith. Both had consistent years and will be looking to push for regular League selection in 2021.

Well what a year we had! Starting all the way back in November 2019, we were about to embark on preseason training for a normal season. As a first year coach, I was excited to start and plan my first preseason program and implement things I learned under previous coaches.

Pre-season went well; we were fit and healthy, without too many injuries - only a few existing injuries from the previous year. Our 4 coaches, Andrew Stephen, Kane Lucas, Paul Mews and Paul Hansen all took a group of 20 while I was in the coaches box talking to Mark Pashby to relay my messages to them. We weren't allowed to do any contact training and had to keep socially distanced as best we could, pretty challenging to create drills and players to get something out of it but we managed it!

Jemma Bassi (our S&C) implemented a falling technique program that taught our players to fall properly and brace for contact, which was very helpful. We had to continue like this for 3 weeks which was 6 sessions in total.

Now we had finally got word that we could start training as a group and planning for preseason 2.0 started! The players, coaches and staff were all excited to finally be back as a group and we hit the ground running. We were now edging closer to playing practice games and excited to put into practice all of our hard work that we put in over a very long

preseason.

The season was finally upon us, albeit a shorter 8 game season plus finals and we were extremely excited to showcase our talent. We didn't start the season off all that well, we were 1-3 before our first bye with losses to South Freo, Peel and Perth with our only win coming against East Perth. The bye came at the right time for us as we knew we had 4 tough games if we wanted to play finals. We held a quiz night during the bye week to better bond the team ahead of a massive finish to the season.

After the bye we had games against West Perth, Claremont, Subiaco and Swan Districts. First up, an undefeated West Perth at Joondalup. We backed ourselves in and put in our best performance for the season and came away with a 22 point win. Next up, an undefeated Claremont side who we knew were going to be tough. Another fantastic performance as we came away with a 21 point win at home. A loss to Subi in round 8 was tough to take but we were a united group and knew we would bounce back. Swan Districts fielded their strongest team for the year against us in Round 9 and we had to win to play finals. It was the perfect game leading into a finals campaign as it was tough and hard, and we came away with a 10 point win to secure a finals berth against West Perth.

The week leading into our semi final was an exciting one, we made it about ourselves and were really united in taking any challenge on. That's exactly what we did coming away with a 19 point win to advance to a Prelim Final against the eventual premiers Subiaco. Although losing the Prelim by 62 points is not their way we wanted to finish our season there were plenty of positives to take away from such a tough year. We played 39 players across 10 games and the average age of our squad this year was 17.2 making us the second youngest side this year. Over half of the playing squad this year can play next year and make up the core of our squad. Exciting times ahead not only for us as a Colts program, but the club as we have some great talent coming through and I am extremely humbled and privileged to be able

to develop these young talented boys and give them understanding of what it means to play for our great club.

There are a fair few people involved in making this a successful program and I would like to thank all of them so here we go. Oscar's snap goal in the last minutes of the 1957 Preliminary Final to take the club he loved into the Grand Final and the Premiership were and still are part of the "Oscar story".

His dedication to the club saw him spend a great deal of time in a variety of coaching and management roles. During his years on the Board he was involved in Recruiting, Zone, Match and Social Committees as well as his work supporting the Colts teams.

Finally, as stated in last year's report this committee cannot keep on keeping on and unless we can attract some new blood 2022 may well be our final hurrah. We

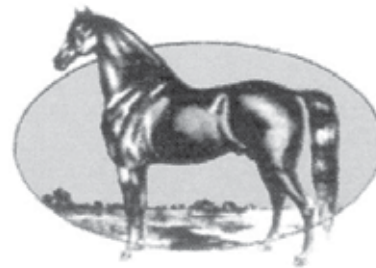

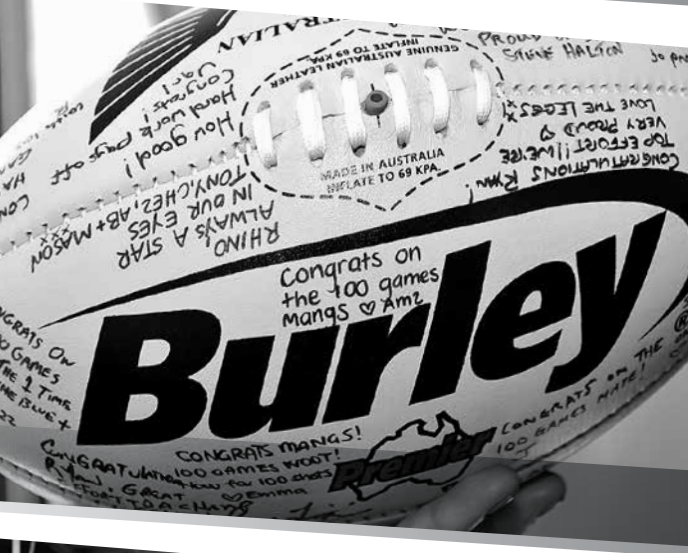

Great Northern Football League Annual Report - *Mat Cook*



We were extremely fortunate to have some sort of season in 2020, given the challenges we faced due to Covid-19. Although it was a delayed and shortened season, it turned out to be a very successful year for the GNFL.

Also due to Covid-19, many clubs lost a number of players for various reasons, and several were struggling for numbers in the Colts, Reserves and Womens on a regular basis. Because of this, and the shorter season, last years agreement with the GNJFL for juniors to play up was suspended until 2021, and we saw an influx of Under 16s pulling on the boots in the Colts competition – some really great talent coming through for next year.

The competition started mid-July, instead of our usual April start, and the season consisted of 10 rounds plus finals. Round one began with only 4 out of 7 of the men's teams playing, the remaining three with a Bye.

Our GNWFL competition continued into its third season this year, finishing with a nail-biter of a Grand Final that only had one kick in it, resulting in Brigades defeating Chapman Valley by 3 points right on the siren. The level of skill in our women's competition has grown massively over the past three years and we are hopeful that they continue to build their skills in the years to come.

This year, the GNJFL also introduced a Youth Girls competition. So much talent was uncovered throughout the clubs and things are looking very promising for our GNWFL in the future.

With no country week or other carnivals to participate in, all clubs were able to focus on the GNFL competition and battle it out for the premiership flag. At the end of Round 10, Rovers sat in top spot for both League and Reserves, whilst Brigades and Chapman Valley were top of the ladder for Colts and Womens respectively - 3 out of 4 of the ladder leaders were undefeated for 2020, which is an amazing effort by all involved.

The JJ Clune Awards Night is always a highlight of the GNFL calendar, although this year saw some restrictions, due once again to Covid-19. With restricted numbers in attendance, this year we celebrated our best players, umpires and volunteers and gave them the recognition they deserve.

The vote count saw the 11th Rovers player in GNFL history, Tom Denton, to receive the JJ Clune medal with a 7-point victory over Railways' gun player, Ben Saunders. Denton won several other awards on the night, including the Geraldton Guardian Writer's Award and the Spalding Park Pro Coaches Player of the Year. Tom also won the West Coast Poly Player of the Year for the WACFL, which is a huge honour and very well deserved.

In Reserves, Northampton's Kasey Hasleby won by 6 votes, Colts saw Brigades' Brendan Cockman take out the President's Medal by 7 votes, and Towns' Aaliyah Jones took out the Women's Best & Fairest by just 1 vote in the last round over a tie for second by Jess Giudice-Nairn and Julia Teakle.

Other award winners for the evening were Richard Barlett (Chapman Valley), who won the Rising Star award, Mitchell Thompson (Chapman Valley), who won the East Fremantle Football Club Rookie of the Year, and Stephen Trent (Rovers), who won the Volunteer of the Year award.

The week before the Grand Final proved stressful to all involved – extra hand hygiene stations, social distancing measures needed to be put in place and a whole heap of Covid-19-related paperwork was required so the day could go ahead. The day arrived and was a huge success, with a huge crowd of over 2500 people coming through the gate.

With an early start for Colts, we saw the top two sides, Brigades and Rovers, go into battle. Brigades were strong from the very first bounce, walking away with a 53-point victory, with the President's Best on Ground Medal awarded to Luke Kanny.

In the Reserves, Chapman Valley played Northampton, and the Valley took out their very first Reserves Premiership in the clubs' history, defeating Northampton by 38 points. Valley's Jay O'Brien was awarded the Charlie Comeagain Medal for Best on Ground.

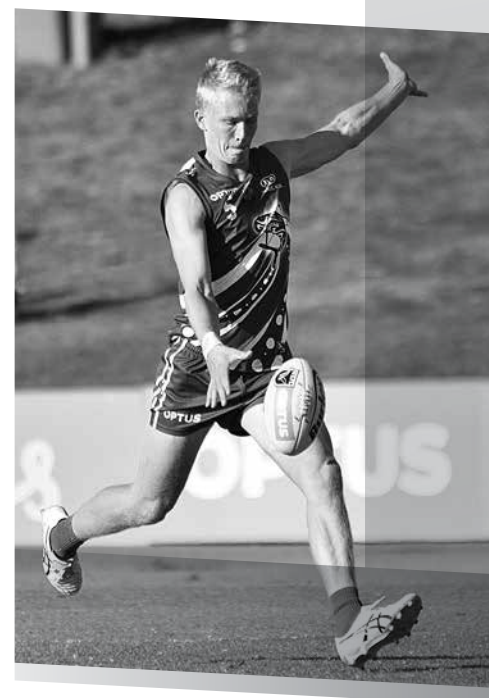
