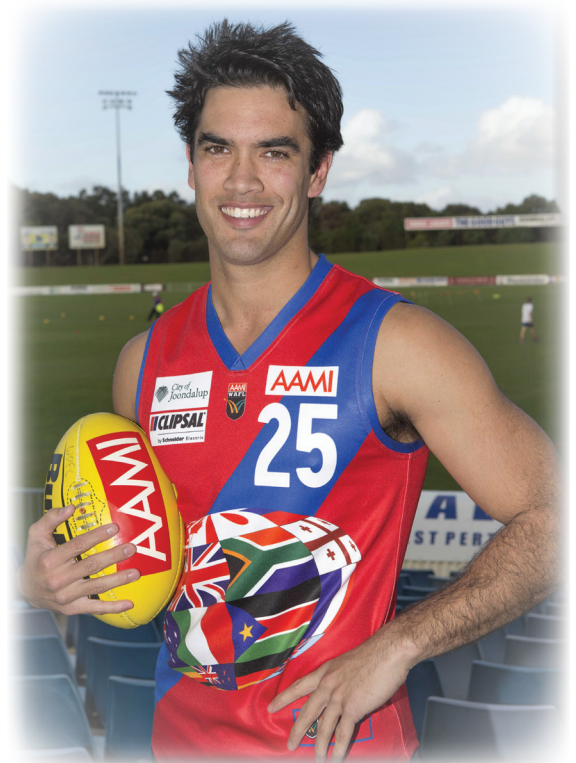


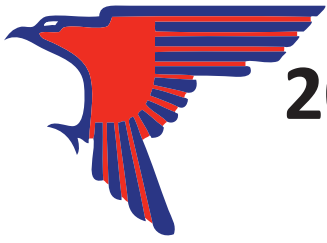

2014 Falcons International Round Design a Jumper Competition

The West Perth Football Club invites you to enter the 2014 Falcons International Round “Design a Jumper” competition.

Our unique “International Round” was created to recognise and celebrate the huge multicultural population that live and work in Perth’s northern corridor. The definition of “Multicultural” is a person either born overseas or has at least one parent who was born overseas. In both the City of Joondalup and City of Wanneroo we work with a large contingent of nationalities within our population including:

- 41% were born overseas (Australian average 20%)
- 25% come from the United Kingdom
(9 of our 28 suburb areas have a UK Population greater than 38%)
- 7% come from a non-English speaking background (includes Afghani, Indian, and African Continent descent).
- 9% of the local population have migrated to Australia in the last 3 years

Please find below the guidelines for our Design a Jumper Competition. We look forward to enjoying the creativity from your school.

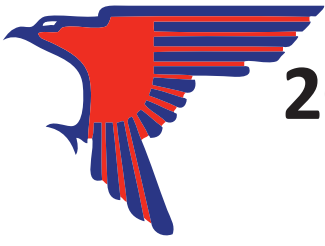
Competition Details:

- This is a schools competition. Students must be enrolled in Year 1-7 at a participating school located within the Falcons District
- We will accept a maximum of two entries per class
- Entries must be submitted on the A4 template provided with coloured pencils being the preferred medium
- Entries must be accompanied by a brief reflection on the reasons for the design. Students are encouraged to describe the artistic, cultural or geographical influences including their school population demographics when constructing their design
- In honouring the West Perth Football Club’s rich history and tradition we ask that the design incorporate the club’s “Red and Royal Blue” colours and encourage the traditional blue sash to remain present in some form.
- The winning design may be modified to suit reproduction requirements.
- Entries close 5.00pm Friday 6 June 2014

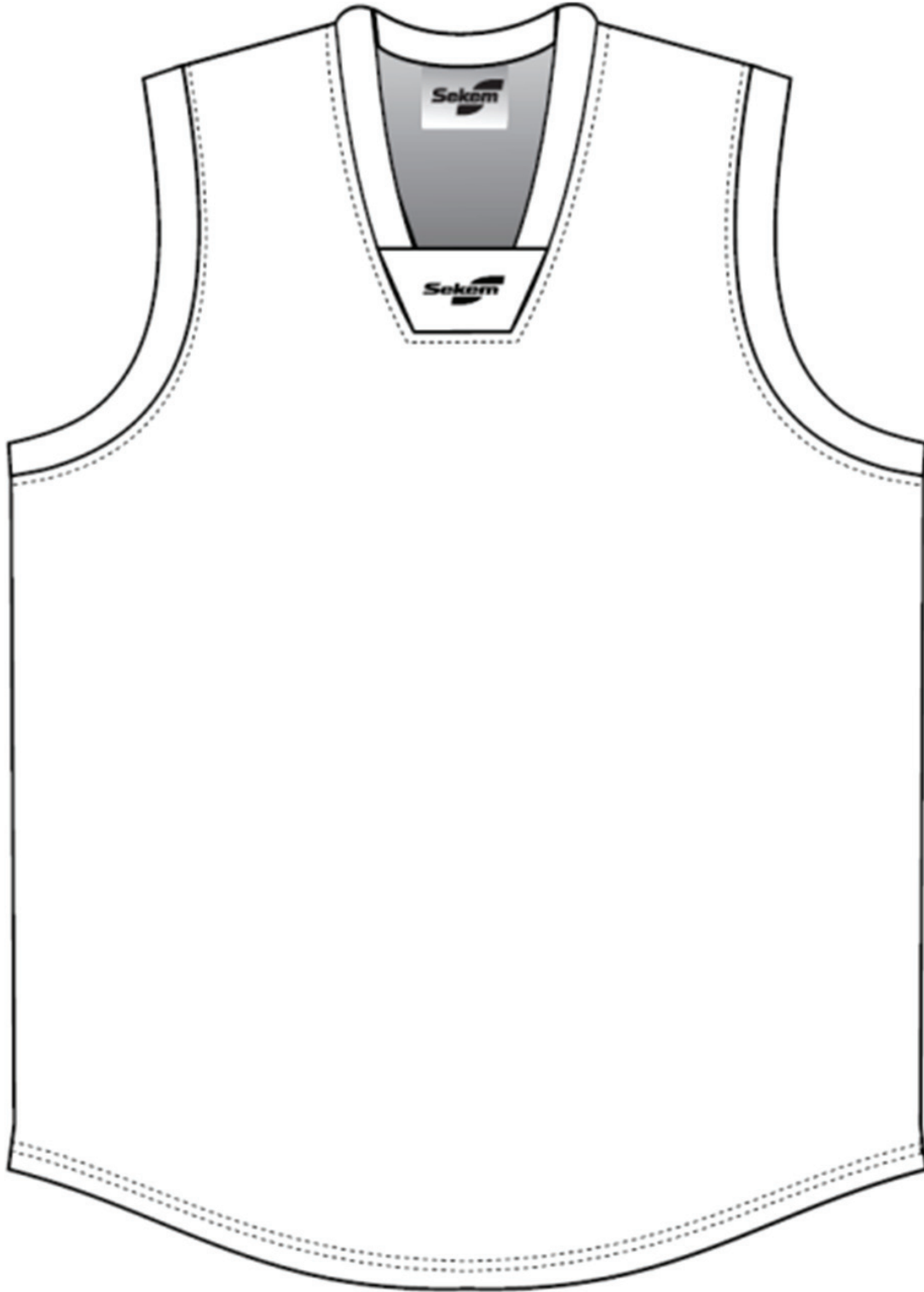
Entries will be judged by representatives from the West Perth Football Club, WA Football Commission and the Falcons District. No correspondence will be entered into regarding selection of the winning entry.
