### COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Entries must be completed on the **template provided** (limited to 6 colours per design).
- Entries must be accompanied by a reflection on the reasons for the design.
- The competition is open exclusively to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.
- Maximum of **one entry** per person.

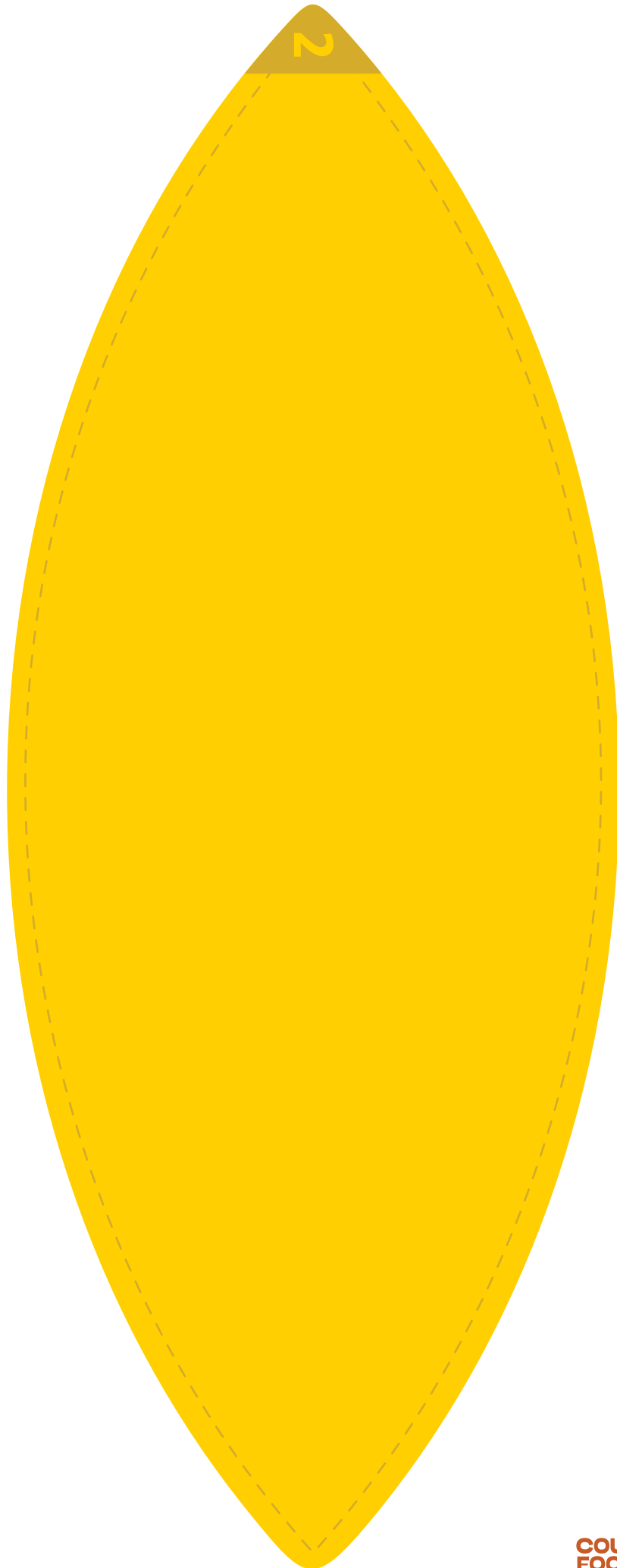

This competition has been made possible through Country Football WA's partnership with the Insurance Commission of Western Australia, with the aim to promote the Belt Up road safety campaign.

The Insurance Commission's aim is to raise awareness across all communities about the importance of wearing a seat belt. Its Belt Up road safety campaign has a key focus on regional WA, which is overrepresented in motor injury insurance claims, and specifically not wearing a seat belt.

The winning design will be judged and announced in December 2023 and will be used on the Belt Up NAIDOC footballs for season 2024.
