

1.3.1 Father / Son

If a player's father satisfies at least one of the following criteria

- a) Played in 50 or more League matches with the East Perth Football Club.
- b) Played at East Perth Football Club for a combined total of 85 League or Reserve grade matches in at least five football seasons
- c) Been elected as a Life Member of the East Perth Football Club.
- d) Held a full time administrative position at the East Perth Football Club for a combined period (if employment is broken) of 10 years shall qualify for his son's to play at the East Perth Football Club under this rule.
- e) Qualified for and been drafted to the AFL (or recruited by an AFL team prior to the draft) from the East Perth Football Club and then played 50 AFL games or 85 AFL and State League games (as a listed AFL player) combined, over 5 years, in the same way as a) and b) above relate to WAFL League and Reserves games.

1.3.2 Grandfather / Grandson

If a player's grandfather satisfies at least one of the following criteria:

- a) Played in 50 or more League team matches with the East Perth Football Club
- b) Played at East Perth Football Club for a combined total of 85 League or Reserve grade matches in at least five football seasons
- c) Been elected as a Life Member of the East Perth Football Club.
- d) Held a full time administrative position at the East Perth Football Club for a combined period (if employment is broken) of 10 years shall qualify for his son's to play at the East Perth Football Club under this rule.
- e) Qualified for and been drafted to the AFL (or recruited by an AFL team prior to the draft) from the East Perth Football Club and then played 50 AFL games or 85 AFL and State League games (as a listed AFL player) combined, over 5 years, in the same way as a) and b) above relate to WAFL League and Reserves games.

1.3.3 Brother / Brother

This rule is only to apply where brothers are forced to play with different WAFL clubs due to changes in the WAFL club allocated zones.

If a player's brother satisfies the following criteria:

- a) The first brother must have played his first game prior to reaching 19 years of age: and
- b) Both brothers must have the same Mother and/or Father: and
- c) The first brother must be a registered member and playing either Colts, Reserves or League level at the time of application, or has progressed onto AFL level through that WAFL club; or
- d) The first brother has played at least 50 League games or played in one Club for a combined total of 85 League or Reserves grade matches in at least five football seasons.
