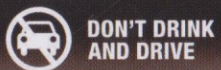

A BRIEF HISTORY

Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL has grown from what started as a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In its 95th year with 69 clubs, 240 teams and over 10,000 registered players, the WAAFL caters for players as young as 16 years to provide a quality high standard competition whilst accommodating considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

For many players the WAAFL provides a superior football competition for those not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study commitments, career commitments or simply a lifestyle that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The WAAFL is also the beginning point for many well-known WAFL and AFL personnel, starting their careers in amateur football and becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

High profile players and our Colts League name-sakes include Phil Scott, Drew Banfield, Laurie Keene, Brett Jones and two-time Sandover Medallist Ian Dargie all who played for the West Coast Eagles.

Other household names, and current AFL players, include Tendai Mzungu (Fremantle) and Nick Kommer (Essendon)

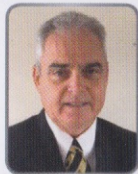

On Wednesday August 31 the WAAFL hosted the seventh annual Hall of Champions function. The Hall of Champions honours those individuals who have made long, significant and commendable contributions to the WAAFL, to help make it the strong and respected sporting body that it is today. This year the WAAFL inducted three new members into the Hall of Champions.

Bill Duckworth first began his involvement with the WAAFL in 1977 as a Colts' player for WAIT (now Curtin Uni Wesley).

He was picked up by the Essendon Football Club where he played 126 games and kicked 64 goals. He was a premiership player in 1984 and 1985 including a Norm Smith Medallist in the 1984 Grand Final. In 1993 Bill joined the North Beach Amateur Football Club where he played 33 games and kicked 16 goals. He won a premiership with the club in 1993. He coached at North Beach from 1996 to 2012. In this time, he coached teams to ten premierships including seven consecutively from 2004 to 2010. He then coached the D1 side from 2014-2015 making the Grand Final on both occasions. All teams coached by Bill have participated in finals.

Bill Duckworth was awarded Life Membership of the North Beach Amateur Football Club in 2005. He is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a Champion.

Michael Salmon played 154 games for the University Football Club. He played in his first premiership in 1974 in the A Colts competition.

In 1975 Michael played in University's A Grade premiership and was selected in the state amateur representative team. In the same year he won the A Grade leading goal kicking award with 103 goals for the season. He went on to play in University's A Grade premierships in 1975 and 1977 before being picked up by WAFL club Claremont in 1979.

Between 1979 and 1980 Michael played in Claremont's league and reserves side including the Claremont Reserves premiership in 1980. He returned to the University Football Club in 1981 where he played and coached the A Grade side to another premiership while being selected as Vice-Captain in the state amateur representative team and winning the inaugural B.J. Giles Medal as the best player in the A Grade Grand Final.

He again coached the University team in 1982 and was selected as Captain of the All Australian Amateur Team following the carnival held in Perth. He was also selected as vice-captain of the all Australian team that played Vic Country in 1983.

In 1985 Michael was selected as Vice-Captain in University's Best 25 Year Team. In 1986 he played in University's F Grade Premiership as well as their I Grade premiership in 1988.

Michael Salmon finished with six premiership medals with three of those in A Grade. He was a four-time State Amateur Representative as well as being selected twice in the All Australian Amateur Team, once as Captain and once as Vice-Captain.

He was the inaugural chairman of the metropolitan football league council serving from 1996 to 2002. Michael is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a Champion.

Shane Beros began his football with the WAAFL in 1996 with the West Coast Amateur Football Club. He spent two seasons with West Coast, representing the state in both years before being recruited to the Swan Districts Football Club in 1998. He made his debut for Swan Districts playing 18 games and kicking 11 goals.

He finished his WAFL career in 2008 with 193 games to his name and kicked 112 goals. He won the 2003 Sandover Medal and finished as a runner up in 2004. He won two Swan Medals as Swan Districts Best and Fairest in 2003 and 2005. Shane was also Captain of the Swan Districts Football Club from 2003-2006.

In 2009 Shane joined the Mount Lawley Amateur Football Club where his brother Damon was playing. He assisted Mount Lawley in winning the B Grade Grand Final which allowed them to be elevated into A Grade the following year. He won the WAAFL B Grade Best and Fairest and was judged as the Best on Ground in the Grand Final.

In 2010 he coached the Mount Lawley A Grade side finishing just one game out of the finals. He returned to coach the side again in 2011 finishing on top of the ladder before losing the Grand Final to University. This Grand Final appearance is the best A Grade effort for Mount Lawley since their run of premierships in the late 80's and early 90's.

Shane is inducted into the Hall of Champions as a High Achiever.

WAAFL INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

In 2016 Integrated Football continued on its way delivering on two key fronts, Participation and Competition. Seven Teams, Coolbinia West Perth, High Wycombe, Kingsway, Wembley, Warnbro, and Fremantle CBC Gold and Green participated in regular fixtures with all teams playing a minimum of twelve home and away games.

This season Integrated matches were played for the first time on Friday nights in addition to regular Saturday afternoons following senior football with occasional games on Sundays. Player registrations have now reached 190 with strong growth across all teams.

For a number of seasons, the West Coast Eagles Football Club extend a Curtain Raiser to the program providing just over fifty Integrated players the opportunity to play before a WCE home game at Domain Stadium. In 2016 this was held on June 11 prior to the Eagles v Adelaide game, enhanced by the appearance of WCE Star Mitch Brown who has become a most welcome member of the Integrated Football Family providing support and knowledge.

At the completion of the 2015 National Inclusion Carnival WA had two players from the State Team, David Hallows and Lyndsy Ashworth from the Coolbinia West Perth AFC selected in the 2015 All Australian All Abilities AFL Team.

On Friday 29 July our two All Australian nominees together with Program Co-Ordinator Greg Gilbee flew to Canberra to play in the first ever All Australian All Abilities exhibition game at Manuka Oval. This was another first for Footballers with Intellectual Disabilities, it was a fantastic reward and opportunity for our WA Players who enjoyed and excelled in the match, David receiving the Coaches Award.

Due to financial constraints WA did not send a team to the 2016 AFL National Inclusion Carnival, however it was imperative that the skill development of upper echelon players continued to occur.

The High Performance Academy was set up in 2016 for aspiring players to build on their skills and abilities. Coached by 2015 State Integrated Coach Jamie Wynne with Dave Wright as his assistant.

The Academy is not just about improving playing skills, it is also providing whole of football education incorporating other aspects of the game, umpiring, coaching, volunteering, peer mentoring and respect.

From May to August the HP academy trained at Robinson Reserve Tuart Hill each Monday fortnight.

Jamie and Dave have been supported by Mitch Brown at many of the sessions, setting a challenging program for the participants who have eagerly accepted and are rapidly improving skills, fitness and most importantly respect for the game.

A highlight of the program was a session by WAFC Umpire Manager Darryl Sinclair and WA AFL Field Umpire Luke Farmer. The session touched on respect, behavior and laws, with Mitch Brown also in attendance.

Saturday 6 August Integrated Football were welcomed to the WAFL, where HP Academy played an exhibition game at Kingsway following the Subiaco v West Perth.

Osborne Park AFC also have been involved in the High Performance Academy, joining the guys on the track for an all-inclusive session.

Integrated Football has much to look forward to, it has evolved into a vibrant, sustainable program that recognizes the tremendous work done by volunteers at WAAFL Club level who provide the environment and supportive surrounds, additionally the financial contribution by Dept. of Sport towards the High Performance Academy, West Coast Eagles and Mitch Brown, Disability Services Commission, National Disability Insurance Scheme and Inclusion WA.

The West Coast Eagles State U23 Amateur Team headed to Queensland and Tasmania over the first weekend in June.

The first game against Queensland on Friday 3 June saw WA win by fourteen points in wet conditions. With the rain coming down hard inaccurate kicking in the third quarter from the Queensland side allowed WA to get a handy lead.

Taylor, Malone and Mackenzie all kicked two goals for WA with Jaime Rudrum voted Best on Ground for the WA team.

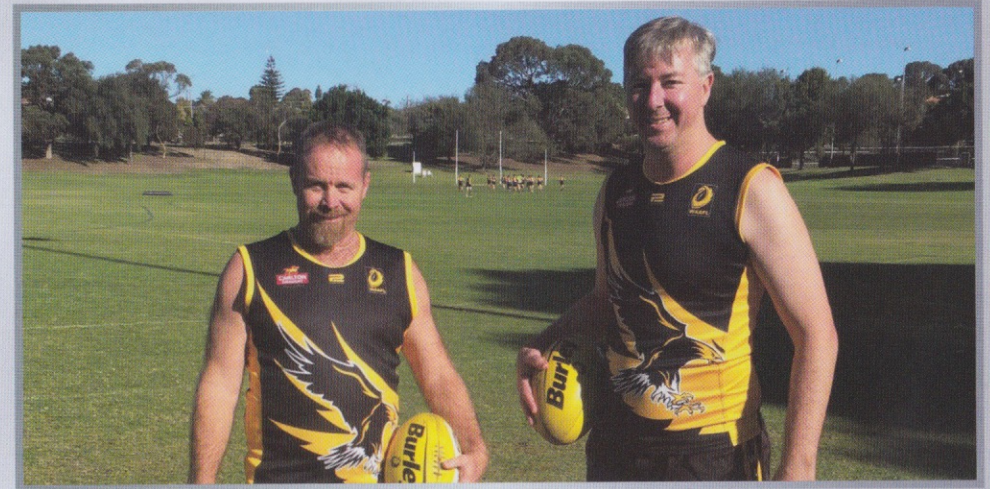
With a twenty-three-point advantage at half time the WAAFL held on to their lead in the third quarter kicking a further two goals.

SIGNIFICANT GAME MILESTONES FOR OCEAN RIDGE PLAYERS MATT AND TODD



Ocean Ridge Amateur Football Club players Matt Vickers and Todd Corderoy celebrated significant milestones when they stepped onto the field on Saturday 25 June.

Matt Vickers played his 450th game while Todd Corderoy played his 350th match for the club.

Matt Vickers or as he is known 'Vicko' started at Ocean Ridge AFC in 1989, aged 16. He was part of the inaugural Colts team after being recruited by the coach at the time; Wayne "Cowboy" Elliot. Since this time Vicko has continued to play under a long list of inspiring coaches, has learnt valuable lessons from his teammates and has also created great memories along the way.

"My most memorable moments would be playing in the 2006 Reserves and 2011 Thirds premierships" Vicko said.

He has also noticed a substantial shift in the culture of the club over the years and integration of the much loved sport of footy in the local community.

"Having played football with hundreds of guys over the years, and knowing the valuable volunteers who give so much, I am proud that the club has remained

strong, adding a third senior side, maintaining our colts team, having a great supporters club, and a committee as eager as any we've had" Vicko said.

Todd Corderoy (TC) played his first game at ORAFC in 1994 at the age of 17. TC's attitude has always resonated around the idea that it's not what the football club can do for the teammates, but rather what the teammates can do for the club.

"I've been lucky to see so many quality players through the years and as a player I've had favourite coaches, but my biggest desire has always been to play with and for the 21 other guys who are all wearing the ORAFC colours".

TC's most memorable moments at the club include his 300th game, which was also played with Matt Vickers, and will always consider ORAFC as "a great place to play footy, make good mates and push yourself as hard as you are able to".

Ocean Ridge AFC President Jon Knox said that "Vicko and TC have both been significant contributors to the development and growth of the Club, not only on field but also off field with both sitting on the Clubs Executive for extensive periods".

UMPIRES CLOCK UP 1000 GAME MILESTONES

Goal Umpire Robert Cox and Field Umpire Ronald Roebuck both celebrated reaching their 1000 game milestones in season 2016.

Robert Cox began goal umpiring 27 years ago with the WAAFL where his first season of goal umpiring saw him umpire two games in the then G Grade competition.

Goal Umpiring was a role that Robert fell into after training with his local side the Riverton Football Club. When the club needed a Goal Umpire Robert was asked to fill this position on a volunteer basis before someone suggested he should join the WAAFL.

It wasn't long before he worked his way up to the top competition where he has since umpired 191 A Grade games closely followed by 163 B Grade games.

Throughout his career as a goal umpire Robert has umpired both Men's and Women's football as well as being selected to umpire a State Game in 2009. He has goal umpired in 18 Grand Finals the highest

grade being B Grade which he umpired in both 2005 and 2011.

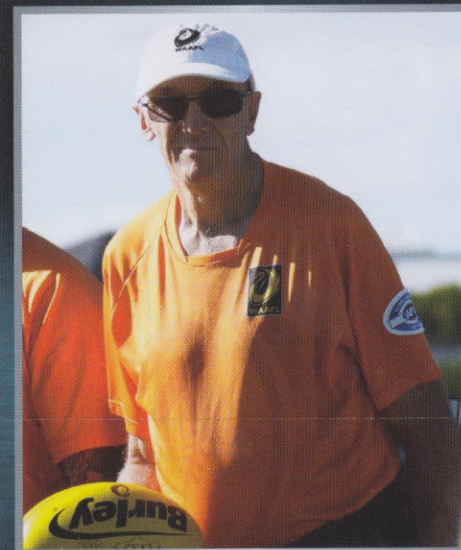
Field Umpire Ronald Roebuck umpired the Ballajura Football Club D2 Reserves and D2 League matches this year.

Ronald began field umpiring 35 years ago with the WAAFL where in his first season he umpired ten colts' games as well as a D Grade and G Grade Match.

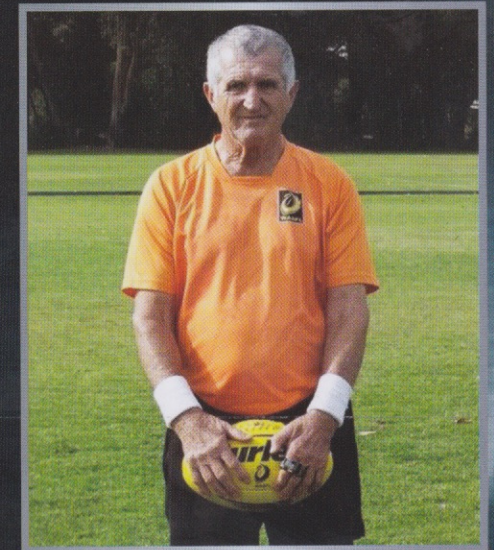
Throughout his 35 years of umpiring Ronald has umpired twelve Grand Finals, ten of those with the Sunday Football League and two with the WA Amateur Football League.

BASILE CLAIMS TOP MEDAL AT WAAFL AWARDS

On Wednesday 31 August over 800 players, officials and VIP's packed the Crown Ballroom to celebrate the 2016 WA Amateur Football League Season.

One of the biggest nights on the WAAFL calendar sees the football guernsey's swapped for suits as the league recognises those who have excelled throughout the year.

This year's presentation saw Fremantle CBC's Christopher Basile awarded the CJ Jamieson Medal as the A Grade Best and Fairest for 2016.

Chris claimed the medal after polling 22 votes in just eight rounds including an impressive six best on ground performances. A runner up in both 2014 and 2015 Chris finally got the recognition he deserved.

Last year's winner Bradley Nisbett from the West Coast Amateur Football Club finished as runner up with 18 votes, while 2016 leading goal kicker Marc Re from Scarborough finished in third with 16 votes.

David McKinlay from the Mt Lawley Amateur Football Club won the TR Howard Medal for the B Grade best and fairest just minutes after he claimed the B Grade Leading Goal Kicker award. The award was a tie with his brother Adam McKinlay and Wembley's Tim Noakes who all kicked 57 goals for the season.

Other winners included Kingsley's Andrew Fisher who made it back to back wins in C1 while Klinton Williams from Curtin Uni Wesley also took out the A Reserves medal for the second time in a row.

The NK Donaldson medal for the Phil Scott Colts competition went to Harrison Whiteside of Curtin Uni Wesley. After five best on ground performances Harrison won the award by three votes. Harrison makes it back to back medals after taking out the award in 2015.

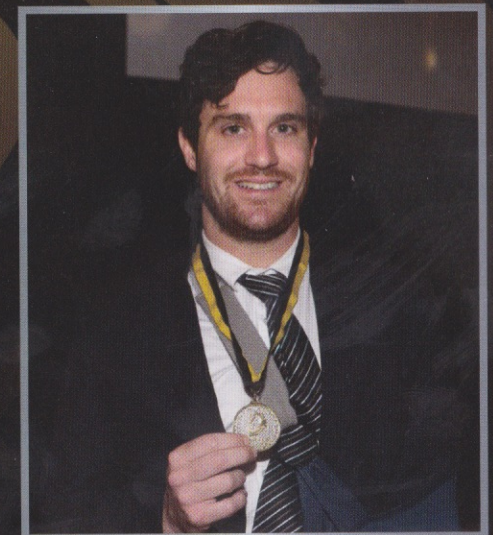
The night not only honours the best and fairest players from the various grades but also recognises

the achievements of clubs, administrators and umpires throughout the 2016 season.

The Ron Webster Memorial award for the senior champion club was awarded to University Football Club and the TK Naylor award for the Colts champion club was awarded to both Wanneroo and Willetton. The champion club awards are calculated by both on and off field points with points awarded for each win, meeting attendance, payments, paperwork submitted on time. Points are deducted for send offs and for match day fines.
