PRESIDENTS REPORT 1991

Not only did the players, coach Paul Rafter and the support staff achieve a unique personal highlight, they gave all members of our league a credibility in Australian Amateur football that had only ever been dreamt of. On behalf of all our members, and those who enjoy our great game, thank you to all those involved in achieving the ultimate at our level of football.

A critical part of our success was the support given financially by the Government, through the Ministry of Sport and Recreation and also the W.A. Football Commission and the Subiaco and Claremont Football Clubs.

With the euphoria slowly passing we must now concentrate on one of our short term objectives; to maintain our place in this states football system or indeed improve it !.

The very tough economic times have placed a lot of pressure on some of our clubs and we must work hard to support each other. 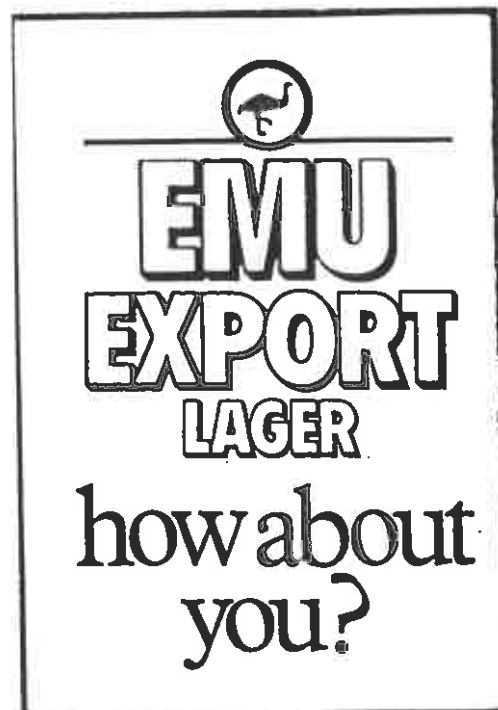

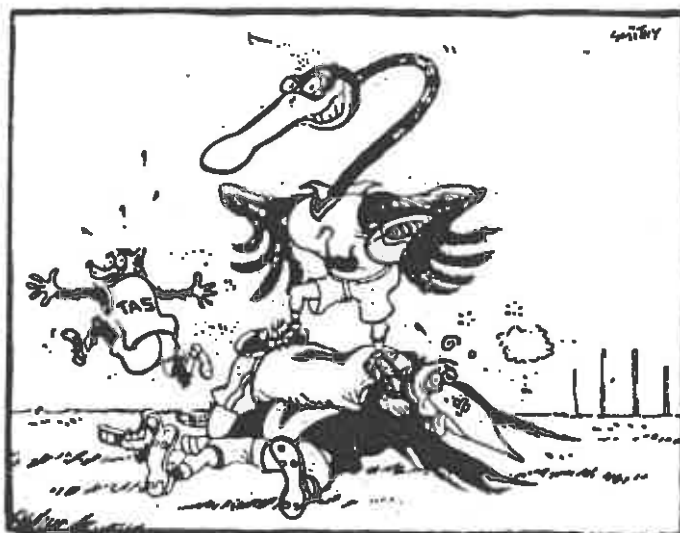
