Game Day Environment

- A positive game day environment leads to more enjoyment for our junior players.
- **By-Law 40.3-** WA Football supports a **ZERO TOLERANCE** stance against **any form of umpiring or officials abuse.**
- Any breaches of these codes will result in penalties and sanctions directed at the person responsible, the team and possibly the club.

Umpire Respect

- The Demons District JCC Umpire Policy is as follows:
- Before the start of play and at the conclusion of the game, **all players, coaches, parent and association umpires** should shake hands.
- The spirit and intention is to make sure all games are played in a competitive and fair manner.
- **By-Law 45.9-** Only the Captain or Team Manager from either team can approach an Umpire during breaks in a match, and may only do so for an interpretation of a ruling (not an argument!)

Year 7 Competition

- The Year 7 Competition in the Royals District is still part of the 'modified' age group and will be played as a 15 a side competition (3 lines of 5 players).
- There will unlimited interchange. The use of the 'interchange app' is not compulsory, however each player **must** play at least 50% of the game time (This will be monitored by the JCC).
- The even up bylaw will apply in any instance where a team does not have 15 players. **Numbers on field should always be even.**
- A player is permitted to bounce the ball twice prior to disposing of the ball.
- Players are not permitted to deliberately kick the ball off the ground or use feet to control the ball whilst it is on the ground.
- No 'Fairest & Best' voting will be to be undertaken. Only participation, effort and skill achievement programs.
- All other rules as per the 'Year 7' flowchart in the 2017 Junior Club manual

All Competitions

AFL/WAFL rules apply except for:

Players are required to wait for the flags to be waved before the ball is kicked back in

No free kick from a deliberate rush behind

3rd Man up rule will apply,

Players are not required to nominate

If a “3rd” player gets in involved in the contest, a free kick will be awarded

Match Day Checklist

- Ensure ground is marked correctly, including interchange if Yr 7.
- If you are the first game check the oval for foreign objects.
- Ensure all fixed goal posts are padded prior to the match commencing.
- Ensure all officials are ready for commencement of match.
- Ensure the time keeper knows the correct times (incl. break times).
- Ensure STG team sheet has been done prior to commencement.
- Ensure umpires receive water during breaks.
- Ensure you have the correct information for STG at end of game.
- The EPDFDC Team Managers Checklist will be distributed and will also be available on the EPDFDC Competition Directory
