2023 was a year of tremendous growth for the East Perth Football Club both on and off the field.

Reflecting on the past 12 months, the Club has achieved many significant milestones, none bigger than East Perth competing in the WAFLW for the first time. The significant time and resources the Club has invested into this program has led to a foundation being laid that will see rapid and continued success.

The club now has in excess of 350 players registered to play for East Perth across male, female and all-abilities programs. Excitingly, this number will continue to grow as we increase our talent programs through various academies in both our metro and country regions.

We aim to deliver these programs whilst being not-for-profit. This season, I am pleased to report that the Club has bounced back to be in the black. The Club will report an operating profit surplus of \$32,344.

This is a remarkable achievement given our current climate and that the club had budgeted for a \$28,000 loss for FY23. Some contributing factors to this were:

- Record gate receipts
- Increased merchandise sales
- Significant revenue received for events and functions

Our loyal members and supporters gave both our male and female teams

tremendous support throughout the year. In our inaugural season, we had the highest home and away attendance of any WAFLW club. Our male gate receipts had the highest increase of the WAFL competition. Playing an exciting brand of football that is successful is a key element of our growth.

We will continue to seek ways to improve facilities for our players and members. Upgrading the lighting and surface at Leederville Oval remains a priority. Having our senior male, women's and male talent based across three different venues, whilst necessary at the moment, is far from ideal. In the short term, we are focusing on improving these three locations with our long-term vision to be a dedicated training and community base to compliment an upgraded Leederville Oval.

The results we were able to achieve through our fundraising endeavours this year were incredible. I wish to thank our many partners and contributors to those functions. Not only do they provide much needed support for our football operations, but they are also a lot of fun.

I wish to thank Bronte and the Board for their guidance and support throughout 2023. Significant strategic decisions and commitments have been made over the past 18 months to ensure the Club is on the right path.

The Club is fortunate to have the hardest working and most dedicated group of staff in the WAFL, regularly going over and above to not only make sure that expectations are met but are consistently exceeded.

I wrote this time last year that the building blocks of success are there. I would like to congratulate Ross McQueen on reaching the finals in his first year as coach. We all acknowledge and embrace the rising expectations around our performance in 2023. Consistency in matches and from week to week is something we will strive for throughout the Club in season 2024.

We then dropped the next three games going into the bye, before bouncing back winning eight games in a row, including wins over West Perth on WA Day, (game interrupted by lightning), East Fremantle six days later and Peel Thunder in Mandurah.

We finished the home and away season in fourth position, which meant we were playing finals. A disappointing loss in the first round of the finals resulted in our season being over.

Across the club, highlights included the Reserves winning at Bassendean over the eventual premiers, the Colts challenging East Fremantle, Subiaco, West Perth and Perth, all of who played in the finals, the first season of our WAFLW team, the Rogers Cup team playing in the finals and terrific results for our Futures program.

Hamish Brayshaw, Mitchell Crowden, Angus Schumacher and Angus Scott represented our state, with Schuey winning the Club's first Simpson Medal since Paul Johnson in 2012. Hamish Brayshaw won the 2023 Sandover Medal, we returned to the finals and we had stronger engagement with our

supporters with attendances up 25%.

We achieved a lot of our goals, learnt plenty along the way and I am confident that we can build on these successes. We want more, we need more, we demand more.

We do need to continue to improve. We need to be more consistent. We had a few games where we played well, but we also had a few games where we underperformed. We need to develop our own and improve our depth. Injuries happen. Defend better to allow us to stay in games longer and build our relationships in the community. We have a lot of young, talented men and women with terrific character, and, I believe, that we have the potential to be a force in 2024 and beyond.

Challenges and opportunities will present themselves; we all know there are no guarantees in football though, but we will be there being the best versions of ourselves striving for success.

I have been reflecting on season 2023 with pride - and with great feelings of gratitude towards the East Perth Footy Club and the amazing people who support the colts program. Whilst our on-field results were a little less than perfect - we only managed four wins after starting the season with great promise - those outcomes are not reflective of the positive environment created by the coaching and support

Our season seemed like a series of 'near misses' and close losses - between Round 9 and the end of the year we managed just two wins...but lost only one game by more than 18-points. Whilst it was incredibly frustrating to be "IN" so many games without walking away with the points, it was at the same time incredibly encouraging - we dropped games to the grand final sides Perth (three points) and Claremont (eight points) and our best footy was clearly 'good enough'.

There is a highly talented group of young players coming through the ranks.

57 players pulled on the jumper during the 2023 season - players from both the South-West and Lower South-West regions, as well as from our Metro zone. We are incredibly lucky to have access to so many talented young players and to receive the support of the coaches and administrators from each of our aligned clubs.

Special thanks should go to the Augusta Margaret River Football and Netball Club who hosted the 2023 Colts pre-season camp.

The highlight of the camp was without doubt the efforts of our physiotherapist, Adrian Rapattoni.

Adrian managed to forget to take ANY of his sleeping gear - and huddled up on the floor in the changerooms under a beach towel... then attended the morning rehab and completed the cold water 'therapy' along with the players.

During the National U18 Championships in 2023 four of our squad members - Tyler Lindberg, Bailey Harbour, Xavier Walsh and Lucas Kemp were selected in the West Australian squad.

I know these players really loved the experience and I am sure everything they learned will really help push their football to another level in 2024 as they move into the senior program. I would like to congratulate Xavier on his selection to Port Adelaide in the Rookie Draft and wish him every success in his AFL journey.

My long-lasting memory of the 2023 season will be the support the footy club provided myself and the colts program.

Every club in Australia talks about having a 'one-club' model, where everyone is working together towards a common goal - East Perth truly lives it.

The integration of the senior squad and colts program each Monday and Thursday night from the midpoint of the season is - simply - the best thing I have seen in nearly 20-years of coaching U18 football.

Providing our talented young players with access to the senior coaches - and with opportunities to build relationships with the senior players - simply doesn't happen at any other club.

East Perth is trying to do something that is both unique and inspired and I have no doubt this genuine 'ONE Club' approach will support us into the future as we strive for success in all grades.



PAST PLAYERS & OFFICIALS REPORT

With all three grades returned to the Club, our 70 members continued support and involvement during the 2023 season including;

- A \$3000 donation towards trophies on Awards Night for all three codes.
- \$1500 donated towards a new TV to display memorabilia photographs.
- \$50 at each home game as a Reserves player achievement award, outlaying a total of \$400.
- A sausage sizzle for our Colts Team and opposition players at each home game.
- Subway rolls to the tune of \$560 for Reserves players at the close of their home games.

These activities and the hosting of half-time fellowships with East Perth members and opposition members were in turn supported by generously supplied donations from Princi Butchers, Charles Musca (raffle prizes), Jon Mellowship liquor supplies, Mount Lawley Subway and Mount Lawley Hardware Store, plus various local retailers.

As a direct result, we were able to present a good standard of catering (thanks in particular to Julie) and excellent raffle prizes at all home games whilst controlling costs.

Financially, our income comprised Members' subs \$2300 of Members' donations \$2315, special fundraising of \$1000 from selected members and Raffle sales of \$5120 that were kicked along by a special gate raffle offering accommodation at the Crown, courtesy of Travel Key.

Because we also strongly support the WAFL Combined Past Players in their endeavours of contributing to grassroots footy, we have

also been pro-active in;

- Extending a Coach's Award to both Reserves and Colts players at each WAFL club.
- Providing Leederville Oval for Combined PP Committee meetings.
- Arranging an annual Ascot Race Day with complementary WATC members' facilities.

Personal appreciation is extended to our PP Committee and helpers for their combined efforts and we look forward to continuing our support of the Club in 2024 and welcoming new members.

We were all treated to some outstanding footy during the past season even though we fell short & did not take our chance of a Grand Final appearance that was there in each of the last four games.
