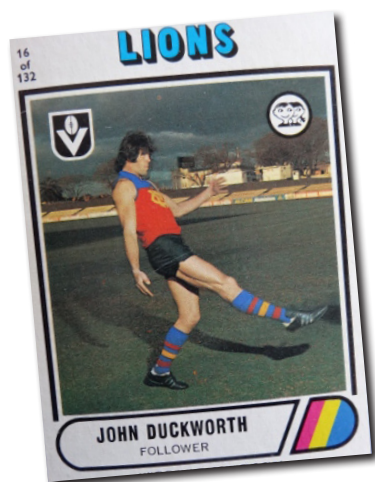

JOHN DUCKWORTH

Born 19 January 1949, John started his football career in Victoria with Fitzroy, whilst in Melbourne due to National Service training.

John played 58 games for Fitzroy before returning to WA in 1977 where he joined West Perth. He played 44 games for West Perth over two years before being picked up by SANFL club Central District where in his debut season, won the Magarey Medal as the leagues fairest and most brilliant player.

The end of the 1980 season saw John return to West Perth to finish his career, ultimately playing 120 games for West Perth.

BILL DUCKWORTH

Born 21 February 1959, an aggressive defender, Bill appeared 35 times for the Cardinals following his debut in 1980.

After two seasons, Bill was recruited by Essendon where he went on to be a dual premiership player in 1984 and 1985, ultimately playing 126 VFL games. It was his heroics in the 1984 Grand Final over Hawthorn that saw him earn a Norm Smith Medal.

Returning at the end of the 1990 season, Bill carried on for a further two years, taking his final games tally for West Perth to 51.
