PRESIDENTS REPORT 1999

With the end of the 1999 season we can say that once again the WAAFL has provided the community with a well managed football competition that has provided a great range of experiences and enjoyment for many hundreds of players, officials and supporters.

The WAAFL competition provides opportunities for footballers to participate at a level equal with their abilities. People from a wide range of vocations choose to assist in the running of amateur clubs by becoming club officials and administrators also clubs provide an excellent point for social interaction for their many players, officials and followers.

On behalf of the WAAFL management committee many thanks to those people who volunteered their time to make sure our great game thrives at the grass roots level, with success enjoyed through winning games and the ultimate yard stick, a premiership and by the players who won individual awards.

Whilst the amateurs representative senior and colts teams had limited success in games played against other leagues it once again provided young players with the opportunity to expose their ability to talent scouts from various Westar clubs.

Club officials have voted to resume interstate football as soon as practicable. The WAAFL has become party to a resolution to reform the Australian Amateur Football Council in order to play regular interstate games as well as the traditional amateur football carnivals.

Members of the board are fully aware of clubs finding it difficult to meet their financial commitments are appreciative of Qantas for providing a substantial prize for a pre season raffle that enabled clubs to raise valuable funds.

The WAAFL continued to participate in the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council (with SFL, Peel FL, SuperRules and Womens FL) the main purpose the allocation of WAFC funding (via Ministry of Sport) and discussion of grass roots football problems.

Our High Schools Umpire Scheme continues to expand and flourish under the guidance of Bruce Wheatland with over 60 young students participate every week from 4 schools and is likely to expand next season providing a major source of replacing umpires who have retired after many years of service.

The League Panel Umpires once again under the coaching of Mike Ball backed up by Vaughan Veryard (Boundary), Nigel Tilley (Goals) and Stewart Tempest (Fitness) provided excellent service whilst Mr Bruce Wheatland and Reg Statham gave input into our clubs umpires program. Our umpires continue to perform at a very high standard with several under notice to perform at Westar level.

The Swan Brewery and Smith + Nephew continued their long involvement with the amateurs in their sponsorship support.

The WAAFL continues to provide a grass roots football competition with clubs spread over the entire metropolitan area with new clubs Wonderers and Willetton joining us for the first time in 1999 and Belmont amalgamated with Redcliffe and Forrestfield fell by the wayside.

Throughout the year the office staff headed by Executive Officer Neil Judge, Kerry Spencer and Julia Triplett continue to give efficient service. Doug Frame assisted greatly with general duties including umpire appointments posting.

My sincere thanks to all those who served on the Board of Management. Milton Sanders (Vice President), Alan Thomas (Treasurer), Bruce Wainwright (Secretary), David Thompson (Function), Doug Frame, Graham Jacques (Functions), Alan Clements (Radio 6AR), Bob Stow (Radio 6AR), Tony Tarulli (State Football), Mark Herron and Phil Hayes.

Special mention to Alan Thomas for his efforts in revamping our accounting and financial recording prior to his resignation to go overseas. Bob Stow in his short stay with us has provided a great wealth of experience to the board that will be missed.

The WAAFL and all clubs continue to operate with a tireless band of volunteers without whose untiring commitments we would not exist as a successful community based football body to those people my sincere thanks to you all.

UMPIRE ADVISERS REPORT 1999

The umpiring this season has been steady in all three categories i.e. field, boundary and goals. Like all seasons we would like to see faultless displays performed by umpires, even though we strive for it we just can't achieve this goal. The main area the umpires' coaches worked for in this year was for umpires to enjoy their umpiring and have an appreciation for players and coaches, because they are under extreme pressure to perform at their best for their club and supporters.

The training aspect of umpiring was good but can be improved on. The area requiring attention is those umpires who are unable to attend. These umpires not only miss the physical work but also coaching sessions. These coaching sessions are for changes to laws but mainly to rectify faults in their performances. The facilities at Richardson Park are very good and it creates a good atmosphere. The lighting which was improved on at the end of 1998 was superb. This helped Stewie Tempest to plan and run quality sessions.

The association led by Glen England, worked hard to please the umpires in social events and sponsorship. It was pleasing to have the Swan Brewery, Herdsman Hotel and Qantas on board this season. Their help was greatly appreciated. The presentation night on preliminary final night was very successful, and the numbers were great.

Club umpiring was significantly better this year and this can be attributed to Bruce Wheatland, who viewed and gave feedback to these umpires. At the last training session, I was pleased to promote 2 of our colts age players to the Seniors team, Andrew James (Wesley Curtin) and Kane Nitschke (Scarborough). This probably cost the colts team greatly, because they are both good hard ball getters, and we encountered their type of conditions in Mandurah.

The guys that did take the field performed well in a game that did not reach great heights, because of the wet and windy conditions. In a very low scoring game, the WAAFL boys lead narrowly at half time, before the Country side ran over us to record a comfortable victory. Easily best for us was Peter Beck (Wembley), with Grant Cox (Scarborough), Brad Collard (Wesley Curtin) and Barry Harrington (Mt Lawley) also acquitting themselves well.

The second game was on a cold but still night at Joondalup, against the Sunday League colts. In the first half the guys performed brilliantly to set up a commanding 6 goal half time lead. Unfortunately, the SFL snapped into life in the third quarter, to take a narrow lead at the last change, and they were able to hang on and win an entertaining and high standard game by 7 points. Best were Brad Collard (Wesley Curtin), Luke Forrestal (Whitfords), Barry Harrington (Mt Lawley) and Brent Kupsch(Bassendean).

The final game was the annual weekend trip to Geraldton to play the GNFL colts. This was a game that in the end we lost comfortably, but at three quarter time we had equal scoring shots. Unfortunately, our return was 2 goals 12 behinds, and that does not win games of football. Finally, thanks to my support staff. Guy Zaiti (Balcatta/Osborne Park) has been my manager for the last 2 years and has been of immense help. Rex Carlshausen was my runner and Damien Eves, Ed Munks and Luca Margaretic were my assistants, coaches/selectors. Thanks to you all.

I believe that the format of the state colts program does need to be reviewed, the lack of support from a large number of clubs is proof of this. I believe it is a magnificent concept and urge all clubs to get behind the league in their efforts to raise the profile of these games.
