LEVEL 2

The WA Football Commission are seeking expressions of interest for upcoming Level 2 coaching courses.

This is an opportunity for Youth and Senior coaches who meet the below pre-requisites to further their coaching development and achieve Level 2 Accreditation in 2021/22.

Course Pre-requisites

- Must hold a CoachAFL membership and Foundation Coach accreditation
- At least 2 years coaching experience at any level of AFL football
- Currently coaching at Youth/Senior level – Year 7 age group and above
- Must have a coaching mentor in place to complete the course – (An accredited coach who can support you and provide you with feedback. Can be within your club or outside your club)

Course dates and venues have not been confirmed but are expected to be run in the months as follows:

- November, 2021 – (Online and Face to Face) Date & Venue TBC
- February, 2022 – (Face to Face, Full Day Course) Date & Venue TBC
- March, 2022 – (Face to Face, Full Day Course) Date & Venue TBC

LEVEL 3

The WA Football Commission are seeking expressions of interest for their first Community Level 3 Coaching Course. This course will provide the opportunity for existing Level 2 coaches to progress their coaching.

To run these courses, a minimum number of participants are required together with a desire from these participants to fully engage in the program. The cost of the course will be \$990.

Coaches wishing to nominate for the course should meet the following criteria:

- Hold a current AFL Level 2 Coach accreditation for a minimum of two years
- Currently coaching in one of the target group programs at AFL, WAFL, Senior/Youth Community or School Level
- Evidence of a commitment to on-going education will be highly regarded when selecting between candidates of similar merit
- Endorsement of their Club, Academy or State body (i.e. State Coaching Development Lead)

The Level 3 Course will be delivered via both face to face and online components including a range national and state virtual workshops in 2021.

The dates and program structure will be finalised in the coming weeks if enough interest is received to proceed with the course.
