A MESSAGE FROM COUNTRY FOOTBALL WA

Welcome to the 2025 Nutrien Ag Solutions Country Football Championships. The highlight of the Country Football calendar is back bigger than ever this year and we are excited to see it all come to life this weekend.

Sixteen teams will compete across three Nutrien Ag Solutions Divisions, whilst eight teams will compete across two CBH Group Colts Divisions. This is the first time since 2010 that we have had a two division format in the colts and we can't wait to see two champions crowned on Friday.

It will be great to see Great Northern back in the spotlight of the Men's divisions following their Division 2 success last year, the first time they have tasted Division 1 action since 2018. They will face a tough ask in climbing the mountain again with the other four sides all confident of a good showing. 2024 Champion's South West will again be the team to beat whilst both Avon and Peel come into this years championships under the leadership of a new coach.

Division 2 looks to be incredibly competitive. Upper Great Southern, a long time Division 1 powerhouse, find themselves in Division 2 following relegation last year and are intent on making it a one-year stint only. On the other end Great Southern went through unbeaten in their Division 3 title run last year and will be looking to put on a good showing as they seek to continue their rise through the grades. The Shield really is anyone's though with Ongerup, Eastern Districts, North Pilbara and Central Midlands Coastal confident going into this year's Championships.

Lower South West make their return to the Championships for the first time since 2018 in what is a new look Division 3. Mortlock could claim early favouritism following their relegation last year. Unfortunately we won't see Onshore Cup or Hills this year.

The CBH Group Colts divisions also take on a new complexion in this year with games being held in the Perth metro area for the first time in a number of years. The return of a Pilbara Colts side has meant an extension of our Colts competition to two Divisions. This year will also see the colts fixtures be played at Scotch College and Guilford Grammar.

A big thankyou to everyone behind the scenes in each of our leagues that continue to advocate for and support representative football. Likewise, to the WAFL, Community Clubs and Schools that will play host to Country Championships content across the four days of the Championships.

Finally, we wouldn't be able to run the Championships with out the ongoing support of our partners, in particular Nutrien Ag Solutions. A massive thank you for your ongoing commitment to Country Football

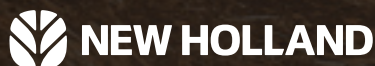

NEW HOLLAND COUNTRY WOMEN'S EDGE PFL IN ONE-POINT THRILLER TO CAP OFF 2025 STATE CLASH

The 2025 New Holland WA Country State Women's Program has wrapped up in dramatic fashion, with the women's side securing a thrilling one-point victory over the Perth Football League (PFL) at Gosnells Oval on Friday, 20 June.

The annual showdown, reignited in 2024 after a long hiatus, continues to grow in stature, providing a vital platform for the best female talent from regional Western Australia to showcase their skills on the State stage.

Coached by Busselton's Rennie Meadmore and assistant Sheridan Kowald, this year's squad was a mix of experience and fresh faces. Nine players returned from last year's memorable draw, including new captain Jessica Giudice-Nairn from the Great Northern Football League (GNFL), who led a team that also featured five standouts from Chapman Valley.

The game lived up to expectations, with WA Country holding the lead at every change before holding off a late surge from the PFL to win 4.4 (28) to 4.3 (27). Donnybrook's Ella Smith was named best on ground for her commanding display, while Secret Harbour forward Kate

Bartlett kicked two crucial goals in the first half.

Post-game, Meadmore praised her team's unity and resilience, especially the defensive unit that withstood immense pressure in the final term.

"I couldn't fault a backman all night. They got hammered and constantly came out on top," she said. "It was a complete team win."

Meadmore credited the 24-hour lead-up with helping the squad bond and prepare for the contest.

"The girls bought into the experience and game plan—amazing, considering many had never played together before," she said.

The New Holland State Program continues to be a cornerstone initiative supported by New Holland, celebrating the strength and spirit of regional football.

The spotlight now shifts to the New Holland Men's State Country side, who will take on South Australia Country under lights at Sullivan Logistics Stadium in Leederville on Saturday 26 July.

We'll also be celebrating some standout performances across the weekend, with awards including the JJ Lussick Award for

Best Field Umpire, Boundary Umpire of the Carnival, Goal Umpire of the Carnival, and the Peter Troode Encouragement Award, which recognises someone showing strong potential.

A special part of this year's carnival is the Country Football State Game between Western Australia and South Australia. We're proud to be appointing 2 field umpires, 4 boundary umpires, and 2 goal umpires from this carnival to take part in that match, which is a great opportunity to be involved at the state level.

Now in its 59th year, the Country Championships have a strong history, and for many umpires, they've been a stepping stone to higher levels, including the WAFL and AFL. Whether you're just starting out or have been involved for years, being part of this weekend is something to be proud of.

Thanks to all the umpires for giving your time, energy, and effort to support country footy. It's a big weekend, but it's always a rewarding one.

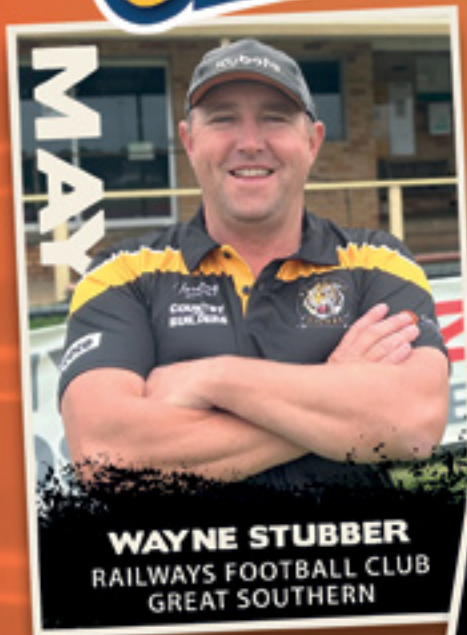

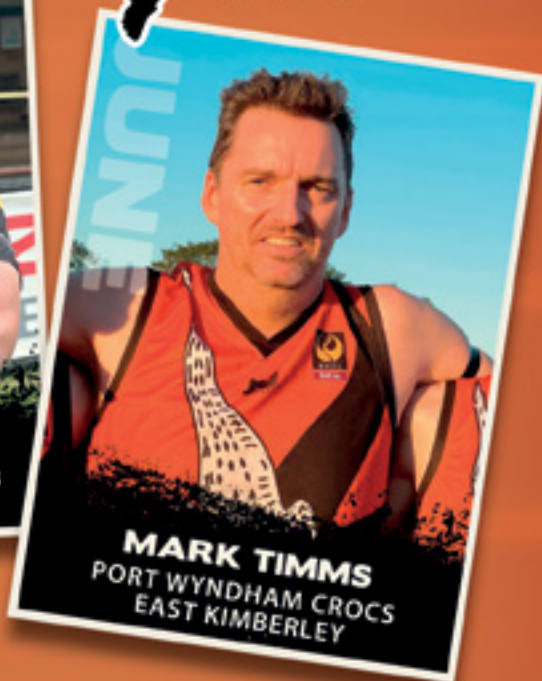

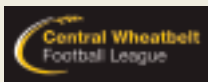
