## WHAT YOU CAN DO

Speak out against racism and say "Hey, that's not ok."

If you experience racism in any form tell the umpire, your coach, or a club official immediately so that the appropriate action can be taken.

Anyone found guilty of racism can be suspended or banned from the football.  
Prosecution may also apply under The Racial Discrimination Act
