WESTERN AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR FOOTBALL LEAGUE
PRESIDENTS REPORT 1989

We have successfully conducted another season of football, devoid of any of the dramas suffered by our senior body! Whilst it was successful the cost of football to Amateurs is also a matter of real concern for the future. We, at state level have not really come to grips with an avenue of income that is outside the club structure. Sponsorship is difficult to get in any sport, but we have to accept the marketability of the Eagles and the W.A.F.L. will deny us many opportunities. However with the numbers we have, 7,000 players alone, we must be innovative and present that, and other areas, as our asset for a promotional vehicle or direct market for appropriate sponsors.

Congratulations to all the clubs who won premierships this season and to the players who won individual awards. I trust these successes will lay the foundations for stronger efforts in 1990.

Whilst we did not have interstate competition this season we did have representative senior and colts teams which enjoyed great success after a great deal of commitment from the players, coaches and support staff.

A highlight of the season for Amateur football was the N.F.L. Shield competition in Tasmania which included an All Australian Amateur team, Queensland, New South Wales, Tasmania, A.C.T. & the V.F.A. Whilst soundly beaten by the V.F.A. in the Grand Final we were certainly able to show the quality of players who are still prepared to play our game for the enjoyment only.

Western Australia had four representatives in the team:


John Hackett, Bill Armstrong, Geoff Horton & Justin Cook who was Vice-Captain of the team. To offer football at this level gives credibility to, and acknowledgement of our contribution to the game.

1990 will loom quickly on the horizon and leave little time for planning and introducing any real changes. However I do feel it is important to continue to change where it is of benefit to our clubs and the players.

The experiment with our colts competition was not successful and it will revert back to the 1988 format. We will however continue to experiment to cope with community and other pressures i.e. double-headers because of ground availability and shorter quarters in lower, senior grades. Perhaps even the number of players on the field.

One area that I am personally keen to review is our Management Committee. Some positions are now redundant with the role played by the Executive Officer and I believe a smaller number would be as effective.

In conclusion I wish to thank the members of the Management Committee for their efforts in 1989 and also our very professional staff, of Neil Judge, Avis Thirley and Neil Costley for their dedication to the task of supporting the elected personnel in maintaining the status and image of Amateur Football.
