We pass on our deepest sympathy and respect to Josh's family, his friends and team mates and, in particular, the club committee for their strength and courage.

To Club Presidents - your committees, coaches, support staff, players and club sponsors thank you for your commitment as your club strived for success both on and off the field. You have all continued the great legacy that has been built over many years on countless volunteer hours.

To each of our 25 grade Premiers, congratulations as you write yourself in WA Amateur Football League history.

I am privileged to be part of a group of committed volunteers who make up the Board, Tribunals and Sub Committees of the WAAFL. Much time is dedicated to meetings and functions which provide the necessary direction for the competition.

I also thank our staff who work beyond the norm. I thank Cameron Agnew (GM), Jasmyn Davidson (Operations Co-ordinator) and Dylan Mellon (Media and Communications Officer) all who resigned after service to WA Amateur Football League and welcome our new General Manager David Armstrong, Sophie James and Christina Dickie to their roles.

In conclusion, I would like to express my true appreciation to everyone involved in our 91st year. Many thanks to those retiring from their football careers, your support and years of unselfish service are truly appreciated. The time and effort received from everyone involved throughout the year has allowed us to become a stronger football community based organisation.

# WEST COAST EAGLES U/23 STATE AMATEURS

The 2012 West Coast Eagles WAAFL State Under 23 program commenced mid-April with 79 of the best young community based footballers putting their hand up to participate.

With the lure of representing their state in Victoria against the reigning Australian Amateur Football Council Champions from 2011, the quality of those keen to play was outstanding and made for a very difficult selection process. Having been beaten by Victoria in the 2011 Carnival, the program focused on identifying mature players, and with the final squad of 23 having only 5 players with previous state experience, the challenge was there for everyone.

The lead up games proved to be a great platform to build on, with the side being overrun by a far more mature and experienced State Country side in our first contest together. The squad backed that performance up by playing free flowing attacking style of footy against Peel League, winning the game relatively comfortably. Both games were played with spirit and my thanks must go to everyone from North Fremantle who hosted both games.

The WA side travelled to Victoria intent on atoning for the grand final loss at the 2011 carnival, and to do so, the coaching staff offered a totally new game plan for the team to adjust to.

In slippery conditions, our attack on the football when in dispute was outstanding in the first half, which saw us trouble the Vic's and keep in touch on the scoreboard, entering the main break just 15 points down. The start of the 2nd half was a different story, with Vic jumping out of the blocks early to kick some easy goals as a result of our inability to win the footy. The Vic's managed to kick 6 goals to 3 for the quarter and enter the final change 32 points in front.

Whilst disappointed with the quarter, the WA team regrouped during the break and wanted to finish the game as it started, with fierce attack on the ball. To their credit, the team stood up again and played the type of footy expected of representative teams from WA and made the Vic's play it right out, closing to within 13 points at one stage, before finally succumbing by 26 points.

Of the 23 players who had the opportunity to don the black swan state jumper, only 5 players had previous representative experience. We had representatives from 11 amateur clubs, with 16 being from A Grade, 3 from B Grade and 4 from C Grade.

From a coaches perspective I'm very proud of the entire team and although we fell just short of our goal, their response to a new game plan and the challenges thrown at them were always met with enthusiasm.

The success of the WAAFL State Program has been further highlighted post carnival with Jamie Delborello (Kingsway) and Max Alexander (Stirling) having played WAFL football with West Perth.

I'd like to sincerely thank John Davies and his Board for giving me the opportunity to again lead the WAAFL against the best amateur team in the country. In particular, I'd like to mention the efforts and tireless work of WAAFL General Manager, David Armstrong and his staff, State Team Coordinator Peter Grosser and Geoff Palmer, who without their commitment there would be no WAAFL State team.

I'd also like to thank my own team, with the success of the program being in no small part resulting from their involvement and individual strengths; Assistant Coaches Jamie White, Darren Von Bergheim and Paul Matthews, along with Chairman of Selectors Warren Eddy, Property Manager Guy Ziati, Head Trainer John Grierson and runner Wade McGrath.

In closing special mention must go to all the players, community coaches and the WAAFL clubs as without their input and support, State Representative Amateur football wouldn't be as alive, vibrant and competitive as it is today.

# WEST COAST EAGLES AMATEUR STATE COLTS

The 2012 WAAFL State Colts program started in April with trial games and training sessions starting intensely. We put an emphasis on developing a game plan that would be highly beneficial at state level, and would also give players opportunities to further develop at club level. The goal for this program was to ensure that selected players came away with different skill sets which allowed them to improve on elements of their game. This goal was supported by the use of specific training drills.

The Colts program worked with the same coaching staff as 2011 which allowed us to continue the program we had previously employed. It was our opinion that we would be able to significantly enhance the program from last year. We had a significant amount of pressure placed on us with players being unable to attend certain nights, information being misdirected and a communication breakdown between us, players and their associated WAAFL clubs. It seemed our program was shunned by many clubs and their players, a problem that will be rectified through improvement strategies next year. We were able to choose a squad of players we believed would be capable and that could learn through the process.

All games were played at Gil Fraser Reserve, North Fremantle and I would like to take the opportunity to thank the North Fremantle Football Club for their outstanding hospitality on all occasions.

The first game against WA Country Football League Colts showed us that we were a few players off the required pace of the game, however by the second half our team had adjusted to the playing style that was necessary. Our players struggled with the WACFL players' tempo and found difficulty in the transition from being the main ball winners at their local clubs, to playing roles at the higher level. In saying this, the WACFL team was an exceptionally talented side that they should have been very pleased with. Our best player for this game went to Luke West from Swan Athletic.

The second game saw us face off against the Peel Football League. Our game started extremely well with exciting football being played from the first bounce. Our players all embraced our game play and the roles that were expected of them. This was a very pleasing outcome for us as the players had played 3 full games in 5 days. We walked away with a comfortable win,

which was a credit to all involved. Kaiden Matera from Melville played an outstanding game with lots of run and carry, and long penetrating kicks.

The final game saw us face off with the State 16's. This was no doubt our pinnacle game and was something the players had really pushed themselves toward. The game itself was of an exceptional quality and one that definitely had our boys at a disadvantage with the constant attacking pressure of the State 16's.

The score board truly did not reflect the game on the night and it was pleasing to hear that this was the most difficult team the State 16's had played. No matter the result, the game was an outstanding opportunity for the players to be exposed to this level of football and no doubt allowed WAAFL and AFL representatives to see the skill and ability level of the WAAFL players. The best player for this game was Will Green from Swan Athletic who used pace to break open lines and carry the ball through congestion.

I would like to make mention of our coaching staff who gave countless hours of commitment to the program. Brett Warner - Chairman of Selectors, Devin Martin - Assistant Coach, Sam Cavicchio - Assistant Coach, Clint Gardiner - Assistant Coach, and Ben Johnson - Conditioning and Running.

All of these people made the program extremely professional and their knowledge of the game was truly beneficial to the players. I would like to make mention of the medical staff who attended both training sessions and game day to ensure the players were ready each week. Also to Geoff Palmer and Peter Grosser from the WAAFL who ensured the resources, communication and facilities were ready each week. Thank you all.

I would also like to thank the WAAFL Board for the opportunity they have given us this year, and for the support that they have ensured I received during this program. Thank you all for your ongoing support and direction throughout the year.

## WAAFL INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

The WA Amateur League Integrated Football completed its fourth year in 2012, the second in a fully structured football competition. The Integrated Football Program provides players with an intellectual disability, aged 16 years and older, the opportunity to play Australian Rules football in a community competition.

The 2012 season had five clubs involved in the competition hosting six teams. Kingsway, High Wycombe, Lynwood Ferndale and Warnbro all hosted Integrated teams. Fremantle CBC was able to field two teams this season, Gold and Green.

The 8 round season is played fortnightly with modified rules, to allow as many intellectually disabled players as possible to take part. Weekly training sessions and club functions were an essential part of the Integrated players football commitment.

Players and families of those playing in the league said that the competition has been a welcome addition to their lifestyles.

Kirk Barker (Fremantle CBC) stated "It's good to be able to be part of a sport team. My brother is and I wanted to be like him, and now I am... It's good that he comes to watch me now."

The second Integrated Grand Final was held on the 26th of August, 2012 at Ferndale Park between Lynwood Ferndale and Fremantle CBC Gold. The Grand Final showcased the talent

each team had with a final score of Lynwood-Ferndale 6.2 (38) defeating Fremantle CBC Gold 5.5 (35). Best on Ground was awarded to Damien Watson (Lynwood Ferndale) who was given the match ball.

Integrated Coordinator Sophie James was very pleased to see how many players had stayed on board after the inaugural year, and how the league looked to be a sustainable competition in the future.

"The success and growth of the Integrated league shows how hard everyone works to field a team and have their players involved in football".

"It's fantastic watching the players take their football so seriously, ensuring a highly competitive competition. The players all say it's a great way to socialise and increase their fitness."

She was impressed by the pro-active mindset of some of the clubs and players, and that it was obvious this was a league that wanted to grow.

As the integrated players continue to play and train in 2013, the WA Amateur Football League will definitely see some Integrated players move into the mainstream grades.

WA Amateur Football League Life Member, Neil Donaldson, was awarded Western Australia's highest level of recognition within football, being inducted into the Western Australian Football Commission Life Members' Association.

WAFC Life Member induction is awarded to those who have made a significant impact and outstanding overall contribution to football in Western Australia.

Neil Donaldson was inducted at the WAFC Life Members' Association Christmas Luncheon at Patersons Stadium on Monday, December 10.

Neil was inducted as a WAAFL Life Member in 1972 and was a WAAFL board member from 1972 – 1979. In 2009 Neil joined the WAAFL once again, as a member of the Hall of Champions Selection Committee.

Neil has an extensive history with the WAAFL inclusive of a 252 game playing history and Life Membership with University FC.

Neil has a strong commitment with University Football Club and has had a long history with the club. Neil's various roles at UWAFC include club patron, Secretary then President 1954 - 1965 and also Coached from 1963 - 1975 including 5 A-Colts Premierships.

Neil has also been involved with the WAAFL State teams taking on roles as runner, selector, Chairman of Selectors and manager from 1964 - 1978.

Neil is the first person to have been awarded a WAFC Life Member through commitments to the WA Amateur Football League.

## UMPIRING REPORT

The WAAFL Umpiring Team had a successful year in 2012 as it continued to build on the strength from previous seasons. There were a number of highlights during the season and many stemmed from future goals and initiatives identified at the end of 2011.

Firstly, the team was able to expand on its visits to the clubs from 2011. In 2012 over 25 clubs were visited during pre and early season. These visits were well received by the clubs, assisting them with a greater understanding of how the umpires interpret the rules, how they train and prepare for matches and generally improve the relationship between the two parties.

Secondly, Collier Oval in Como was secured as a long-term pre-season training venue. This venue provided a stable Monday night option, with a large area to train, two change rooms, a meeting room, kitchen and storage area. Its location also assisted those who live south of the river and have to travel to Mount Lawley during the regular season.

Thirdly, a new Umpire Operations Manager role was implemented successfully. Colin Gray was appointed to this role and handled it with aplomb. The appointment assisted WAAFL Umpiring to ensure all operational matters were dealt with, via a dedicated person. No doubt this role will continue to expand in 2013 learning from what worked well and what can be improved upon.

Finally, the number of grades covered by field, boundary and goal umpires was maintained from 2011 as well as most of the umpire coaching team. Over and above this for the first time all A Grade League matches were covered via a three field umpire system. All this was achieved with a number of umpires progressing quickly through the senior community ranks to the WAFL, something the team is very proud of.

Other highlights of the season included a large number of young umpires from the WAFC Junior District Umpire Talent Squads getting a taste of WAAFL colts footy, the appointment of a goal

umpires fitness coach to assist with health and well-being, the appointment of field umpire Graeme Cook to the State Game in Melbourne, another very successful visit by the umpiring team to the Gosnells Football Club and the appointment of a new Umpires Association President in Mark Volk who took over from Colin Gray after Colin moved into the Umpire Operations Manager role.

Finally, a big congratulations to all umpires for once again taking up the challenge in 2012, to the League and clubs for their ongoing support of the umpires, to new sponsor Harvey Norman, to all umpire coaches once again headed up by Colin Gray, Terry Battle, Robbie McDonald, Terry Tomlinson and Des Morgan and finally, to the Mount Lawley Amateur Football Club headed by Gary Formica for hosting the umpires at Hamer Park.

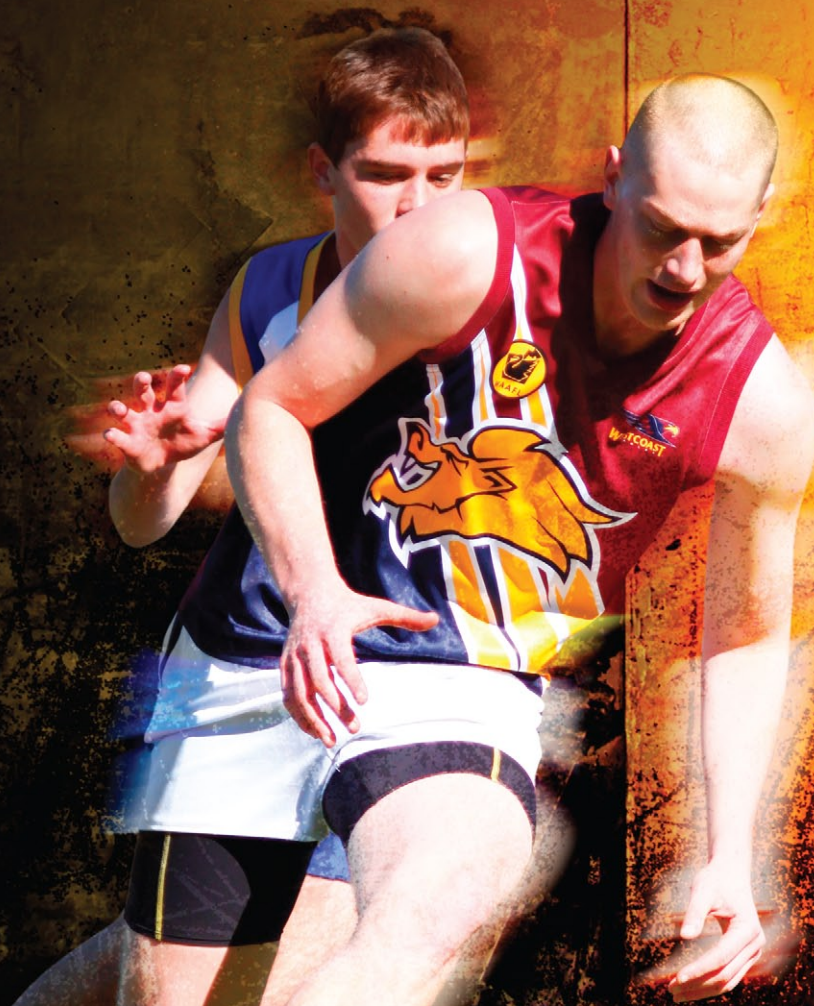
