Paul Rafter, our State Coach, who co-ordinated the scheme with the financial backing from "QUIT" will be looking for a greater response from Clubs in 1993 and it will be to your advantage to maximise the advise available to you.

For the volunteers who served in positions on Tribunals, Reinstatements, Investigations and State Football I offer my sincere appreciation for jobs very well done.

To the Committee of Management, who work very hard and long, I take this opportunity to thank you all for your efforts, your achievements and your commitment.

Neil Judge and Avis Thirley yet again proved to be efficient and dedicated administrative team and we are truly indebted to them for their work.

A special note of thanks must go to our Sponsors who have continued to support us and help us in our future planning for success. The strength and future of Amateur football relies solely on each persons commitment and dedication within every Club. To do your best and maintain a high standard of honesty and pride in our competition is all I can ask. I wish you all the success you desire both on and off the playing field in 1993 and beyond.
