The Swan Districts Football Club Past Players and Officials Association is a very active part of the Swan Districts Football Club and has been since the Association was established in 1958. The Association currently has over 170 Members.

As well as promoting and encouraging the fraternization of former players and officials of the Club, The Association also:

- Assists and encourages the game of Australian Rules Football in the District
- Makes grants of money and provides services and property to the Club
- Co-operates with other WAFL Past Players and Officials Associations for the betterment of football in the WA Football League
- Participates in half-time fraternizations with kindred Associations at home and away matches
- Affiliated to the WAFL Combined Past Players and Officials Association Inc.

Examples of financial assistance contributed by the Association include:

- Providing weekly cash awards to the Reserves and Colts players
- Making an annual grant to assist the Club with Youth Development Squads
- Making grants to the Swans Under 18's, Under 16's, State Schoolboys and Girls selected to represent WA
- Provides awards on Swan Medal Night to the runner-up and third placed in the Swan Medal, the Rookie of the Year and the Fairest and Best in the Reserves
- Hosting the Colt's Parents morning tea during the half-time break in the Colt's home games
- Carrying out minor Club maintenance through the support of Association volunteers.

The Association has its own function room which is available to Members during half-time at home games for hosting of fraternizations with kindred Associations. The room is also used for other Association functions such as after-game drinks and the annual East Fremantle PPOA and Swans PPOA after-game Sundowner.

The room which is the envy of most WAFL League Clubs also houses Club photos and memorabilia which is maintained by the Association, being dedicated to the history of the Swan Districts Football Club.
