Vale - Keith Slater

The Swansmen extend our sympathy to the Slater family on the sad passing of Keith. A Club Champion and Hall of Famer. State and Test cricketer, Claxton Shield baseballer.

Keith played 167 games for Swans, kicked 201 goals, Swan Medal in 1956,57 & 60. Premiership player in 1961, 62 & 63. Simpson Medal in the 1961 Grand Final, when he won his personal duel against the great Polly Farmer.

In 1964 he left Swans and coached Subiaco for 3 seasons, before returning to Swans.

Slater Gartrell Sports and Midland go hand-in-hand, and Keith loved coming up to Swans at any opportunity, even in 2024 despite his failing health.

<u>Next Month – Craig Serjeant: The changing face of cricket.</u>

Craig Serjeant (born 1951) played 12 Test matches for Australia and three One Day Internationals. Just following the Centenary Test in 1977, on the Ashes tour to England, World Series Cricket was signing players from all around the world. Craig was offered a place in WSC but declined. He scored over 5,000 first class runs for Australia and Western Australia – and bowled one over!

Craig was appointed Vice-Captain of Australia against India in 1977 under Bob Simpson and made his only test century (124) against the West Indies in a famous victory.

Craig was initially a pharmacist after his cricket days and then turned into a successful financial planner with former WA cricketer Sam Gannon.


