• effectively applies the Laws of Australian Football / Spirit of the Laws			
• consistently interprets and applies the Laws with composure			
Module 6 – Positioning			
• implements the two / three field umpire system in open-age match conditions			
• demonstrates initiative and poise when changing control with other field umpire/s			
Module 7 – Skills & Techniques			
• consistently performs skills with regards to whistle, voice, signals & ball-ups			
• performs all match-day administrative requirements			
Module 8 – Managing Others			
• courteously cooperates with other match-day officials			
• is aware of the procedures for reporting players and the Tribunal environment
