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As per the WA Government announcement, restrictions for the areas of Greater Perth and Peel will be eased from 6pm Friday 5 February.

## POST LOCKDOWN RETURN TO TRAINING

- Players do NOT need to wear masks whilst actively engaged in 'vigorous' outdoor Football Training sessions – but you will need to wear a mask both before and after training, or if watching training.
- A mask must be worn if indoors i.e. training within a gym, in the changerooms, in a function room, or in a lecture theatre.
- Clubs should limit the number of people indoors at any one time – the 1 person per 4sqm rule applies with a maximum of 150 people allowed at the venue/facility.
- Masks must be worn at all other times in and around the Football Club.
- Do NOT share water bottles and follow all other hygiene requirements including washing hands and using alcohol based hand sanitiser.
- Maintain social distancing of 1.5m at all times.
- Ensure appropriate cleaning of facilities and equipment is undertaken.
- Download and use the SafeWA App. Clubs should ensure that the venue where they are training is registered and that QR codes are displayed. For further information, visit: <https://safewa.health.wa.gov.au/>
- Ensure that all players, staff and volunteers use the SafeWA App or a register is kept of all those in attendance at training
- If you are unwell or have any symptoms then stay home from training and get tested.
- A G2G PASS is required to enter or leave the Perth/Peel region. This is only granted for essential travel, therefore players outside of these areas cannot travel into the Perth/Peel area for training and vice versa during this period.

It also means the W AFC offices, where Perth Football League staff operate from, will remain closed and expect to re-open on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February. All Perth Football League staff will continue to work remotely.

The AGM to be held 6pm Monday 15th Feb will go ahead as scheduled at Tuart College.
