**PRESIDENTS REPORT 1994**

To everyone involved in Amateur Football I would like to offer my sincere congratulations for their efforts in producing another great season. All of the clubs involved in the finals were able to provide some excellent football games and my congratulations go to the Clubs who won grand finals and moved to a higher grade. Those clubs will realise that they need to improve to maintain a higher level of participation & commitment and this attitude can only improve the standard of Amateur football overall.

West Coast created their own history by winning their first A grade grand final and congratulations to John Dimmer for a coaching job well done.

Club administration needs improvement in some areas and whilst most clubs have excellent personnel there are still some who don't have enough people to do the job properly. These poorly run clubs will eventually die on the vine unless they are able to lift their administration level or amalgamate with a club that is well run.

This years State football programme had an excellent build up for the Australian Carnival and players & personnel were very keen to retain the title of Australian Champions. Unfortunately the Victorian team were extremely determined and swept everything before them to win their first carnival at home, in over 30 years.

Our personnel, support team and coaching staff are to be congratulated on the effort and time they dedicated in the hope of a better result. Congratulations to Jamie Langlands (Wanneroo C Grade) and Ian Putt (Scarborough) on their selection in the All Australian Team.

Our colts programme had a successful year under coach John Nykyforak and once again defeated the W.A. Teal Cup team. In 1995 John will move to the senior State coaching position and his place as State colts coach will be taken by former State captain Bill Armstrong. These two coaches have a great deal to offer and I know that their enthusiasm and knowledge will raise the standard of football up to another level.

The racism By-Law that was introduced by the W.A.A.F.L. this year has been accepted by the Amateurs in Victoria and South Australia and has had a steadying influence on an area of behaviour that could have been detrimental to our competition.

One of the most important areas of our football code is sponsorship and as most clubs realise this is the only way to raise finance to keep your club viable. The league sponsors need to have a more solid backing from clubs for the clubs to benefit financially.

This year the Ministry of Sport have allocated funds for 1995 but that funding will cease for 1996. The Ministry will then allocate money to the W.A.F.C. for football development etc, and we will have to negotiate with the W.A.F.C. for a grant to offset our Administration costs. At this time our negotiations with the W.A.F.C. for a grant have received a favourable response.

For the very hardworking Management Committee it has been a good year and my sincere thanks go to them. Most of all the Office staff in Neil, Avis & Dianne deserve credit for an extremely efficient administration. This year we changed offices from Subiaco Oval to Leederville Oval with a minimum of fuss and are now in a better location than before.

Sincere thanks to our Umpires Advisor Bryan Smith and the Umpires Association for a very good year. Next year Phil O'Reilly will be our new Umpires Advisor and Phil's enthusiasm will no doubt raise the standard yet again.

To all the volunteers who work behind the scenes on tribunals, reinstatements and investigations I thank you for your sincere efforts to keep the Amateur competition operating on an even keel.

In Amateur football there are too many people to thank individually because we are a volunteer orientated organisation, so for all of those people I thank you and wish you every success for a great 1995.

The 1994 season opened with our commitment to provide two umpires in as many games as possible and importantly in the Colts grades. For most of the season this was possible, however, unfortunately we were unable to continue supplying Panel Umpires to "F" GRADE.

It is our belief that by supplying two umpires in most Colts games that this had offered a much better controlled game and therefore more enjoyable for both players and supporters.

During the season about 100 field & 30 boundary umpires received appointments. Also 15 field umpires completed Level 2 A.F.L. accreditation.

## **UMPIRE ADVISER'S REPORT 1994**

### **Coaching Panel**

The coaching panel was as follows:-

This report refers to field and boundary umpires only.

### **Numbers**

About 100 field and 30 boundary umpires received appointments in the year. The numbers of field umpires increased markedly, probably as a result of the two umpire policy in all those grades covered by the official panel. This policy seemed to receive wide word of mouth coverage and this helped to recruit additional umpires.

We were fortunate to receive a few older, experienced umpires from other competitions who swelled the ranks at A and B Grade level. Lower grades were well served with umpires from Junior Council ranks who helped us to achieve our aim of two umpires for most games.

### **Accreditation and Skills Development**

Accreditation was again an important part of umpire development. Theory classes were held throughout the year and each field umpire was assessed by a number of observers in the field. This year, 13 field umpires received Level 2 AFL Accreditation and 2 boundary umpires from last year received their field accreditation.

### **Finals**

Again, it was a difficult decision to appoint umpires to senior finals this year because of the increased depth of ability and evenness of performance of the top 10 umpires. Choice was made a little easier by an improved assessment and feedback system for umpires but this needs building upon if objective decisions are to be made.

### **Recruitment**

A successful newspaper advertising campaign at the beginning of the season was responsible for the recruitment of a number of umpires. This needs to be continued. Additionally, ex-players are seeking to become umpires and this should be encouraged. Ideally, all Grades should have the opportunity of two umpires. To achieve this recruitment and retention of current umpires should remain a priority.

### **Support**

I would like to thank Neil Judge and his team in the office for the support they have given. Additionally, the work of Max Hasson and the Appointments Board has helped tremendously in making 1994 a successful year.

## AUSTRALIAN AMATEUR FOOTBALL CARNIVAL 1994

Having reached the pinnacle of success in 1991 our coaching and support staff were eager to repeat the dose in Melbourne this year. We believe our preparation was better than ever, indeed, some players began training in late January. The appointment of Andy Shearman as fitness adviser ensured the squad was physically strong.

In the weeks immediately prior to the Carnival fate dealt a cruel blow when injury eliminated two or three key personnel.

The story of the carnival is simply we were outclassed. We accounted for a much improved Tasmania in a hard slogging affair but it became immediately apparent that the standard of football being played by South Australia and Victoria was very high indeed. It also became obvious that the weekly competition played in the eastern states was of a quality which drilled players in disciplined, team-oriented football.

Our representatives tried hard against South Australia but a lack of discipline and pace cost us dearly. An obvious shortcoming in our game was a lack of adequate disposal skills - we constantly turned the ball over. It must be said that some players clearly found the pressure and pace too great but hopefully will become better footballers as a result of the experience.

The Victorians were an extremely experienced, well drilled and polished unit. Many of their players had actually played A.F.L. Football in 1994, Their skill level was extremely high and our players did very well indeed in the early part of the game to contain them. Unfortunately as often occurs when we tired and relaxed the pressure they hurt us on the scoreboard.

Very fine performances were given by Ian Putt (Scarborough) and John Langlands (Wanneroo) both of whom were chosen in the All-Australian side. Grant Ryan (Wembley) and Dane Chandler (North Beach) were others who stood up well to the standard. Solid contributors were Adam Clark (Wembley), Gavin Perry (North Beach), Chris Davies (Nollamara) and Rex Carlshausen (Wesley Curtin).

I record my special thanks to Barrie Pearson, Ray Snell and Steven Smeath as selectors and Milton Sanders, Marty Burgess, Greg Maskiell and Bob Tanner our support staff. An extra vote of appreciation goes to Phil Hayes and Andy Shearman who were untiring as Coaching Support Staff.
