Beginning in 1922, the WAAFL has grown from what started as a small six team competition to the largest single organised football league in WA.

In its 96th year with 67 clubs, 230 teams and over 10,000 registered players, the WAAFL caters for players as young as 16 years to provide a quality high standard competition whilst accommodating considerable volunteer personnel and social supporters.

For many players, the WAAFL provides a superior football competition for those not wishing to endure the commitment to WAFL training due to study commitments, career commitments or simply a lifestyle

that considers football as a recreational pursuit.

The WAAFL is also the beginning point for many well-known WAFL and AFL personnel, starting their careers in amateur football and becoming the football champions of tomorrow.

High profile players and our Colts League name-sakes include Phil Scott, Drew Banfield, Laurie Keene, Brett Jones and two-time Sandover Medallist Ian Dargie all who played for the West Coast Eagles.

Other household names, and AFL players, include Tendai Mzungu (Fremantle & GWS) and Nick Kommer (Essendon)

On Wednesday August 30, the WAAFL hosted the eighth annual Hall of Champions function. The Hall of Champions honours those individuals who have made long, significant and commendable contributions to the WAAFL, to help make it the strong and respected sporting body that it is today. This year the WAAFL inducted three new members into the Hall of Champions.

Brian Kiely was a foundation member of the North Beach Amateur Football Club in 1964 and played 227 games with the North Beach AFC from 1965-1981.

Brian coached for seven years: 1966, 1967, 1969 and 1970 in D Grade, 1971 in C Grade, 1973 and 1974 in B Grade.

He was captain for seven years and won the North Beach fairest and best award in 1965, 1969, 1972, 1973 and 1978 as well as finishing as runner up on four occasions.

He won the WAAFL fairest and best player for D Grade in 1966 and 1969, C Grade in 1971, the TR Howard Medal for B Grade in 1972 and the A2 medal in 1976, as well as finishing runner up on three occasions.

Brian won the best clubman award at North Beach in 1970 and 1972 and was made a life member of North Beach in 1972. He was vice president of the club from 1976-1979 and club president from 1980 - 1983.

Brian is inducted into the WAAFL Hall of Champions as a Champion.

Andrew Piccoli played 230 games for the Wembley Amateur Football Club from 2002- 2016. He was the A Grade captain from 2008-2013 winning the Wembley A Grade Fairest & Best in 2007 and 2011 as well as being runner up in the award in 2004, 2009 and 2012. He was the Wembley league leading goal

kicker in 2005, 2007, 2011, 2012 and 2013. Andrew was a premierships player for the Wembley B Grade team in 2005.

In 2007, he won the CJ Jaimeson Medal as the A Grade Best & Fairest player as well as the A Grade Leading Goal Kicker Award in the same year.

Andrew participated in the WAAFL State U23's program in 2006 and 2007. He was rewarded with All Australian selection in both years as well as winning the LA Tetley Award as the best state player in 2007. In 2012, Andrew won the TR Howard Medal as the B Grade Best and Fairest player as well as the B Grade leading goal kicker award. He was also runner up in the B Grade Best and Fairest in 2009 and 2011.

Andrew Piccoli is inducted into the WAAFL Hall of Champions as a Champion.

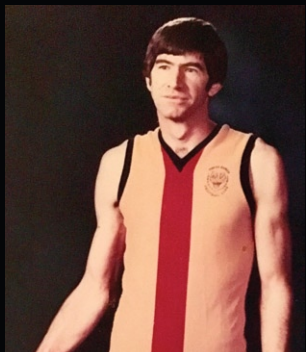
Des Reed played 200+ games for Fremantle CBC AFC. He was a captain/coach in 1956-1958, 1961-1962, 1964 and 1970.

He was a triple premierships player in the WAFL for South Fremantle in 1952, 1953 and 1954.

Des was the inaugural premierships coach of the Fremantle CBC league side in 1961 and was made a life member of the club in the same year. Des served on the committee from 1960-1970.

Des was included in the Fremantle CBC 1960's Team of the Decade and was a Hall of Fame Inductee of the club in 2010.

WAAFL INTEGRATED FOOTBALL

Integrated Football has 200 registered participants and is becoming a vibrant, sustainable community program underpinned by the clubs that field teams and support the program.

In 2017 seven teams, Coolbinia West Perth, Kingsway, High Wycombe, Warnbro Swans, Wembley and Fremantle CBC Green and Gold played twelve home and away fixtures throughout the season. Both Willetton and North Beach also established programs at their clubs and commenced building a base and undertook training sessions.

Our Home and Away Season has proven to be most successful, a restructuring of fixtures saw a more even spread of results with High Wycombe finishing the season as minor premiers.

Our High-Performance Academy once again took to Robinson Reserve with nominations from Clubs seeing over 25 players take part in the ten-week training period. Jamie Wynne and Dave Wright provided the high-level coaching supported by Amy Fuller from Netball WA who have established their own Inclusion Program, it's been fantastic having Amy involved.

This year the WAAFL were very pleased to announce WA would participate at the 2017 AFL National Inclusion Carnival on the Gold Coast. The journey began for players, volunteers and staff as we prepared and planned for this event that for many was a dream come true.

WA selected a team of sixteen players supported by Jamie Wynne and Dave Wright in Coaching Roles, Amy from Netball WA as our Team Runner, Heather Timms a long time Integrated Advocate and Volunteer, Tayla

Lewis as Team Physio as well as Natalie Couch, David Armstrong and Greg Gilbee.

The Carnival lived up to the expectation with glorious weather as well. The team had a marvelous experience not only playing for their state but to experience the sights and sounds of the Gold Coast including trips to Movie World, Sea World and Metricon Stadium.

WA finished in Pool B playing a minor final against the Northern Territory which we won comprehensively. WA players Phillip Ranieri and Raphael Gould from the Fremantle CBC AFC also received All Australian selection. Phillip and Raphael demonstrated skills, abilities and behaviours deserving of their selection throughout the carnival. Congratulations to everyone involved in what was a wonderful life changing experience for the team.

On Saturday 12 August, the West Coast Eagles Football Club welcomed Integrated Football to Domain Stadium in what was our final Curtain Raiser at the venue. Fifty Integrated players received the opportunity to play before the WCE v Carlton game. In what is always a program highlight and one all players and volunteers look forward to.

Integrated Football is in a very good space receiving tremendous community support and is recognised for the positive impact it has on the participants. The WAAFL recognises the dedication, commitment and support by all volunteers at WAAFL Club level and encourages more clubs to have a closer look at the program and to get along and enjoy a game, you will be pleased you did.

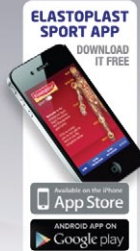

WEST COAST EAGLES STATE U23 AMATEUR TEAM



The West Coast Eagles State U23 Amateur Team battled wet conditions on the Gold Coast as they came up against Queensland on Sunday 11 June.

The match was contested throughout with the margin never exceeding five points at every break. The wet conditions made it tough to get clean possession of the football as the rain continued to fall for the entire match.

Thomas Cuijpers kicked two goals for the WAAFL in the first quarter as they looked to be the better side early on. However, Queensland added 1.1 to 0.4 in the second quarter to leave the scores level at the main break.

Queensland were tough in defence as they took several intercept marks across the day. The Queensland players may have been bigger bodied however the speed of the younger WAAFL side kept them in the game.

Jaime Rudrum kicked a crucial goal late in the final quarter to leave the margin just one point in favour of Queensland.

In the end, it was Queensland who were in front at the final siren by just three points.

On Friday 26 May, the annual WA Amateur Football League v WA Country Football League match was held at Fremantle Oval.

On a night where the temperature dropped to 14 degrees the WACFL started fast with two goals on the board dominating the first half of the first quarter. It took eight and a half minutes for the WAAFL to kick their first goal which came from the boot of Thomas Cuijpers. With that they fought back to win the second half of the first quarter to trail by just seven points at quarter time.

The WAAFL dominated the second quarter kicking 5.2 to 2.0, however the WACFL were determined to not let the game get away kicking back in the third quarter to trail by just one point at three quarter time.

With history against them the WAAFL held on to break a nine-year drought.

Thomas Cuijpers took out the Best on Ground for the WAAFL.

The WAAFL Colts took on the WACFL Colts at Fremantle Oval on Friday 26 May. The match started well for the WAAFL with a goal to Harrison Ryan at the three-minute mark. It was a highly-contested match throughout the first quarter with just five points separating the two teams at quarter time.

The match opened up in the second quarter with both sides able to get some run through the middle of the ground. Within the first minute of the quarter the WACFL had their first goal off the boot of Jai Jackson. The WACFL won the quarter kicking 2.2 to 0.1.

In the third quarter Jai Jackson again kicked the first goal within the first minute but the WAAFL followed up with their own goal one minute later from Braydn Furmark. A few minutes later a fast break down the wing and accurate kick inside the forward fifty saw a mark and goal to the WAAFL's Brodie De Abreu as the WAAFL continued their fight back. The margin was cut to just 13 points at three quarter time.

Unfortunately for the WAAFL they were unable to hold on in the last quarter kicking just one goal.

Three WAAFL players celebrated significant game milestones as they ran out for their 400th game in 2017.

Coolbinia West Perth's **Joel Shirlow** reached his milestone at Coolbinia Reserve on Saturday 27 May.

Joel or 'Jacko' as he is known to his teammates started playing in the WAAFL "about 22 years ago" for the Osborne Districts J Grade side. The backman has played in a range of grades from B Reserves, C Grade League and Reserves, J Grade and most recently E Grade. Since 2003 Jacko has played at least 15 games every season.

After being involved in many football matches Jacko received his first premiership medallion in last year's Grand Final which saw the Coolbinia West Perth E3 side defeat Gosnells by 26 points.

Just a couple of months later North Beach player **Ian Tester** ran out for his 400th match on Saturday 8 July, setting a new club games record.

Ian or 'Slimy' as he is known at the club, started playing as a colt in 1982. He spent 17 years at the club before he took some time away to focus on his studies. He returned in 2005 in an assistant coaching role before pulling on the North Beach jumper again. In his prime he played in the A Reserves Grade Final and won a premiership in I Grade.

Bullcreek Leeming player **Paul Petkovich** reached his 400th game milestone at Beasley Park on Saturday 15 July.

Paul has dedicated 22 years to the Bullcreek Leeming Amateur Football Club with 20 of those in committee roles from President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and General Committee roles. He began his playing career with the club in 1995, the following year he was named Colts captain in which he led the side to a premiership and won the best and fairest award.

His leadership qualities were recognised several times by being named club captain in consecutive seasons from 2004 to 2009. He has won the Club Best and Fairest Award on three occasions 2001, 2002 and 2003 as well as the Club Leading Goal Kicker award in 1996, 1999, 2005, 2010 and 2012.

Paul has also been lucky enough to be part of five premiership winning teams with the Club in 1996, 1999, 2005, 2010 and most recently in 2012.

TIE FOR TOP AWARD AS THE WAAFL CELEBRATES 2017

On Wednesday 30 August over 800 players, officials and VIP's packed the new Crown Ballroom to celebrate the 96th WA Amateur Football League Season. One of the biggest nights on the WAAFL calendar sees the football guernsey's swapped for suits as the league recognises those who have excelled throughout the year.

This year's presentation saw a tie for the CJ Jamieson Medal as the A Grade Best and Fairest player. University's Hamish Murray and Fremantle CBC's Christopher Basile claiming the top award with twenty votes for the season.

While Hamish is a first-time winner of the A Grade award, Chris makes it back to back wins.

Hamish was leading the count with one round to go however a best on ground performance by Chris in round eighteen saw the award tied for the first time since 2004.

Chris polled votes across eight rounds including five best on ground performances while Hamish had an impressive season polling in seven rounds with six of those performances rewarded with full votes from the umpires.

Scarborough's Joel Ashman, Kalamunda's Sean Fletcher and Wembley's Benjamin Noakes all finished as runners up on 19 votes while 2015 winner Bradley Nisbett from West Coast polled well again finishing in third place with 18 votes.

Andrew Vawser from Hamersley Carine won the TR Howard Medal as the B Grade best and fairest polling votes across twelve matches including four best on ground performances.

Kingsley's Andrew Fisher created history becoming the first person in C1 Grade to win the award in three consecutive years.

The NK Donaldson medal for the Phil Scott Colts competition went to Ryan Donaldson from the University Football Club. After five best on ground performances Ryan won the award by three votes over West Coast's Joshua Tucker.

The A Grade Leading Goal Kicker award went to Trinity Aquinas player Ryan Murphy who kicked 56 goals for the year, Ryan also won the award in 2015. For the second straight year Mt Lawley's David McKinlay won the B Grade Leading Goal kicker award with 73 goals for the year.

The night not only honours the best and fairest players from the various grades but also recognises the achievements of clubs, administrators and coaches throughout the 2017 season.

The Ron Webster Memorial award for the senior champion club was awarded to Gosnells Football Club while the TK Naylor award for the Colts champion club was awarded to Canning Vale Football Club. The champion club awards are calculated by both on and off field points with points awarded for each win, meeting attendance, payments, paperwork submitted on time. Points are deducted for send offs and for match day fines.

The LA Tetley award for best player of the 2017 State Program was awarded to Charlie Stapleton of University Football Club for his performance across all games and his attitude and leadership during the entire program. Joycelyn Smith from Secret Harbour Football Club won the administrator of the year while Darren Brealey won the Ken Armstrong Senior Community Coach of the year award.
