After finishing fourth on the ladder at the end of the regular season the Colts won all three of their finals and played off against Claremont in the Grand Final. Unfortunately, they couldn't complete the fairytale and went down by 25 points. We congratulate John and the team for their achievements in going as far as they did.

After an impressive win over Peel at Mandurah in the Qualifying Final the Second Semi Final was not a good day for the League side with East Perth having the better of the Black Ducks on the day to take the win by 28 points and set-up a Preliminary Final showdown with Peel at Steel Blue. It wasn't going to be easy with Swans missing two of their best on-ballers and Peel stacked with AFL listed players. The start was promising with Swans dominating the first quarter with the breeze kicking 5 goals to nil. Peel turned the tables in the second and kicked 6 goals to 1 going into the half time break 9 points up. Injuries again dogged Swans with Jarvis Pinna and Lewis Tester going down and Peel capitalised on this keeping Swans to one goal with the breeze while kicking two against it and went into the last break 15 points up. It was going to be a herculean effort for Swans to dig themselves out and it wasn't to be as the Docker filled side ran away with the game with the breeze in the last quarter eventually winning by 47 points. Congratulations to Andrew and the team for making it as far as they did and had circumstances been a bit different, who knows, but there's always next year.
