PRESIDENTS REPORT 1995

Season 1995 started in fine fashion with the Presidents, Secretaries and Sponsors Dinner at Gloucester Park. The night was a success for the sponsors who were able to meet the personnel in charge of each club and advertise their product to them. It is extremely important to this League that clubs honour our sponsors by using their products or taking advantage of and promoting their deals. If Clubs don't do this then the Sponsors dollars will dry up and the League will be forced to restructure affiliation fees accordingly. All Clubs are aware of the value of sponsors and the league is no different, so by promoting and presenting good sponsorship packages to you we are all trying to keep your costs at a manageable level.

Even though the season began with a disagreement between the Umpires Association and the League, I must say that the overall standard of umpiring was very good. Umpires Board Chairman John Davies and his committee and Umpires Adviser Phil O'Reilly worked very hard towards a common goal to raise standards and fitness and it definitely showed with the high standard in the top grades. The top echelon of umpires set some very high personal standards and some were rewarded with games in Adelaide, Darwin, Hong Kong and WAFL Reserves. I congratulate them, the Appointment Board and Phil O'Reilly on a job well done and wish them all success for the future.

Our State Team suffered losses against the Country and South Australia this year and those selected players now realise the difference in intensity between Club football and State football. The games were a good experience at playing quality football for a full 100 minutes and I'm confident that players selected to represent WA next year will give a stronger performance and reverse the results. The State personnel, along with coaches John Nykyforak and Bill Armstrong have been appointed again and are looking towards 1996 with very positive attitudes.

All aspects of the Metropolitan Football Leagues Council have been finalised and our funding from the Ministry of Sport will continue to come to us through the WAFC. Our affiliation with the Sunday League, Peel, Hills, Women's Football and Superrules now gives us a solid base in Metropolitan football for the future.

The Investigation Committee and Reinstatements Committee are again to be thanked for doing their job., All personnel involved are ex players and I thank you for your contribution back into the game.

The highest accolade must go to the Clubs themselves, who provide the players, coaches, managers, trainers, timekeepers, goal, boundary and central umpires and personnel who make this competition the solid one it is today. Countless hours are voluntarily given each season, some with reward and recognition and some without, but you continue to front up again and again and I thank you all and congratulate you for doing what you like most - being involved in Amateur football.

Congratulations to Scarborough on their undefeated season and their first A Grade Grand Final victory. Also to all victors in all grades my congratulations go to you and I wish you success in the next grade in 1996.

All of the Fairest and Best medal winners are to be congratulated for their achievements. All were well received at our Medal Night at Gloucester Park which was a very successful night.

The Management Committee operated enthusiastically and efficiently and although some attendances were down, due to work commitments, the overall contribution by the members is to be congratulated.

The Office Staff continued to give good service and the efficient way they handled hundreds of questions and requests is testimony to their commitment. To our Executive Officer, Neil "Grumpy" Judge and the smiling Avis and Diane I thank you once again and wish everyone success for the future years ahead.

At the end of 1994 UAB Chairman Max Hasson stood down after several seasons. His retirement was a loss to the WAAFL as well as to umpiring appointments in particular. However, Max set in place some of the major achievements for 1995. The appointment of highly respected and credentialed Umpires Coach Phil O'Reilly saw a major change in several directions.

Phil a former WAFL and AFL Umpire with his close contacts in the WAFL Umpiring fraternity moved the Umpires training venue from McGillivray Oval to Ernest Johnson (South Perth) Oval. This venue has been set up solely for Umpires training and various facilities including a lecture room and social room.

The Umpires Appointment Board met every Tuesday at midday during the season to assess performances and confirm appointments. To those members Bruce Wainwright, Kevin Thomas (Secretary) Ross Howlett, Terry Kenny, Phil O'Reilly and Jim Turley a sincere thank you for your untiring support and valuable input.

A crackdown on several undesirable aspects of the game hopefully has brought about a more enjoyable atmosphere. Those areas included: abusive and obscene language directed at Umpires and opponents, hitting behind the play, officials on the sidelines behaviour, players and officials continually questioning Umpires decisions.

With a greater fitness level achieved under fitness coach Craig Curtis, I feel Umpires standards have been more consistent.

Several younger Umpires were blooded throughout the season, having first started on the boundary and graduating to field has put pressure on some longer serving senior Umpires to perform. Some of the 1995 rookies will no doubt be vying for top senior honours in 1996.

Already at the end of the season an Umpires recruitment campaign was aimed at getting high school students involved. A successful, although small group graduated at the end of January 1996. We hope that this is the start of a regular campaign to encourage youth to get involved at a too often neglected area of football.

WAAFL panel Umpires were supplied in the two (2) Umpire system in A.B.C and D Grade as well as A.B and C Colts. Clubs supplied Umpires for the other seven (7) senior grades. Mr Michael Daff watched games throughout the year in club umpired games. Several of the most consistently performing Umpires were rewarded with interleague, interstate and overseas games. This hopefully will lead to more people wanting to participate in Umpiring as there are definite incentives. Also, several

of our field Umpires achieved promotion to control games in the WAFL, again pioneering a career path for those who aspire to greater levels.

1995 perhaps was one of the most exciting years for the Umpires as a whole, with further developments already approved for the 1996 Season. However, we must consider that we will go nowhere in the future if there is not the commitment for a planned recruitment programme. In the past an adhoc approach has been towards attracting new Umpires (field, goal and boundary). As mentioned a first step towards arresting the decline in numbers was taken by the UAB, with the first group of trainees, of what we hope is an on going programme targeted at high schools.

My sincere thanks to Neil Judge, Avis Beasley and Diane Clausen for their great support in preparing material for the UAB.

UMPIRE ADVISER'S REPORT 1995

The 1995 Coaching panel consisted of the following personnel:

The events within the Amateur Umpires Panel in season 1995 will be recorded as one of the most productive and positive periods in the history of the League and one that if allowed to continue, will eventually see a large crop of quality personnel serving the Clubs within this League.

This season the Panel Umpires moved to Ernest Johnson Oval, South Perth. There we joined the WAFL and AFL representative umpires and the merge was a great success. Interchange of umpires occurred and the opportunity for our umpires to be promoted to the WAFL games created extra effort in our Panel.

We suffered this season with retirements and some that did not want to adjust to change. Whilst these umpires were missed, they were replaced with enthusiastic new people and long term, will be the future of the Amateur Umpires Panel.

SPONSORSHIP: Sponsorship was sought by the Umpires and a generous Alf BARBAGALLO provided funds which allowed the Panel to purchase new uniforms and provide incentive rewards for effort and commitment. We hope Alf BARBAGALLO will continue as our No 1 Sponsor in 1996.

NUMBERS: The Boundary and Goal Umpires numbers were good and their performances throughout the year were first class. In 1996 these two groups will advance further with skill coaching of experienced WAFL Umpiring personnel.

The Field Umpire numbers were down and resulted in the Panel supplying coached field umpires to the A,B,C and D Grades and the A,B and C Colts Competition only. Whilst all other lower Grades and Club Umpires, the feedback from this area was not satisfactory and is an area the League will need to look at over summer to improve for season 96.

RECRUITMENT: Twenty Seven (27) new Field Umpires were recruited this season. Recruitment of umpires is difficult. Mainly due to the fact that people do not want the abuse that comes with the job. That is where the League must recognise the need to *reward* umpires who take on the task. Retiring players should be encouraged to take up the whistle. The umpires presently on the panel, with an Amateur Club background, are enjoying great success and find the Umpiring environment similar, even better, than the Club they served.

AWARDS/REWARDS: This season, with Sponsorship, the Panel Umpires enjoyed the opportunity of vying for two overseas holidays to Hong Kong and four interstate holidays to Darwin, N.T. The League contributed to these rewards being made and that is the best recruitment tool we can offer. *Rewards* for commitment.

Next season, with assistance from the League, the Prize for the best umpires will be a trip to Vancouver, Canada. Depending on Sponsorship obtained for 1996, other *rewards* will be offered for the Panel Umpires, that were in place this season.

PROMOTION: This season the umpires have been coached in skills training equal to the WAFL and AFL counterparts. They have been promoted within the League, deservedly, for their training and commitment. I am very happy with the performances for Panel umpires this season and know that next season we will be even better.

SEASON 1996: Several plans are in place for season 1996. A summer umpires course is set to run in November 1995. Already 20 people have indicated they will be taking part. A pre-season camp will call all umpires together in February. A pre-season Umpires Carnival is being planned which will involve A and B Grade Football teams. An end of season holiday is on the drawing board. Discussions will take place with the State Director of Umpiring, David JOHNSON, to further the interchange of umpiring personnel next season. There may be the opportunity to send one umpire to Karratha each weekend of next season to lift performances of the umpires in the North West Football competition. This opportunity will improve the communication skills and professionalism of our own umpires.

SUPPORT: Finally, I have had great support this season from John DAVIES, Chairman of the UYmpires Board. His dedication to his task has enabled many changes to Amateur Umpiring that will be visible in the near future. The members of the Selection Panel that observe umpiring performances this season have also done a fine job. Again, more observers are needed to do the job properly. Thanks also to the assistance given our Panel Umpires from Neil JUDGE, Avis and Diane at the League Office.

CONCLUSION: The Panel Umpires have done a great job this season and supported me with initiatives that have required more time and effort from each. We have turned the corner in regards to professionalism and the future looks bright for the Panel with an enthusiastic Committee creating a pleasant atmosphere to become involved in

For the future of Australian football, programmes such as the WAAFL's State Colts are a must. The commitment of the WAAFL to develop our football youth should be commended. The 1995 State Colts, if considered in terms of football development, was a successful venture.

Over the course of the season the State Colts played three games. The first of these games, against the Commonwealth Bank Cup Squad, was very early in our season. With the help of club coaches, a squad was hastily formed. It was unfortunate that, because of the hurried formation of the squad and communication difficulties, there were a few players who were overlooked. To avoid a similar occurrence colts coaches, including myself, need to be more alert about the week to week happenings in football.

However, I would like to thank all those club coaches that supported the programme. Your teams' short term loss (of players) was the individuals' and football's gain. I am confident that those players who were part of the State Colts gained valuable experience and knowledge.

There were some excellent individual performances in our three games. Against the Commonwealth Bank Cup Squad, Scott Keys (Swan Athletic) gave indications that he should develop into a valuable player. Mark Gostlow (Scarborough) was a strong player at Centre Half Back against the Great Northern Under 21's. In our final game in Geraldton there were many good players. Peter Toll (University) Jarrod Harben (Hamersley Carine) and Ben Carter (University) were among the best. Mention should be made of this year's captain Rick Lambly (Hamersley Carine), who over the three games led by example with his high skill level, tenacity and maturity.

I must thank the following people for their contribution this year:-

Martin Burgess (Manager/Selector) who worked tirelessly and enthusiastically throughout the programme, Phil Warren (Selector/Runner), Brian Kelly (Physiotherapist) and Norm Delavale (Trainer). Finally, thanks to the WAAFL's Neil Judge and Milton Sanders for their guidance and assistance.
