This document contains the Terms and Conditions under which the West Australian Football Commission (ABN 51 167 923 136) (Promoter) will offer rewards under its *Go For 2&5 WA Junior Footy Healthy Clubs Competition (Competition)*.

The Competition commences at 9:00am (WST) on Wednesday 5 August 2020 and concludes at 5:00pm on Friday 25 September 2020 (WST) (**Competition Period**).
