brief history

Beginning in 1922, in the WAAFL is now in its 90th year of operation. With 63 clubs, 235 teams and over 15,500 registered players, the WAAFL has grown from a six team competition to the largest organised football league in WA.

The WAAFL continues to focus on the future and how the league uses its leadership and resources to set new standards of excellence and relevance for its member clubs' and various committees. This is reflected in our vision *"The Western Australian Amateur Football League aspires to be a premier community sports competition."*

The WAAFL provides a quality high standard competition for those players not wishing to endue the commitment to WAFL (second tier competition) training due to study or career commitments or simply a lifestyle that considers football a recreational pursuit however is in a position to bridge the gap between amateur football and the Champions of tomorrow.





presidents report

In March 1922 there were calls for interested parties to form a new football competition in the Perth area. On Friday 18th March representatives from business houses of the city decided to form a Mercantile Football Association with six teams, commencing the competition on May 16th. Through 3 name changes, 1924 (Perth Districts Football Association, 1929 (WA Amateur Football Association) and finally in 1971 (WA Amateur Football League), that small competition has now grown into the largest single Australian Rules Football competition in Western Australia.

I am proud to be part of such a large organization that prides itself on providing an outlet for anybody at any level to participate or assist either as a player, administrator, volunteer, coaching staff, umpire, sponsor or supporter.

This year we celebrated our 90th anniversary since that humble beginning. The Western Australian Amateur Football League has been built on a solid foundation set in place by many hundreds of tireless volunteers over those years.

Today's unsung heroes (volunteers) associated with the 63 clubs and 235 teams continue to build the WAAFL into a highly respected and creditable sporting organization. The elected Board appreciates all those participants and thank you sincerely.

Clubs should be proud to be part of an organisation that continues to be given great recognition within the Western Australian football community. The achievements of our clubs to maintain financial viability and greater efforts in their administrative responsibilities and their willingness to embrace the directions laid down by the WAAFL Board has assisted to make both the League and Clubs more viable.

The WAAFL, as in past seasons is grateful for the help through the financial support provided by the WA Football Commission. Our corporate partners CUB, West Coast Eagles and Midway Ford, along with Cougar Sportswear, Sherrin, De Bortoli Wines, Granny's Pies, PowerPlay Sports, Elastoplast, Keystart Country, Actimed, Toyota Parts and Service and Australian Physiotherapy Equipment have contributed either financially or with products ensuring the stability of the League and as a result helped reduce the costs of participation of our thousands of players.

The WAAFL Board consists of talented and dedicated members who continue to give freely of their time. With their wide range of experience, expertise, business and management skills as well as their first hand knowledge of the amateur competition, have acted responsibly at both board and sub-committee level. All have served the League and Clubs well.

Many people continue to contribute in important parts of the WAAFL by making themselves available for various committees, sub-committees, tribunals, media, investigations, Hall of Champions, integrated football, state football and development

councils. All are necessary for the good governance of the League.

The Community Umpires Association has worked hard to put on the oval, good and competent umpires, whose performances have been commendable throughout the season. The Association has worked hard to retain numbers in all sections of umpiring.

The Competition Integrity Sub-Committee worked diligently throughout the season to speak to individuals in respect to alleged payments made to players in our competition. Over 42 interviews have been conducted during 2010 and 2011. There were some interesting results and they will continue their work in 2012.

For the first time in 19 years the Australian Amateur Football Council conducted a four state carnival. Held in Adelaide to commemorate the South Australian Football League 100th Anniversary, the West Coast Eagles U/23's finished runners up to Victoria. Many thanks to players, coaches, selectors and support staff who contributed to the success of the team.

The WAAFL continues to look closely at its structure and ability to carry out its mission and role to provide football at our level across the metropolitan area. With the continued growth of the League with the admittance of new clubs and many established clubs increasing their teams, it has put pressure on gaining suitable grounds. This may hinder the expansion of our game in areas where the required standard of facilities are being seriously looked at. Club development still remains a clear priority of the Board, to assist clubs in the basic fundamentals on how to comply with various demands and requirements.

Congratulations to all premiership teams and clubs, players who gained All Australian selection or state selection, individuals who won League awards and club personnel who were awarded "Volunteer Recognition Awards" for long service.

The WAAFL would like to acknowledge the valuable support given by retiring West Australian Football Commission CEO, Wayne Bradshaw. Throughout Wayne's 10 years he has always been available to discuss football matters in an open, transparent and honest way. His attendance at many of the WAAFL events and functions, despite his heavy workload, has been appreciated. Amateur football is grateful for your support over the past decade.

In conclusion, gratitude to all clubs and volunteers for your involvement in our 90th year. Special thanks to those retiring after years of unselfish service, we all appreciated your participation. Everyone's time and energy in assisting your club has contributed to make us a better football and community based organization.

2011 highlights

- The WAAFL continued to grow in its 90th year by expanding to 235 teams. This included the addition of new member clubs in: Secret Harbour; Canning Vale; Noranda ECU and Swan Districts.
- The completion of the first premiership season for the WAAFL Integrated Football competition. A total of 5 teams competed from: Fremantle CBC (Premiers); Lynwood Ferndale; High Wycombe; Kingsway and Warnbro. The success of the competition was recognized by the Minister of Sport and Recreation with an invitation to premiership players to attend Parliament House
- The WAAFL reinvested over \$50,000 back to its member clubs through the League Development Fund.
- The WAAFL elevated its exposure through the online broadcasting of 11 fixtures over the finals series. This resulted in over of 15,000 views of the games during the month of September.
- The WAAFL launched its own website in June with monthly traffic to the site equal to that of any WAFL club.
- The West Coast Eagles U/23 State Amateur team was defeated by Victoria Amateur Football Association at the 2011 AAFC National Carnival, held to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the South Australian Amateur Football League. The WAAFL side defeated both Tasmania and South Australia to earn the right to tackle the Victorians for the title.
- The WAAFL had 6 players selected in the All Australian team: Josh Stott (North Beach); Curtis Jack (Kalamunda); Joe Boys (North Beach); Michael McCann (North Fremantle); and Cameron Manuel (Swan Athletic)
- The WAAFL partnered with the WAFC undertook a senior metropolitan community facilities audit. This included over 70 clubs having their facilities assessed to develop a report that ranked clubs in order of priority for development.
- The WAAFL welcomed new sponsor partners in De Bortoli Wines; Actimed and Australian Physiotherapy Equipment.
- The WAAFL introduced its own 'Volunteer Recognition Award'. This provided clubs the opportunity to recognize those volunteers that have provided service for 10 years or greater. Over 40 volunteers were presented this award in 2011.
- Our largest Medal Presentation night with over 800 guests attending the event at Burswood Entertainment Complex.
- A highly successful second Hall of Champions function was held at Patersons Stadium. A further 8 persons were inducted on this night in two different categories.



general managers report

Entering its ninth decade in 2011, the WAAFL remains the envy of many sporting organizations in Western Australia. Our strength both on and off the field is exemplified through the competitive nature of our grades, the strong participation numbers at our clubs, the strength of our representative program, the growing diversity of the programs delivered and the diligence and commitment of club administrators and volunteers.

The values on which the WAAFL was founded on 90 years ago – playing for the love of the game – are still very much at the core of the competition today. It is this simple ethos that has been the rock solid foundation that we can continue to innovate, build capacity and respond to the modern day realities.

The 2011 season ushered in significant changes and developments that continue to elevate the WAAFL's status as a premier community sporting organization. The Integrated Football program completed its inaugural home and away season. With the addition of two new clubs in the Warnbro Swans and High Wycombe fostering teams, they joined Fremantle CBC, Lynwood Ferndale and Kingsway to cement a five team competition. Going through the season undefeated, Fremantle CBC got their just deserves by holding off a gallant Lynwood Ferndale in the grand final. Beyond the success of the first competitive season, there was the invitation from the Minister of Sport and Recreation to the Fremantle CBC premiership players to Parliament House. The Minister met the players, families and club officials followed by a personal invitation inside WA's parliamentary home. The magnitude of the Integrated Football program gaining such high level recognition after beginning as a concept in 2009 vindicates the WAAFL's ability to lead and innovate.

The WAAFL landscape is always a work in progress. The new partnership with WAFL club, Swan Districts, and the Department of Corrective Services added another highlight to the canvas. The introduction of the Wooroloo Prison Farm into the E1 competition formed part of the V Swans New Horizons Program. The program, led by ex-West Coast Eagle Peter Matera and ex-Swan Districts player Danny Penny, was a personal development program which provides members of the Wooroloo Prison Farm pathways to football, education and career opportunities.

The participants of the program competed under the Swan Districts FC banner, finishing the season in top position and narrowly losing the grand final. Each participant of the program completed their Level 1 AFL Youth Coach Accreditation and

received further personal development seminars on topics such as drug and alcohol awareness and nutrition and healthy eating. The program has been hailed as success with 36 participants completing the program in its inaugural year.

The ongoing loyalty and support from the corporate partners of the WAAFL over the past decade has been the fundamental reason why the WAAFL has been able to strengthen its financial position on a year to year basis. In 2011, the WAAFL implemented its League Development Fund. This provided all member clubs the opportunity to seek financial support in the purchasing of key resources and assist in the training of volunteers. In total, over \$50,000 was reinvested by the League back to the clubs through this new initiative.

The WAAFL, while being a premier community sporting competition, recognises that it must continue to identify new strategies to promote and expose the quality competition that it is. Over this season's finals series, the WAAFL engaged Local Media Services Co to provide live video and commentary coverage of 11 games. This coverage included teams from A grade to C2 grade with teams from the colts, reserves and league. All games were able to be viewed on the new WAAFL website with the initiative receiving accolades from many circles in the industry and abroad.

No season would be a success without the tireless work of many hands. I would personally like to acknowledge the efforts of those involved in community football for their outstanding contribution and commitment given in 2011. My appreciation also extends to the WAAFL Board and the Community Football Office staff for their support and service. Special recognition must go to long serving staff member Matt Henson who, after 9 years involved with amateur football has pursued other career opportunities. His contribution to the WAAFL during this time has been greatly appreciated.

To the family, teammates and friends of Kyle Thomas, who tragically passed away after a collision playing for his beloved Bullcreek Leeming AFC in the grand final, we pass on our deepest sympathy and respect. Kyle was an inspiring captain and a passionate player of amateur football. Herein lays the true value of our competition, one that our founders 90 years ago would be proud to of seen in Kyle's approach - *playing for the love of the game....*

west coast eagles under 23 state amateur team



The 2011 West Coast Eagles WAAFL State Under 23 program commenced in April with in excess of 80 of the best young community based footballers putting their hand up to participate.

With the lure of representing their state in Adelaide at the first National Carnival since 1994, the quality of those keen to play was outstanding and made for a very difficult selection process. The program was focused on identifying players with the ability and traits to play 'A Step Above' with the players constantly challenged to test themselves and push their limits to the next level.

The lead up games proved to be a great platform to build on, with the side being overrun by a far more mature and experienced State Country side in our first contest together, eventually going down by 5 goals. The squad backed that performance up by drawing an even contest against Peel League. Both games were played with spirit and gave our squad of young players the opportunity to gauge the intensity and style of football that would be played in Adelaide.

The National Carnival saw the introduction of a new format, with all sides playing 3 qualifying games of 40 minutes duration. The qualifying fixtures were scheduled over the first 2 days of the carnival which was very testing of the groups approach to rehabilitation and maintaining our focus of being 'A Step Above'.

Our first game of the carnival pitted us against Tasmania, a side that had never tasted victory in any of their state games. In very wet and slippery conditions, we managed to sneak home with the last kick of the day, with Joe Boys managing to kick a goal from a tight angle and give us the win by 2 points. After a short break to re-group, the team backed up against the home side in SA, which we managed to control from the outset and go on to win comfortably by 21 points.

Having been victorious in our opening two games on the first day, we entered our last qualifying game against Victoria knowing we would face off again in the Grand Final two days later. WA entered the game with the intent on winning and in an entertaining contest, WA was just outplayed to the tune of 9 points.

Whilst disappointed by the defeat against the Vic's, the team gained instant belief in their abilities and work ethic, knowing with attack and pressure they could taste ultimate success in the Grand Final.

WA entered the Grand Final against Victoria with the full squad available for selection, and were confident in our chances of becoming AAFC National Champions. WA's attack on the football when in dispute was outstanding in the first half and saw us enter the main break just 8 points down, however a major injury suffered by our fullback Max Alexander just before the break, proved to be damaging.

Forced to shuffle the side around, we returned in the second half with the game there to be won but couldn't match the at-

tack of Victoria who outplayed us in the 3rd quarter and went on to win by 70 points, with the final scores being 14.20 (104) to 5.4 (34).

The AAFC National Carnival was an outstanding success and whilst the final score in the Grand Final was disappointing, it was not a true reflection on the contest and endeavor shown by the WA side.

Of the 26 players who had the opportunity to don the black swan state jumper, only 2 players had previous representative experience, meaning huge scope for improvement in future program's. We had representatives from 13 amateur clubs, with opportunities given to players from all grades with a final travelling party consisting of 16 players from A Grade, 6 from B Grade and 4 from C Grade.

From a coaches perspective I'm extremely proud of the entire team and although we fell just short of our goal to become national champions, their response to a new game plan and the challenges thrown at them were always met with enthusiasm. I'd like to congratulate the six WA boys selected in the AAFC All Australian side; WA Captain Mick McCann from North Fremantle; Curtis Jack from Kalamunda; Cameron Manuel from Swan Athletic and Josh Stott, Cale Potts & Joe Boys from North Beach, with Joe Boys also winning the Tetley Award for the best player in the WA State Program. All of these men were thoroughly deserving of the honor and represented the WAAFL with pride.

The success of this years State Program was further highlighted post carnival with 5 players going onto play WAFL football, with Josh Stott making his league debut with East Perth in their final home and away clash.

I'd like to sincerely thank John Davies and his board for showing a bit of faith and giving me the opportunity to lead the WAAFL into the AAFC National Championships. In particular, I'd like to mention the efforts and tireless work of WAAFL General Manager, Cameron Agnew and his staff, State Team Coordinator Peter Grosser and Geoff Palmer, who without their commitment there would be no WAAFL State team.

I'd also like to thank my own team, with the success of the program in no small part resulting from their involvement and individual strengths; Assistant Coaches Jamie White, Darren Von Bergheim and Paul Matthews, along with Chairman of Selectors Warren Eddy, Property Manager Guy Ziati, Head Trainer John Grierson and runner Wade McGrath.

In closing special mention must go to all the players, coaches and their community clubs as without their input and support, WAAFL State Representative football wouldn't be as alive, vibrant and competitive as it is today.

The 2011 WAAFL State Colts program started in the first few weeks of April, with trial games and training sessions being very intense and focusing on developing a game plan that not only would be beneficial at this level but also giving the players opportunities for their own development back at club level. The goal for this program was to ensure that players selected came away with a different skill set that saw them improve elements of their game. This was assisted by specific training drills and visiting coaches such as Simon Easthaugh from the West Coast Eagles.

While some players were unable to attend certain nights we eventually settled on a squad that was not only capable, but one that we could see could learn from the program. This was proven at the first game in Pinjarra where it took several quarters for the team to adjust to the playing style we were looking for. This all came together at the end of the 3rd and during the 4th quarter where we able to step away from the WACFL side and win by a comfortable margin on the night.

The second game saw us face off against the Peel Football League (PFL) in Rockingham. We started well from the first bounce and really played exciting football. However, the momentum did stop and the commitment to doing the hard things in footy fell away allowing the PFL to come into the game and made it very much a contest. We were able to stick with it although a few players learnt the value of staying with the game plan and not playing individual footy to just get over the line.

The final game of the program saw the WAAFL State Colts face off with the State 16's in an AFL curtain raiser at Paterson's Stadium. This was no doubt our pinnacle game and something the players had really pushed themselves towards. The game itself was of an exceptional quality with the lead changing many

times during the course of the match. Unfortunately we were unable to get up and lost by a few points (after the match was cut short by the AFL for television coverage). No matter this was an outstanding opportunity for the players to be exposed to this level and no doubt allowed WAFL and AFL representatives to assess the skill and ability level of the WAAFL players.

While many of our players acquitted themselves well over the three games there are a few that I would like to mention in particular who were Travis Turner, James Pember, Jack Catrall, Matthew Bluett and Alex Dowson.

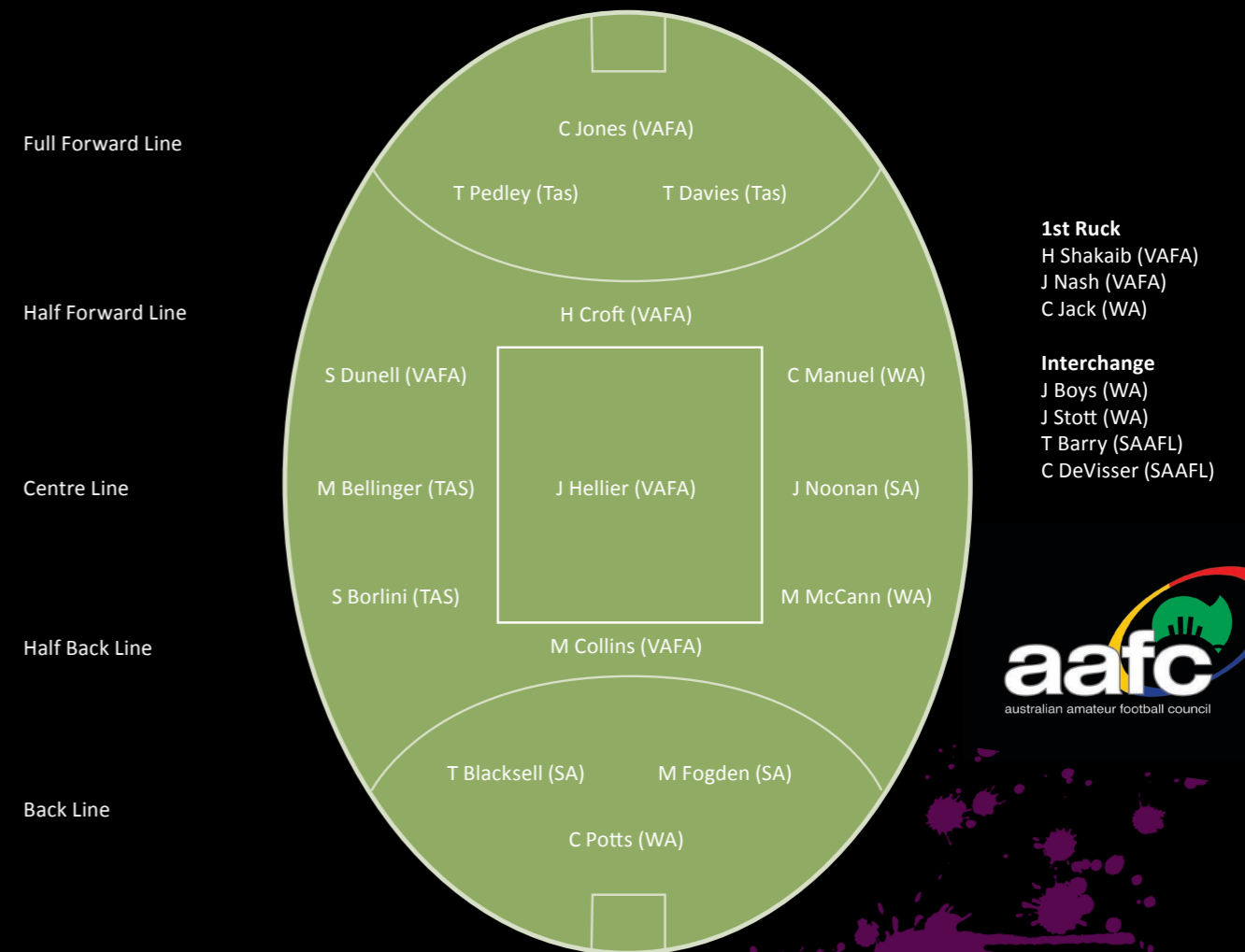

wa afl integrated football

THE WA Amateur Football League Integrated Football Program completed its third year in 2011, its first of fully structured competition.

Integrated Football provides footballers with an intellectual disability the opportunity to play Australian rules in a fully structured competition. Five clubs nominated teams in 2011, with Fremantle CBC, Warnbro, Kingsway, Lynwood Ferndale and High Wycombe playing each other once throughout the year.

The season proved to be a tremendous success, culminating in the Grand Final between Lynwood Ferndale and Fremantle CBC in front of more than 300 spectators.

Fremantle CBC won the inaugural Integrated Football Premiership by 20 points, with Nicolas Rogerson being awarded the best on ground medal for his performance.

The success of the program was acknowledged when the Minister for Sport and Recreation the Hon. Terry Waldron met with the Fremantle CBC players, parents and officials on the steps of Parliament House.

Mr Waldron spent 30 minutes learning about the journey the Integrated Football Program had taken over the past three years, and took the opportunity to commend the WAAFL and all those involved with the program at the beginning of question time.

The WA Amateur Football League are working with Ausrapid, the Department of Sport and Inclusion WA to support and grow the Integrated Football Program in 2012 and beyond.

THE WA Amateur Football League hosted its second annual Hall of Champions dinner in 2011, inducting four Champions and four High Achievers in front of more than 250 guests at Patersons Stadium.

Beginning in 2010, the Hall of Champions concept honours great contributors to the WAAFL, both on and off the playing field, as well as those who began their careers at an amateur level before going on to contribute at higher tiers.
