The AFL and WAFC have released the National Concussion Guidelines for Australian Football at all levels of Community Football, based upon current medical advice. Please download the AFL approved App HeadCheck to assist with recognizing any suspected concussions. Refer to WAFC website www.wafc.com.au for more information.

Please be advised there will be further information circulated regarding the new Concussion and Returning to Football Policy (developed to align with concussion guidelines), but for any player returning to football after sustaining and recovering from a medical procedure, serious injury or illness that required medical attention.
