

# 2025 “Starkick All-Abilities” Design a Jumper Competition

It is with pleasure we invite your school to participate in the **2025** Starkick design a jumper competition, for Education support students. Your application package is enclosed, with instructions and contact details. Good luck and we look forward to seeing your students’ entries!

**Aim:** *To have students demonstrate a sense of school pride/identity and get involved in football in a cross-curricular manner, this activity can also assist engaging those students who would not necessarily participate in sports.*

## Competition details:

- Entries close **Friday July 4th, 2025**
- Students **MUST** be enrolled within an Education Support School or centre to participate in this competition.
- Entries are restricted to students enrolled between **Year 3 through Year 8**
- **Maximum 2 entries** per school.  
*(We encourage all students to participate in the activity, however schools must undertake their own selection process to **choose the 2 entries to be entered in the competition** in line with the competition rules)*
- Entries to include a short reflection on the students reasons for their design. *(Teachers may assist in writing this summary)* We recommend students are encouraged to pay attention to local landmarks, their school ethos, location as well as local population demographics when considering their design.
- Entries must be scanned and uploaded for judging purposes.
- **Please note:** Any designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork (sometimes referred to as “dot-paintings”) due to sensitive cultural reasons, can only be submitted if they were created by an Aboriginal student. Teachers are not permitted to submit any non-Aboriginal student designs that contain traditional Aboriginal artwork.

## Judging Details:

- Entries will be judged by a panel from WA Football.
- The Education Support Centre or School with the entry selected to be the best and most thoughtful design will WIN a Full set of Football jumpers replicating the submitted design, produced by ISC.
- The Winning design will be announced in Term 3 in line with the Starkick Education Support Football Carnival.
- Jumpers will be presented to the school at a mutually agreed time and place.
