8:00am: Gates Open

12:30pm: Juniors are asked to begin arriving (if not arriving earlier to watch the Reserves Game). Players and Officials from Junior Clubs to Arrive and be seated in marked areas on grassed banks **POSITION A** (see attached map)
Clubs are provided the opportunity erect banners and marquees within your designated area. We recommend these are erected prior to 12.30pm.

1:20pm: Junior Clubs to be in position in their club areas.

1:20-1:30pm: Claremont Development Officer will report to each junior club and brief club officials.

1:40pm: Reserves finish

1:42pm: Scotch College Pipe Band leads parade. Players and Officials from Junior Clubs follow on to the oval for the parade **MOVE TO POSITION B** (see attached map).

1:46pm: Claremont enters the arena

1:47pm: East Fremantle enters the arena

1:48pm: PA instructs Players and Officials from Junior Clubs to move onto the oval – PA begins Parade Day announcements
Parade begins moving along to front inside boundary line to **POSITION C** before moving to the back of the centre square lined in club groups **POSITION D** (see attached map).

Cones will be lined up equally spaced in 10 positions marking placement for each clubs to stand.

Clubs to line up behind each cone staying in number order.

1:55pm: Opening Ceremony officially begins

2:03pm: Unveiling of plaque

2:04pm: National Anthem is played

2:05pm: PA to announce Players and Officials from Junior Clubs to depart oval

POSITION E (Clubs are asked to depart the ground quickly for game to start on time)

2.15pm: League Match commences

2:30pm: *Selection Panel (District Chair, Competition Director, Assistant Competitors/s, Administrator and Development Officer) to meet in Function Room briefly to select top three winners.*

Development Officer to enter winners on announcer's sheet with support from CFC staff.

Half Time: Junior Parade Club Award winner announced

Suggestions:

- 1) Get players wearing club colours and / or uniform
- 2) Engage your club mascots
- 3) Be creative with banners, signs etc.
- 4) Encourage as many members as possible to attend across all age groups

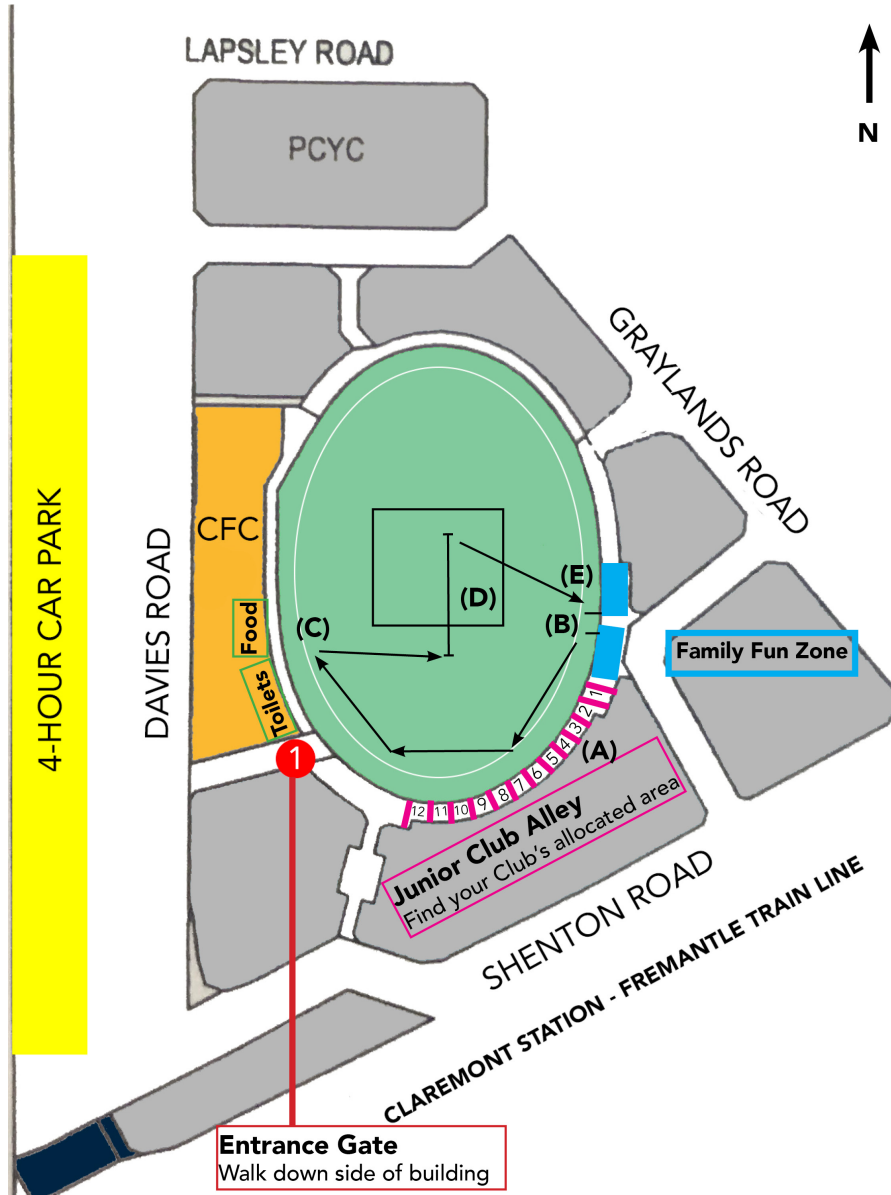
