Subject: Central Conference Competition – 2016 Finals Procedures

To Junior Community Clubs, Coaches and Team Managers

With the 2016 Finals upon us, the Central Conference Executive takes this opportunity to remind all participants of their requirements and responsibilities. In order to ensure a successful finals campaign, the following criteria is to be observed and **strictly** adhered to at all times. Teams failing to comply with these guidelines will be penalised.

Eligibility to play finals

All clubs competing in the Central Conference Finals series are required to be financial with their respective District Football Development Council in accordance to bylaw Rule 52, in particular 52(h) which says:

(h) For a club to participate in any finals, a club MUST be financial with JCC, DFDC and WAFC.

Attire Standards

The required attire for the finals is as follows:

- Club Officials must be identified with Club shirt and badge;
- Water Persons must wear clearly marked fluoro vests at all times;
- Team Runners must wear clearly marked fluoro vests at all times; and
- Any First Aid person in attendance must wear a white shirt with a red armband or be clearly identified.

Match Day Procedures

The match day procedures are as follows:

1. Host Club to supply scoreboard and scoreboard attendants;
2. Host Club to ensure the interchange area and coaches boxes are correctly marked and roped off in accordance with the JCC requirements;
3. Teams are to use the Interchange correctly as outlined in the By-laws and AFL Rules, this includes Players and Team Runners
4. In the case of any team using two Team Runners only one Runner is permitted on the playing arena at any time
5. Interchange stewards and an appropriate device for each team is required to be supplied for the duration of the finals (including Grand Finals)
6. Match Ball – both teams competing in the game are required to provide a match football for the first 3 weeks of finals (Grand Final will be supplied by WAFC). The football is required to be a PREMIER burley (size respective of age group), and should be of a quality standard. If the football is not of a quality standard, the umpires have been instructed to request another.
7. Change rooms are out of bounds to all except Team Officials and Players involved in the games being played, and must be cleaned and tidied at the conclusion of the game;
8. All Players are requested to be at the ground 45 minutes prior to the commencement of the game;
9. In the event the JCC does not have enough boundary & goal umpires available for any finals game then Clubs must provide their own Boundary and Goal umpires. Teams will be advised of this by the Thursday prior to the game.

10. All players must be in correct club uniform. Team Managers and Coaches are reminded that players not in full Club uniform, which is correct Team Shorts, Socks and Club Jumper, will be fined.
11. Each Player on the team sheet must play at least half a game as required by **By-law 26.5**. Player rotation will be closely monitored by the JCC. Failure to do so, may result in the game being awarded to the opposing team – this will be left at the discretion of the Central Conference Executive.

During the Match

1. For all games during the Finals series only Team Officials are allowed in the Coaches designated area and must remain **behind the safety line** whilst the game is in progress.

The number of Team Officials allowed in this area is to be no more than 8 persons, and may include the following:

- Coach;
- Assistant Coach;
- Team Runner x 2;
- Water Person x 2; (**shall be an adult: By-law 22.7**)
- First Aid; and
- Club Official.

Parents and spectators will be permitted on the ground near the team huddles during the ¼ time and ¾ time breaks. This will be monitored throughout the finals series, and the JCC reserves the right to remove parents and spectators if required during ¼ time and ¾ time breaks. The onus will be put onto clubs to ensure positive parent and spectator behaviour.

2. Any Team not complying with the above Criteria and Procedures will be penalised, and this may include the loss of all scores in the game.
3. Time will be kept by a supplied timekeeper from the hosting club. In accordance to the rules of Australian Rules football, time will commence once the ball has been thrown (or bounced) to start the quarter, and not when the siren sounds. Time will not be taken from the Interchange App.

Officials, Players and Spectators are reminded of their respective Codes of Conduct and the East Perth, Perth and Swans JCC's, will deal with any Official, Player and/or Spectator who are seen or heard to go against these codes. Unruly behaviour, including obscene language, smoking & drinking will not be tolerated in any way. Clubs and Teams will be held responsible for any Official, Player and or Spectator found to be breaching their respective Codes of Conduct.


Further, should an official be reported and found guilty of any offence during the final series, the joint JCC's reserve the right to remove all scores from the offending team, thus forfeiting the game.
