AUSTRALIAN PRIVACY COLLECTION NOTICE WAFC (TRADING AS WA FOOTBALL) WEBSITE

In order to comply with our obligations under the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) (**Privacy Act**), we are required to notify you of certain matters when we collect your personal information (**Notice**). These matters are outlined below.

Why we collect your personal information?	We collect your personal information in order to provide our services. By accessing our website, we will collect your personal information in order to: (a) provide you with information or updates about the WAFC, football in Western Australia and our events; and (b) for internal purposes including the administration of our website, data analytics, compliance with law, legal processes or our internal policies and procedures.
Who will we disclose your personal information to and will this be overseas?	In order to provide our services to you and for the purposes specified above, we may need to disclose your personal information to third parties, which may include third party service providers who may help us, for example, to conduct promotions, competitions or fundraisers or to determine what marketing information you might find useful. Such third parties are generally located in Australia. The WAFC ensures that your personal information is not disclosed overseas otherwise than in accordance with the Privacy Act.
Do we collect sensitive information?	We do not ask for, and do not knowingly collect, sensitive information from you.
