The 2022 Yearbook and Financial Report is dedicated to the memory of Bill Forrest. Bill passed away in November 2022, aged 97. For more than 50 years, Bill maintained an integral role within the workings of the East Perth Football Club.

Bill started in football administration with the Coolbinia-Yokine Junior Football Club in 1960. He then moved his attention to the East Perth Junior

Football Council, where he served for 20 years in a number of roles, including Assistant Secretary, Treasurer and President for 11 years,

He presided over the formation of the East/West competition, which saw the merging of the East Perth and West Perth Junior Councils. The regionalisation of junior football when the WAFL introduced new boundaries for the 1991 saw the emergence of the Central Districts Junior Football Association, and Bill served as President from 1991-96 and was a member of the Tribunal from 1997-2000.

At East Perth level, Bill was a club member since 1960, serving as manager of the 16s' Development Squad before moving on to the Board in 1982 for nine years, with two of those years as Vice-President.

Between 1987-2010, Bill was a voluntary office worker at East Perth. During this time, he researched player profiles, maintained player records, and computerised and maintained the membership records of the club and coordinated and assisted with the Annual Yearbook.

For the past decade, Bill focused on historical aspects of East Perth and was widely respected as the club's historian, with such marvellous achievements as the publication of The Royals 100-year history book and the establishment of the Hall of Fame. Thanks to Bill, East Perth has the most extensive record of historical and statistical records, photos and videos of any WAFL club .

Bill was awarded several honours and accolades including East Perth Life Member (1983), National Football League Merit Award (1988), Life Member of several Junior Football Councils and Associations, Australian Sports Medal (2000), Life Member of the West Australia Football Commission (2001) and an inductee into the East Perth Football Club Hall of Fame.

Thanks for everything, Bill, we'll miss you.

We certainly experienced the highs and lows of a football season in 2022.

After commencing the season with some very promising performances, we saw the second half fall dramatically away in both the league and reserves. The shining light was our colts who played finals but unfortunately did not advance past the first elimination final.

The disappointment of the season was felt by all and a full review of the Football Club was undertaken with a very rigorous search and interview process taken to find a replacement coach.

Ross McQueen was appointed on a two-year contract after having been involved at the Club as an assistant coach for the past two seasons. Ross has a steep knowledge and successful background in coaching, and I am confident that his style and ability will drive our Club back to finals football.

On behalf of the Club, I wish to thank Jeremy Barnard and his family for their four years of commitment and dedication to East Perth. In particular, I would like to thank and acknowledge Barney for the work he achieved in setting the future foundations for success after having been a partnership club with the West Coast Eagles for the prior six seasons.

2022 was by no means smooth sailing. Amongst other things, the financial impact of having to shift two matches to East Fremantle Oval due to the Leederville Oval surface being unsafe for football. This included our blockbuster fixture against West Perth, and I do thank the supporters who travelled and supported all grades for these games.

With the season behind us, we got straight to work on improving all aspects of the Club. We have an exciting list of young players and for these men to go to the next level, we need to recruit youthful but experienced players who will complement our local player strengths and create a sustainable long-term playing structure to ensure that we will again be a powerhouse in the WAFL.

With this in mind, we looked each other in the eye and all agreed that our seniors underperformed given the talent we have, and this will be the catalyst to spur our revival in 2023.

We have been very targeted in our recruiting efforts and have gone to great lengths to present the Club as a professional outfit. To date, we have signed Mitchell Crowden (formerly Fremantle Dockers) and Harrison Macreadie (formerly Carlton) as a key backman, and the pen has not been put to rest as I write this report. Both Mitch and Harrison will certainly complement our budding local talent.

Our captain for the past two seasons, Jackson Ramsay, has decided to retire on medical advice but will be around the Club in a mentoring and coaching role. On behalf of the Club, I wish to thank Jackson for his contribution since returning in 2018. His best was better than anyone's in the competition. The leadership Jackson has shown in his time back at the Club cannot be overstated throughout this very important rebuild and transition back to being a traditional Club.

The most significant announcement for the Club this year was being granted a WAFLW licence for 2023. Well done to Jo Davies, Jason Wittorff-Bloom, Craig Matthews and Angus Schumacher for their dedication and hard work to get this licence, against all odds. We are tremendously excited for the growth of women's football at the Club and the importance it bears for female players in our districts.

There have already been several initiatives put into place to grow female football within our metro and regional zones. We are working with the Southwest and Lower Southwest Football Leagues and Clubs to ensure female players in those regions can participate in our programs.

We started a partnership with Perth College through our

relationship with Adam Selwood (Head of Sport Development and Performance for the College) where we ran a pilot program for the students. The College committed to make their facilities available for events such as pre-season camps and training, giving the club a unique opportunity to access sporting facilities designed for female participants.

I would like to thank our off-field staff led by CEO Dean Turner for their continued efforts ensuring that the Club is run as a sustainable business. It took a huge effort this year to raise funds to allow this Club to work towards its goals on-field and in the community.

Thank you to the players, coaches and football staff led by Football Manager Warren Parker, who put in significant hours throughout the season, with results not an indication of that endeavour. Judging by the effort and commitment that so many of you are already putting in to ensure our success next season, I have no doubt that we have exciting times ahead in all grades.

I am sure all members will join with me in congratulating Reuben Ginbey, Jedd Busslinger and Jordyn Baker for being selected in the AFL Draft, as well as congratulating Sebit Kuek for his selection in the Mid-Season Draft, and we wish them all the very best in their future careers. We have now had six players drafted into the AFL system in 12 months, which speaks volumes for our male development program since getting the program back from the WAFC.

A special thank you to my fellow directors for their support and

guidance throughout the year, and to Alan Quartermaine who will leave the Board after 12 seasons, for his valuable contribution and efforts throughout his time as a director.

Challenges create opportunity and with dedication and commitment, these opportunities will lead the way to success and drive our Club forward.

There is plenty of work to be done by all sections of the Club in readiness for season 2023. I am personally very excited about it and look forward to sharing it with you all.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORT

The previous 12 months have presented East Perth with a unique set of challenges. Pleasingly for the Club and its members, there were also several positives that took place throughout the year.

Most significantly was the Club being granted a WAFLW license. This is a remarkable achievement for everyone involved. The growth of female football is exciting and for players in the East Perth Metropolitan and Country zones to have a clearly defined pathway from Auskick to AFLW is vitally important.

Since 2018, the cost of running the Club has risen from \$1.6 million to \$2.4 million for our 2023 budget. The contributing factors for this are the men's program returning to a traditional club model, the Club taking back the Talent program and our increased involvement in women's football. Clearly, all three of these aspects are crucial to the Club's future. Being a not-for-profit organisation, this significant increase in a short period of time has not been easy for our staff and volunteers. Despite this pressure, your commitment and dedication has been resolute, and I wish to thank you for all your efforts.

While being a not-for-profit organisation, the Club always sets out to achieve at least a breakeven result. In 2022 we were unable to achieve this and the Club will report an operating deficit of \$60,863. It is valid to point out that the initial budgeted loss was \$83,000 .

There are a number of reasons for this deficit, including increased spending on male football, the loss of two home matches throughout the season, including the game against West Perth, and the initial costs associated with applying for our WAFLW licence.

While lessened, COVID remained an influence, particularly early in the season. Not only did this affect our football department but our facilities and event business were also impacted.

Importantly for East Perth, we appear to have weathered the uncertainty of the previous years and can now focus on continuing to sustainably grow our great club.

The way we will grow the Club is through community programs. We are focused on;

- Talent programs based in the Southwest and Lower Southwest. Our pilot program in the Southwest this season was a tremendous success and will not only bare fruit for our colts and seniors, but will also pay dividends for our Southwest clubs.
- School-based participation programs. The East Perth zone is fortunate to be so multiculturally diverse and as per our constitution, it is our objective to ensure every child in our region has the opportunity to access football. This is vital to our sustainability as a club.
- Continue offering programs for the growth of female football. We led a terrific pilot program with Perth College and we will be looking to expand this in 2023.

Nobody at the Club is content with where we have finished in the past two seasons.

We are confident that the decisions we have made over the course of the year will lead to success in the future. Our best is good enough to beat the best and with continued development and a focus on



key recruits, our return to the top end of the ladder is imminent.

The excitement already brewing for 2023 is remarkable, and so we should be excited. If we are all committed to leaving no stone unturned in our pursuit for success, there is no better place to be than the East Perth Football Club. We are committed to working with our members and supporters to continue to improve our membership offerings and game-day experience. We are working our way through the 2022 Member and Supporters survey in the lead-up to next season. Thank you to everyone who completed this. There were some great suggestions, and we are eager to implement these.

I encourage all Royals supporters to throw their support behind the WAFLW women. Having the players see their club, the changerooms and the history for the first time has been incredible and made me take a step back and remember what it is that makes this club so great. All the players and their families, I have no doubt, will be wonderful assets to the Club going forward.

I would like to thank the Board of Directors for their continued guidance and efforts for 2022. Thank you to the club's staff for your effort throughout the year. Football is a unique industry and the number of things that are thrown at us on a daily basis has to be seen to be believed.

There have been countless examples of teams and clubs being able to turn their results around quickly. I look at what we have done in the previous couple of years and honestly believe that the building blocks of success are all there, and this is why I am truly excited for 2023. Go the Mighty Royals.

SENIOR FOOTBALL REPORT

Preparations for the 2022 season officially started for the senior players on Monday 15 November 2021 as we looked to continue developing for the future and building for the season ahead.

After finishing the 2021 WAFL league season with a 6-12 record, the playing group, coaches and administration were focused and committed to putting in place practices that would enhance player development and add wins to the record as we chased an elusive finals berth.

As a result, several initiatives were added to the program, including Leading Teams. Facilitated by Jenny Devine, the program focused on developing the leadership qualities of players and within the wider Football Department through the Leading Teams model which has been adopted by successful AFL clubs, including Hawthorn, Sydney and Geelong.

The Director of Coaching role was also added and saw Tony Micale return to the club to oversee the development of our coaches and coaching practices. Tony focused heavily on providing feedback and teaching coaching practices that would fast-track our development of players and improve training standards on the track, as well as our ability to coach for the win on game-day.

With Jeremy Barnard at the helm for his fourth season and the addition of high-quality players like Hamish Brayshaw (West Coast), Damon Greaves (Hawthorn/East Perth), Tom Wallis (Essendon), Thomas Medhat (West Perth), Kyle Hamersley (South Fremantle), Gordon Narrier (North Melbourne/Perth) and Elijah Taylor (Sydney/Perth), the foundation was set for improvement over the course of the season.

The preseason was still affected by COVID, with various delays and training modifications due to the COVID outbreaks experienced when the WA borders opened. The club put in place a COVID Management Plan, which I'm pleased to say was very effective in its implementation and outcomes. Our main objective was to ensure the health and safety of our players, coaches and staff while keeping outbreaks to a minimum to ensure we were able to field competitive sides each week.

Both the WAFL and AFL were affected by COVID at this time which saw the unavailability of players across the board and the implementation of COVID lists for both West Coast and Fremantle, giving the two local AFL clubs access to WAFL players should they experience COVID outbreaks. Hamish Brayshaw, Angus Schumacher, Damon Greaves and Jackson Ramsay were all included on these COVID lists, with Angus named as an emergency with West Coast on two occasions without playing a match.

The club did a great job of managing COVID over the course of the season and although not immune to it, we were able to get through the season with our highest level of unavailability being three players in a match. Considering other WAFL clubs were forced to make up to 10 changes in one game due to COVID unavailability, I think the players, coaches and staff did a great job in managing the landscape, which was certainly difficult to do given work and life outside of football. Let's hope those challenges ease on the industry moving forward as it's certainly been a challenge.

The league side started the season strongly (2-2) with wins against Swan Districts and Perth before falling to East Fremantle by 10 points in Northampton and suffering an agonising one-point defeat at the hands of Subiaco, while the reserves side went to the State game bye with a 3-1 record, including an impressive three-point comeback win against Subiaco after trailing by 32 points at three-quarter-time.

Four players were included in the WA state squad, which was great recognition for their solid starts to the 2022 WAFL season. Exciting young defender Jacob Msando was part of the initial squad but unfortunately did not make the final side. Hamish Brayshaw was named as an emergency for the match, while Angus Schumacher and Scott Jones made the final team that went down to South Australia by four points. This was great recognition of the talent that is starting to emerge within this young core group of players and shows bright signs for the future.

The AFL Mid-Season Draft on 1 June 2022 saw Sebit Kuek selected by Fremantle with pick 15 after starting the season with 16 Goals in the first five games. Although this was tough news for the club in losing a valued member of our team and someone who was impacting at a high level as a genuine full-forward, the club was very proud of Sebit and wish him all the best on his AFL journey at Fremantle.

As the season continued, both the league and reserves performances were best measured as inconsistent. The league side was able to compete with some of the best teams in the competition, falling just short of West Perth on WA Day and losing to South Fremantle by 11 points in Round 8 and 9 points in Round 19. One of the great highlights of the league season was the 26-point victory against eventual grand finalist Claremont. The day was made even more memorable as the players wore Heritage jumpers to mark the 1972 and 2002 premierships reunions taking place that day.

The reserves side, which combined with the league players, saw a total of 60 players represent the club in 2022, was very similar in its ability to compete at a consistent level over the course of the season. Although wins were not coming as frequently as first-year coach Jayden Heuer would like, the side was still in the mix for a finals berth right up until the final round of the season given the evenness of the ladder. Winning both matches against the eventual premiers, Subiaco, was encouraging for the squad moving forward and the likes of Ethan Regan, Jayden Peak, Patrick Reilly, Tom Graham, Adam Boules, Sandon Page and Mitchell Schofield, to name just a few, are players that we look forward to seeing develop into long-term footballers at the club.

As the season came to an end and finals were no longer on the horizon for the league side, at the request of Jeremy, a review of the Football Department was conducted and the decision was made that Jeremy and the club would mutually part ways effective immediately rather than see out the season. Ross McQueen was appointed as the interim coach for the final two matches of 2022.

Jeremy returned to East Perth to lead the rebuild of the club after the decision was made to exit the West Coast alignment in 2019, with his tenure including COVID-affected seasons and other challenges. From a Football Department point of view, we have nothing but

respect for Jeremy and what he's done for this great club and wish him, Steph, James, Tom and Audrey all the best in the future.

The 2022 season saw highs and lows. As a club, we firmly believe that we are on the path towards success. The foundations have been laid through hard work, passion and dedication by those currently at the club and by those who have recently departed. The playing list continues to grow with talented players becoming more attracted to joining the Royals, while our pathway continues to produce players both from our country and metro zones who are capable of playing AFL/WAFL football and will be part of our next successful era at East Perth.

COLTS COACH REPORT

When I started in this role two years ago, I stated that we wanted to be competing more often and more frequently against the best programs and clubs like the Claremonts, East Fremantles and West Perths.

This meant that we needed to replicate our successes from last year, carry over our best behaviours and standards, while incorporating a largely inexperienced group through the talent pathway. Our ability to build a united team, shared belief and confidence in each other would become the forefront of our efforts throughout the year.

We kicked off with our regular pre-Christmas strength and conditioning program, welcoming Jacob Smith on board, who took up this role with aplomb, and Travis Rawlins, our new backline coach. Leading into 2022, we had to reshape and reconfigure our list again, playing 47 players across the year, including 28 debutants. This was a tremendous achievement for the squad, who were extremely well-led by Darcy Miller, Jayden Cappeau, Bonnie Cubahiro, Zak Tetlow, Jedd Busslinger and Soka Soka.

We made a slow start to the initial part of the season and by Round 4 it was evident that we needed to make some strong choices in how we wanted to be defined and underline our purpose for the rest of the year. We were 27 points down halfway through the second quarter against a strong Subiaco side. However, we proceeded to chip away, continually turning up at the contest, and with a great account of ourselves defensively, we hit the front late in the last quarter and were never headed. This was the impetus for an incredible run-on.

We welcomed back Tom Hallett at Claremont, after 631 days between games, and were presented with an outstanding 5-goal debut performance from 15-year-old Bienfat Kihusa in a resounding victory. This led to us going up to an undefeated West Perth, for our WA Day derby fixture, with a growing confidence in our style and purpose. What came over the next two hours, without Jedd Busslinger and Jordyn Baker, was one of toughest and sweetest home-and-away victories within the colts program in several years.

Peel was next, and in cyclonic conditions on a Saturday night at Rushton Park, we were under huge pressure all night but duly hung in there to ground out another big win given the strength of the opposition and conditions. Of note was that our small forward trio of Bonnie Cubahiro, Alex Yiannakis and Bienfat Kihusa had 18 tackles and kicked 7 goals between them. The return of Claremont on our home deck produced as dominant a victory as we've had in several years against a perennially strong Tigers side. We kicked two goals in two minutes to open the game and led a strong procession from there on in to record a 10-goal win. With workmanlike victories against Swans and Perth after this, it was evident that the belief and confidence amongst the group was at an all-time high. We had an incredible buy-in, with all players recognising and performing their roles to a competition-high standard.

In the last third of the season, we were met with more pressing challenges to the depth of our list. We lost Mitch Williams, who made the WAFL Colts Team of the Year from 12 games to showcase his presence, for the year but had some outstanding contributions from several players who just grew with their consistency and performance, week on week. During this time, we had return fixtures against the best teams in Peel, Subiaco and West Perth, and

although we started well with great intensity, ultimately, we didn't execute well enough and couldn't go with these best sides for 100 minutes.

We finished fourth on percentage and landed in an elimination final versus Souths. After a see-sawing game across the whole day, we didn't have the juice to grind this out and ultimately our mountain to climb was too big in the end, given the personnel challenges we had to overcome. We thrived throughout the year to keep turning up, but we just couldn't get it done this time and, sure enough, after beating every single team at some point throughout the year, our season came to a sudden halt.

I want to take this opportunity to firstly thank the Football Club for the opportunity to again coach the colts; from Dean, Warren, Aaron and Nick, their support and guidance throughout the year was well-recognised. Our support staff was extremely well-led by absolute professionals in Jacob and Emma and their set of staff. To our coaching group, Mick, Jason, Trav, Trent, Damian, Jason and Marcus, your support, commitment and genuine investment in supporting myself and this group was so rewarding to see.

Lastly, to such a special playing group, for our 108 sessions at Altone Park, we achieved so much more than the wins and losses this year with the development and growth that we saw in each individual as a person and people throughout the year; this allowed us to have such a great time with each other. I see a bright future for all those going on to senior football and to those staying on in the colts, some great standards to set and follow.

Special mentions to all our award winners: State 18s (Ginbey – WA MVP and All-Australian, Busslinger – All Australian and Baker), State 16s representatives (Xavier Walsh, William Akec and Tyler Lindberg) and WAFL Colts Team of the Year representatives (Darcy Miller, Xavier Milner and Mitch Williams), plus Hec Stempel Medallist Darcy Miller on being invited to the Jack Clarke Medal for his superb year.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

New or amended Accounting Standards and Interpretations adopted

East Perth Football Club Inc. has adopted all of the new or amended Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') that are mandatory for the current reporting period and effective for an accounting period that begins on or after 1 July 2021. Any new revised or amended accounting standards or interpretations that are not set mandatory have not been early adopted.

The adoption of these Accounting Standards and Interpretations did not have any significant impact to the financial performance or position of the Association.

Basis of preparation

These general-purpose financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards - Simplified Disclosure Requirements and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB'), the Associations Incorporation Act 2015 (WA) and associated regulations, as appropriate for not-for-profit oriented entities.

Historical cost convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Critical accounting estimates

The preparation of the financial statements requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise its judgement in the process of applying East Perth Football Club Inc's accounting policies. The areas involving a higher degree of judgement or complexity, or areas where assumptions and estimates are significant to the financial statements, are disclosed in note 2.

Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised at an amount that reflects the consideration to which the association is expected to be entitled in exchange for transferring goods or services to a customer. For each contract with a customer, the association: identifies the contract with a customer; identifies the performance obligations in the contract; determines the transaction price which takes into account estimates of variable consideration and the time value of money; allocates the transaction price to the separate performance obligations on the basis of the relative stand-alone selling price of each distinct good or service to be delivered; and recognises revenue when or as each performance obligation is satisfied in a manner that depicts the transfer to the customer of the goods or services promised.

Variable consideration with the transaction price, if any, reflects concessions provided to the customers such as discounts, rebates and refunds, any potential bonuses receivable from the customer and any other contingent events. Such estimates are determined using either the 'expected value' or 'most likely amount' method. The measurement of the variable consideration is subject to a constraining principle whereby revenue will only be recognised to the extent that it is highly probable that a significant reversal in the amount of cumulative revenue recognised will not occur. The measurement constraint continues until the uncertainty associated with the variable consideration is subsequently resolved. Amounts received that are subject to the constraining principle are recognised as a refund liability.

Sales revenue

Events, fundraising and raffles are recognised when received or receivable.

Donations

Donations are recognised at the time the pledge is made.

Grants

Grants are recognised at their fair value where there is a reasonable assurance that the grant will be received, and all attached conditions will be complied with.

Interest

Interest revenue is recognised as interest accrues using the effective interest method. This is a method of calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating the interest income over the relevant period using the effective interest rate, which is the rate that exactly discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to the net carrying amount of the financial assets.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Other revenue

Other revenue is recognised when it is received or when the right to receive payment is established.

Borrowing Costs

Borrowing costs are recognised as an expense when incurred.

Leases

The determination of whether an arrangement is or contains a lease is based on the substance of the arrangement and requires an assessment of whether the fulfilment of the arrangement is dependent on the use of a specific asset or assets and the arrangement conveys a right to use the asset.

(i) Club as a lessee

Finance leases, which transfer to the club substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to ownership of the leased item, are recognised at the inception of the lease at the fair value of the leased property or, if lower, at the present value of the minimum lease payments. Lease payments are apportioned between the finance charges and reduction of the lease liability so as to achieve a constant rate of interest on the remaining balance of the liability. Finance charges are recognised as an expense in profit or loss. Capitalised leased assets are depreciated over the shorter of the estimated useful life of the asset and the lease term if there is no reasonable certainty that the Club will obtain ownership by the end of the lease term.

Operating lease payments associated with short-term leases and leases of low-value assets are recognised on a straight-line basis as an expense in profit or loss. Short term leases are leases with a lease term of 12 months or less. Low-value assets comprise of office equipment.

Current and non-current classification

Assets and liabilities are presented in the statement of financial position based on current and non-current classification.

An asset is classified as current when: it is either expected to be realised or intended to be sold or consumed in East Perth Football Club Inc's normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is expected to be realised within 12 months after the reporting period; or the asset is cash or cash equivalent unless restricted from being exchanged or used to settle a liability for at least 12 months after the reporting period. All other assets are classified as non-current.

A liability is classified as current when: it is either expected to be settled in the East Perth Football Club Inc's normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is due to be settled within 12 months after the reporting period; or there is no unconditional right to defer the settlement of the liability for at least 12 months after the reporting period. All other liabilities are classified as non-current.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

Trade and other receivables

Other receivables are recognised at amortised cost, less any provision for impairment.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Inventories are accounted for at purchase cost on a first in first out basis.

Investments and other financial assets

Investments and Financial assets in the scope of AASB 139 *Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement* are classified as either financial assets at fair value through profit or loss, available for sale investments or loans and receivables. When financial assets are recognised initially, they are measured at fair value. The Club determines the classification of its financial assets at initial recognition.

(i) Classification of financial instruments

The Association classifies its financial assets into the following measurement categories:

- those to be measured at fair value (either through other comprehensive income, or through profit or loss); and
- those to be measured at amortised cost.

The classification depends on the Association's business model for managing financial assets and the contractual terms of the financial assets' cash flows.

The Association classifies its financial liabilities at amortised cost unless it has designated liabilities at fair value through profit or loss or is required to measure liabilities at fair value through profit or loss such as derivative liabilities.

(ii) Financial assets measured at amortised cost

Debt instruments

Investments in debt instruments are measured at amortised cost where they have:

- contractual terms that give rise to cash flows on specified dates, that represent solely payments of principal and interest on the principal amount outstanding; and
- are held within a business model whose objective is achieved by holding to collect contractual cash flows.

These debt instruments are initially recognised at fair value plus directly attributable transaction costs and subsequently measured at amortised cost. The measurement of credit impairment is based on the three-stage expected credit loss model described below in note (c) Impairment of financial assets.

(a) Financial assets measured at fair value through other comprehensive income

Equity instruments

Investment in equity instruments that are neither held for trading nor contingent consideration recognised by the Association in a business combination to which AASB 3 "Business Combination" applies, are measured at fair value through other comprehensive income, where an irrevocable election has been made by management.

Amounts presented in other comprehensive income are not subsequently transferred to profit or loss. Dividends on such investments are recognised in profit or loss unless the dividend clearly represents a recovery of part of the cost of the investment.

(b) Items at fair value through profit or loss Items at fair value through profit or loss comprise:

- items held for trading;
- items specifically designated as fair value through profit or loss on initial recognition; and
- debt instruments with contractual terms that do not represent solely payments of principal and interest.

Financial instruments held at fair value through profit or loss are initially recognised at fair value, with transaction costs recognised in the income statement as incurred. Subsequently, they are measured at fair value and any gains or losses are recognised in the income statement as they arise.

Where a financial asset is measured at fair value, a credit valuation adjustment is included to reflect the credit worthiness of the counterparty, representing the movement in fair value attributable to changes in credit risk.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Investments and other financial assets (continued)

Financial instruments held for trading

A financial instrument is classified as held for trading if it is acquired or incurred principally for the purpose of selling or repurchasing in the near term, or forms part of a portfolio of financial instruments that are managed together and for which there is evidence of short-term profit taking, or it is a derivative not in a qualifying hedge relationship.

Financial instruments designated as measured at fair value through profit or loss

Upon initial recognition, financial instruments may be designated as measured at fair value through profit or loss. A financial asset may only be designated at fair value through profit or loss if doing so eliminates or significantly reduces measurement or recognition inconsistencies (i.e. eliminates an accounting mismatch) that would otherwise arise from measuring financial assets or liabilities on a different basis.

A financial liability may be designated at fair value through profit or loss if it eliminates or significantly reduces an accounting mismatch or:

- if a host contract contains one or more embedded derivatives; or
- if financial assets and liabilities are both managed and their performance evaluated on a fair value basis in accordance with a documented risk management or investment strategy.

Where a financial liability is designated at fair value through profit or loss, the movement in fair value attributable to changes in the Association's own credit quality is calculated by determining the changes in credit spreads above observable market interest rates and is presented separately in other comprehensive income.

(c) Impairment of financial assets

The Association applies a three-stage approach to measuring expected credit losses (ECLs) for the following categories of financial assets that are not measured at fair value through profit or loss:

- debt instruments measured at amortised cost and fair value through other comprehensive income;
- loan commitments; and
- financial guarantee contracts.

No ECL is recognised on equity investments.

Determining the stage for impairment

At each reporting date, the Association assesses whether there has been a significant increase in credit risk for exposures since initial recognition by comparing the risk of default occurring over the remaining expected life from the reporting date and the date of initial recognition. The Association considers reasonable and supportable information that is relevant and available without undue cost or effort for this purpose. This includes quantitative and qualitative information and also, forward-looking analysis.

An exposure will migrate through the ECL stages as asset quality deteriorates. If, in a subsequent period, asset quality improves and also reverses any previously assessed significant increase in credit risk since origination, then the provision for doubtful debts reverts from lifetime ECL to 12-months ECL. Exposures that have not deteriorated significantly since origination are considered to have a low credit risk. The provision for doubtful debts for these financial assets is based on a 12-months ECL. When an asset is uncollectible, it is written off against the related provision. Such assets are written off after all the necessary procedures have been completed and the amount of the loss has been determined. Subsequent recoveries of amounts previously written off reduce the amount of the expense in the income statement.

The Association assesses whether the credit risk on an exposure has increased significantly on an individual or collective basis. For the purposes of a collective evaluation of impairment, financial instruments are grouped on the basis of shared credit risk characteristics, taking into account instrument type, credit risk ratings, date of initial recognition, remaining term to maturity, industry, geographical location of the borrower and other relevant factors.

(d) Recognition and derecognition of financial instruments

A financial asset or financial liability is recognised in the balance sheet when the Association becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the instrument, which is generally on trade date. Loans and receivables are recognised when cash is advanced (or settled) to the borrowers.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Investments and other financial assets (continued)

Financial assets at fair value through profit or loss are recognised initially at fair value. All other financial assets are recognised initially at fair value plus directly attributable transaction costs.

The Association derecognises a financial asset when the contractual cash flows from the asset expire or it transfers its rights to receive contractual cash flows from the financial asset in a transaction in which substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership are transferred. Any interest in transferred financial assets that is created or retained by the Association is recognised as a separate asset or liability.

A financial liability is derecognised from the balance sheet when the Association has discharged its obligation or the contract is cancelled or expires.

(e) Offsetting

Financial assets and liabilities are offset and the net amount is presented in the balance sheet when the Association has a legal right to offset the amounts and intends to settle on a net basis or to realise the asset and settle the liability simultaneously.

Property, plant and equipment

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Depreciation is calculated on a straight-line basis to write off the net cost of each item of property, plant and equipment (excluding land) over their expected useful lives as follows:

Office equipment	3-10 years

The residual values, useful lives and depreciation methods are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each reporting date.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognised upon disposal or when there is no future economic benefit to the East Perth Football Club Inc. Gains and losses between the carrying amount and the disposal proceeds are taken to profit or loss.

Impairment of non-financial assets

Non-financial assets are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount.

Recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value-in-use. The value-in-use is the present value of the estimated future cash flows relating to the asset using a pre-tax discount rate specific to the asset or cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs. Assets that do not have independent cash flows are grouped together to form a cash-generating unit.

Interest-bearing loans and borrowings

All loans and borrowings are initially recognised at the fair value of the consideration received less and directly attributable transaction costs.

After initial recognition, interest-bearing loans and borrowings are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the liabilities are derecognised.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Trade and other payables

These amounts represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the East Perth Football Club Inc prior to the end of the financial year and which are unpaid. Due to their short-term nature they are measured at amortised cost and are not discounted. The amounts are unsecured and are usually paid within 30 days of recognition.

Employee benefits

Short-term employee benefits

Liabilities for wages and salaries, including non-monetary benefits, annual leave and long service leave expected to be settled wholly within 12 months of the reporting date are measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liabilities are settled.

Other long-term employee benefits

The liability for annual leave and long service leave not expected to be settled within 12 months of the reporting date are measured at the present value of expected future payments to be made in respect of services provided by employees up to the reporting date using the projected unit credit method. Consideration is given to expected future wage and salary levels, experience of employee departures and periods of service. Expected future payments are discounted using market yields at the reporting date on national government bonds with terms to maturity and currency that match, as closely as possible, the estimated future cash outflows.

Defined contribution superannuation expense

Contributions to defined contribution superannuation plans are expensed in the period in which they are incurred.

Fair value measurement

When an asset or liability, financial or non-financial, is measured at fair value for recognition or disclosure purposes, the fair value is based on the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date; and assumes that the transaction will take place either: in the principal market; or in the absence of a principal market, in the most advantageous market.

Fair value is measured using the assumptions that market participants would use when pricing the asset or liability, assuming they act in their economic best interests. For non-financial assets, the fair value measurement is based on its highest and best use. Valuation techniques that are appropriate in the circumstances and for which sufficient data are available to measure fair value, are used, maximising the use of relevant observable inputs and minimising the use of unobservable inputs.

Goods and Services Tax ('GST') and other similar taxes

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of associated GST, unless the GST incurred is not recoverable from the tax authority. In this case it is recognised as part of the cost of the acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense.

Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the tax authority is included in other receivables or other payables in the statement of financial position.

Cash flows are presented on a gross basis. The GST components of cash flows arising from investing or financing activities which are recoverable from, or payable to the tax authority, are presented as operating cash flows.

Commitments and contingencies are disclosed net of the amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the tax authority.

Comparative Figures

When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current year.

Going Concern

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis which contemplates the continuity of normal business activities and the realisation of assets and the settlement of liabilities in the ordinary course of business.

Note 2. Critical accounting judgements, estimates and assumptions

The preparation of the financial statements requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts in the financial statements. Management continually evaluates its judgements and estimates in relation to assets, liabilities, contingent liabilities, revenue and expenses. Management bases its judgements, estimates and assumptions on historical experience and on other various factors, including expectations of future events, management believes to be reasonable under the circumstances. The resulting accounting judgements and estimates will seldom equal the related actual results. The judgements, estimates and assumptions that have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities (refer to the respective notes) within the next financial year are discussed below.

Estimation of useful lives of assets

East Perth Football Club Inc determines the estimated useful lives and related depreciation and amortisation charges for its property, plant and equipment. The depreciation and amortisation charge will increase where the useful lives are less than previously estimated lives, or technically obsolete or non-strategic assets that have been abandoned or sold will be written off or written down.

Impairment of non-financial assets other than goodwill and other indefinite life intangible assets

East Perth Football Club Inc assesses impairment of non-financial assets other than goodwill and other indefinite life intangible assets at each reporting date by evaluating conditions specific to East Perth Football Club Inc and to the particular asset that may lead to impairment. If an impairment trigger exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is determined. This involves fair value less costs of disposal or value-in-use calculations, which incorporate a number of key estimates and assumptions.
