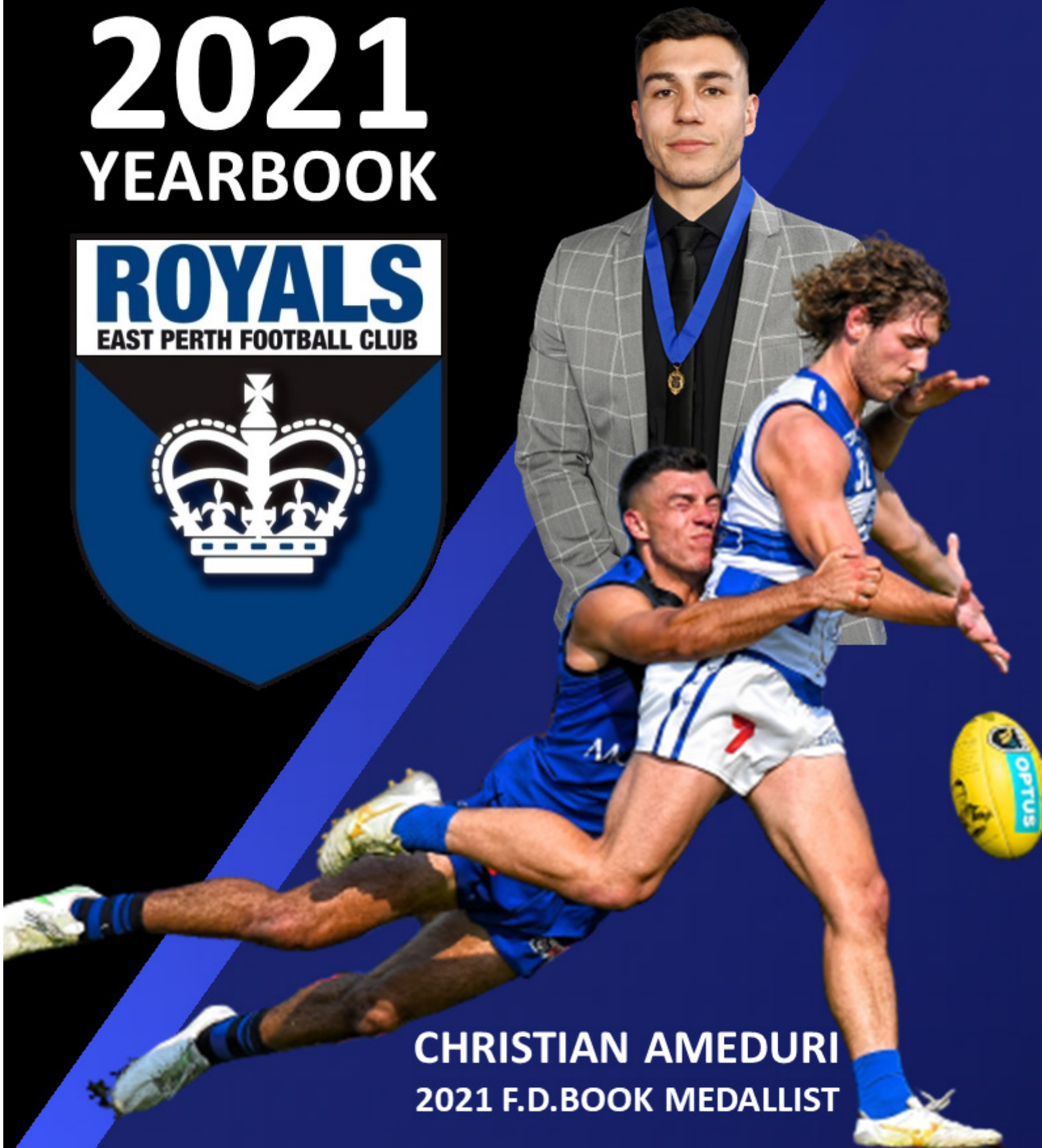

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2021 was a season where we all faced continuing challenges and uncertainty. As a Club, we discussed how 2021 would be another difficult year with unclear playing schedules and financial income caused by COVID.

It was a year of frustration being born from the tireless efforts of everyone at the Club without gaining the on-field success we had set.



After just missing the finals in the League and winning the Reserves Premiership in 2020 we set our goals for 2021 accordingly but unfortunately, we found too much inconsistency in our performance with serious injuries to key players including our Captain and FD Book Medallist Jackson Ramsay who struggled to complete 8 games for the season. At the end of the season the Club conducted a complete review of our Football Department concentrating on our on-and-off field performances, which included commitment, attitude, culture and playing strength.

The results showed the areas that the Club needed to improve on if we were to be successful in 2022. We have endeavoured to address all of these points starting with the re appointment of our Head Coach Jeremy Barnard supported by the new appointment of Tony Micale as Director of Coaching.

On a much brighter note our Colts show the true Royal attitude with a very talented group of young men who made the finals and represented the Club with pride although not going on to win. We congratulate Jye Amiss and James Tunstill who have been rewarded for their talent by being picked up in the AFL Draft and we are confident that we will see some of the other boys graduating to League ranks next year.

Our Rogers Cup Team, as with our Senior Men, had a difficult season as we continued to grow and develop depth in our quest to fielding a Women's Team in the next few season. We will continue to stay focussed and are planning several initiatives to grow female football within our metro and regional zones and I look forward with enthusiasm at what we will achieve in the coming years.

Together, I emphasise together, we can lift this proud Club up and restore it as a powerhouse of the WAFL competition.

We are fortunate at East Perth to have such a wonderful collective of sponsors who continue to assist us in our pursuit of success, both on and off the field. I thank you all for your continued partnerships

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORT

We have a wonderful Club. The true measure of the Club does not happen when everything is going well, but when the chips are down, forcing the Club to look itself in the mirror and meet any hurdles head on.

2021 presented us with such challenges. For various reasons, the season did not start well, and we were always behind the eight-ball trying to catch up. This was a tough sentiment to shake and one that lingered throughout the season.

We are a Club that demands and deserves success, so when this want goes unfilled there is a sense of despair throughout our passionate members, players and staff.

We undertook a comprehensive review of the Football Department as well as our off-field support networks. I am pleased to say that whilst this was confronting and uncomfortable at times, we have come out of that review a much better Club.

Through better process and structure throughout the Club, we are all in a better position to support the players, Jeremy and the Football Department to fulfill their potential.

One key point that was clear throughout this review process was that it is not doom and gloom. There are many exciting developments happening in and around the Club, that if nurtured properly, will catapult this Club back to be a powerhouse of WA football.

This year we competed in the Inaugural WA Wheelchair Football League in which we won the inaugural Premiership. I would like to congratulate this team and the support staff efforts to get this competition off the ground.

Our Rogers Cup side had a difficult season; however, the Club has increased the level of resource for our women's football program, which has already significantly increased the number of youth girls engaged with our Talent Program. This resource aims to grow female participation within our metro and country zones, provide a pathway for female coaches and administrators, help our community clubs continue to flourish and ultimately lead us to being able to field a WAFLW League side in the near future.

Off-field we achieved a tremendous result, turning a budgeted small loss into a profit of \$139,449. We must keep in mind that late in 2020 we were still entitled to receive some JobKeeper payments and received an unbudgeted windfall from the WAFC through our monthly distributions. Having Talent return under the Clubs umbrella (as we have always wanted) has resulted in an increase of funding to the Club, but also a correlating increase in expenses.

This combined with a near enough full year of earnings resulted in the Club returning to \$2,000,000 business. A business this size relies on a lot of people to ensure it works efficiently and effectively.

LEAGUE COACH REPORT

The 2021 season presented itself with many challenges and can be classified as a series of valleys and peaks. We played inconsistent football throughout the season. Due to significant injuries to key senior players, we rarely had our best team available throughout the season. The upside to this was we were able to give our younger talented players an opportunity at League level earlier than anticipated, which will hold the club in good stead in our strategy of sustainable success.

However, although it was a challenging year, we as a League team were able to show our character and abilities to defeat both eventual preliminary finalists. At this particular time the football staff and players could have decided that the season was lost and given up for the year. Once again this is not 'The Royals Way'. We pulled together, starting with an 9-goal win against West Coast then going on to win six of the next eight games.

Unfortunately, as was the theme for the year, we were not consistent across four quarters to win the remaining games, despite being in contention for fifth spot for much of the season.

As I'm sure the players and coaches alike would attest to, this has given us great drive and determination to be in the 2022 finals.

However, we do know that confidence alone is not enough. The Football department is working hard in all areas, in our pursuit of continuous improvement, and will continue to dedicate ourselves to the cause.

COLTS COACH REPORT

Firstly, I would like to thank the East Perth Football Club for the opportunity to coach the Colts again this year. The support from Dean Turner, Warren Parker and new Talent Manager, Aaron Ballantyne, has allowed myself and our staff to continue to develop the Colts program to attempt to reach new heights operating within such a supportive and professional environment is greatly appreciated.

It was a rollercoaster of a year within the Colts program as we started out in late October with a clear plan in place to build the strength and conditioning component of the overall playing group during the off-season period. This allowed us to kickstart our pre-season phase at Altona in early January, with the squad in strong physical condition to begin improving our football craft.

In preparation for the 2021 season, it was evident we had several top-aged players who had significant experience from the previous year to draw upon Combined with an exciting bottom aged cohort, expectations within the playing group were high. Our Colts squad was led tremendously this year by captain Jake Littleton and his vice-captains, Tom Druzianich Ethan Regan, James Tunstill and Riley May.

We continued our strong focus of developing the fundamentals of the game and building our layers of ball movement and team defence as the pre-season unfolded, with high standards and building our connection to each other at every opportunity present. With our pre-season camp held in early February at Margaret River, it was a great opportunity to recognise the ever-growing strength of our Country region and build our connection with our metro-based players along with our country-based players.

Our regular season began with some impressive team performances, as our ability to bring our intensity at the contest and utilise our strengths with and without the ball came to the fore consistently and led to us entrenching ourselves in the top handful of teams. Due to the strength of our start to the season and the growth within our playing squad over several years in our development pathway, we had six players (Jye Amis, Kade Dittmar, Ethan Regan, James Tunstill, Kaden Harbour and Oscar Armstrong) named in the State 19s Program, along with our four State 17s representatives (Jedd Busslinger, Mitch Williams, Adam Di Masi and Jordyn Baker). This, along with a growing PSA contingent, facilitated the fast-tracking of a host of players within our squad to be given the opportunity to play WAFL Colts football as result.

Whilst our depth was showcased, the ability of the wider playing group to continually buy in to the team, style and collective to bring their best at every opportunity allowed us to continue with our strong form. This period produced some of our proudest moments as a coaching group. With 47 players used across the season, the experience that several bottom-aged and Futures players gathered will undoubtedly whet the appetite heading into 2022 as they will be expected to become the leaders of our squad.

After playing some scintillating football in the front half of the year, the back half of the year led to us falling short against some of the other top teams as we headed into our finals campaign. Whilst belief was still high within the group, we recognised we needed to execute more consistently against the best. We finished in third position and with a double chance earned, we gave ourselves a

great opportunity to go deep into September.

Whilst our effort never wilted throughout, we unfortunately couldn't execute in the crucial moments against Claremont and lost after a tight tussle for two and half quarters to then fell away. With East Fremantle at home in a Semi-Final next up, we gave ourselves the opportunity with a ferocious first 30 minutes of elite pressure and territory domination but couldn't put the gap on the scoreboard needed when the momentum was in our hands. As the goal for goal arm-wrestle continued in the second half, we couldn't hold on as Easts kept coming and our season disappointingly came to an end, losing by 17 points.

In summary, our year was undoubtedly a successful one although without getting the ultimate prize. The squad's ability to adapt to the various amount of change and roll with the season's punches was a testament to the overall character and belief within the group. Congratulations to all our award winners; you are thoroughly deserving of your success and recognition.

I would like to thank our Coaching staff, for your time, investment, and commitment into supporting myself, the players, and the program overall. We welcomed Trent Davies into our staff this year and his wisdom and energy was present throughout along with our other coaches in Jason Thompson (Bench Coach), Hayden Copley (Defenders), Michael Gladwell (Midfield) and Damian Shannon (Forwards). The commitment of these people helps form what the program is with their expertise and care consistently shown.

To the Strength and Conditioning and Medical teams, led by Reynton Laird and Emma Boyes and their staff, thank you for your efforts this year. your professionalism and care for our players was of a fantastic standard and gave us the best chance to continue to deliver the program at an elite level throughout.

To Nick Di Campli – the program isn't what it is without this person. Your commitment, dedication and organisation with the staff, players and club is unparalleled. The work you do behind the scenes to ensure these players are a part of an elite, structured environment is top draw. Certainly, the glue that holds us all together.

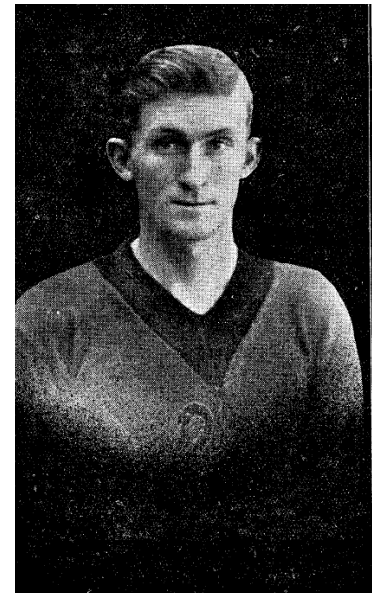
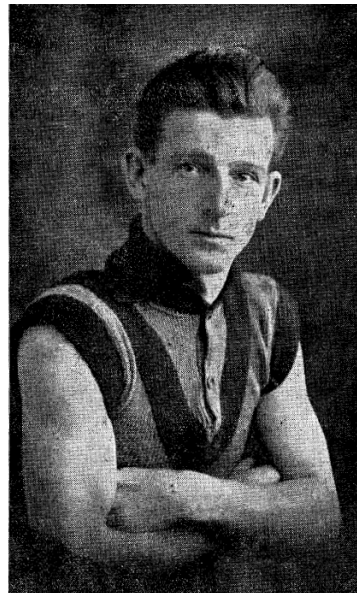

Note 1. Significant accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all the years presented, unless otherwise stated.

New or amended Accounting Standards and Interpretations adopted

East Perth Football Club Inc. has adopted all of the new or amended Accounting Standards and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB') that are mandatory for the current reporting period and effective for an accounting period that begins on or after 1 July 2020. Any new revised or amended accounting standards or interpretations that are not set mandatory have not been early adopted.

The adoption of these Accounting Standards and Interpretations did not have any significant impact to the financial performance or position of the Association.

Basis of preparation

These general purpose financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Australian Accounting Standards - Reduced Disclosure Requirements and Interpretations issued by the Australian Accounting Standards Board ('AASB'), the Associations Incorporation Act 2015 (WA) and associated regulations, as appropriate for not-for-profit oriented entities.

Historical cost convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Critical accounting estimates

The preparation of the financial statements requires the use of certain critical accounting estimates. It also requires management to exercise its judgement in the process of applying East Perth Football Club Inc's accounting policies. The areas involving a higher degree of judgement or complexity, or areas where assumptions and estimates are significant to the financial statements, are disclosed in note 2.

Revenue recognition

Revenue is recognised at an amount that reflects the consideration to which the association is expected to be entitled in exchange for transferring goods or services to a customer. For each contract with a customer, the association: identifies the contract with a customer; identifies the performance obligations in the contract; determines the transaction price which takes into account estimates of variable consideration and the time value of money; allocates the transaction price to the separate performance obligations on the basis of the relative stand-alone selling price of each distinct good or service to be delivered; and recognises revenue when or as each performance obligation is satisfied in a manner that depicts the transfer to the customer of the goods or services promised.

Variable consideration with the transaction price, if any, reflects concessions provided to the customers such as discounts, rebates and refunds, any potential bonuses receivable from the customer and any other contingent events. Such estimates are determined using either the 'expected value' or 'most likely amount' method. The measurement of the variable consideration is subject to a constraining principle whereby revenue will only be recognised to the extent that it is highly probable that a significant reversal in the amount of cumulative revenue recognised will not occur. The measurement constraint continues until the uncertainty associated with the variable consideration is subsequently resolved. Amounts received that are subject to the constraining principle are recognised as a refund liability.

Sales revenue

Events, fundraising and raffles are recognised when received or receivable.

Donations

Donations are recognised at the time the pledge is made.

Grants

Grants are recognised at their fair value where there is a reasonable assurance that the grant will be received and all attached conditions will be complied with.

Interest

Interest revenue is recognised as interest accrues using the effective interest method. This is a method of calculating the amortised cost of a financial asset and allocating the interest income over the relevant period using the effective interest rate, which is the rate that exactly discounts estimated future cash receipts through the expected life of the financial asset to the net carrying amount of the financial assets.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Other revenue

Other revenue is recognised when it is received or when the right to receive payment is established.

Borrowing Costs

Borrowing costs are recognised as an expense when incurred.

Leases

The determination of whether an arrangement is or contains a lease is based on the substance of the arrangement and requires an assessment of whether the fulfilment of the arrangement is dependent on the use of a specific asset or assets and the arrangement conveys a right to use the asset.

(i) Club as a lessee

Finance leases, which transfer to the club substantially all the risks and benefits incidental to ownership of the leased item, are recognised at the inception of the lease at the fair value of the leased property or, if lower, at the present value of the minimum lease payments. Lease payments are apportioned between the finance charges and reduction of the lease liability so as to achieve a constant rate of interest on the remaining balance of the liability. Finance charges are recognised as an expense in profit or loss. Capitalised leased assets are depreciated over the shorter of the estimated useful life of the asset and the lease term if there is no reasonable certainty that the Club will obtain ownership by the end of the lease term.

Operating lease payments associated with short-term leases and leases of low-value assets are recognised on a straight-line basis as an expense in profit or loss. Short term leases are leases with a lease term of 12 months or less. Low-value assets comprise of office equipment.

Current and non-current classification

Assets and liabilities are presented in the statement of financial position based on current and non-current classification.

An asset is classified as current when: it is either expected to be realised or intended to be sold or consumed in East Perth Football Club Inc's normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is expected to be realised within 12 months after the reporting period; or the asset is cash or cash equivalent unless restricted from being exchanged or used to settle a liability for at least 12 months after the reporting period. All other assets are classified as non-current.

A liability is classified as current when: it is either expected to be settled in the East Perth Football Club Inc's normal operating cycle; it is held primarily for the purpose of trading; it is due to be settled within 12 months after the reporting period; or there is no unconditional right to defer the settlement of the liability for at least 12 months after the reporting period. All other liabilities are classified as non-current.

Cash and cash equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand, deposits held at call with financial institutions, other short-term, highly liquid investments with original maturities of three months or less that are readily convertible to known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

Trade and other receivables

Other receivables are recognised at amortised cost, less any provision for impairment.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Inventories are accounted for at purchase cost on a first in first out basis.

Investments and other financial assets

Investments and Financial assets in the scope of AASB 139 *Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement* are classified as either financial assets at fair value through profit or loss, available for sale investments or loans and receivables. When financial assets are recognised initially, they are measured at fair value. The Club determines the classification of its financial assets at initial recognition.

(i) Classification of financial instruments

The Association classifies its financial assets into the following measurement categories:

- those to be measured at fair value (either through other comprehensive income, or through profit or loss); and
- those to be measured at amortised cost.

The classification depends on the Association's business model for managing financial assets and the contractual terms of the financial assets' cash flows.

The Association classifies its financial liabilities at amortised cost unless it has designated liabilities at fair value through profit or loss or is required to measure liabilities at fair value through profit or loss such as derivative liabilities.

(ii) Financial assets measured at amortised cost

Debt instruments

Investments in debt instruments are measured at amortised cost where they have:

- contractual terms that give rise to cash flows on specified dates, that represent solely payments of principal and interest on the principal amount outstanding; and
- are held within a business model whose objective is achieved by holding to collect contractual cash flows.

These debt instruments are initially recognised at fair value plus directly attributable transaction costs and subsequently measured at amortised cost. The measurement of credit impairment is based on the three-stage expected credit loss model described below in note (c) Impairment of financial assets.

(a) Financial assets measured at fair value through other comprehensive income

Equity instruments

Investment in equity instruments that are neither held for trading nor contingent consideration recognised by the Association in a business combination to which AASB 3 "Business Combination" applies, are measured at fair value through other comprehensive income, where an irrevocable election has been made by management.

Amounts presented in other comprehensive income are not subsequently transferred to profit or loss. Dividends on such investments are recognised in profit or loss unless the dividend clearly represents a recovery of part of the cost of the investment.

(b) Items at fair value through profit or loss Items at fair value through profit or loss comprise:

- items held for trading;
- items specifically designated as fair value through profit or loss on initial recognition; and
- debt instruments with contractual terms that do not represent solely payments of principal and interest.

Financial instruments held at fair value through profit or loss are initially recognised at fair value, with transaction costs recognised in the income statement as incurred. Subsequently, they are measured at fair value and any gains or losses are recognised in the income statement as they arise.

Where a financial asset is measured at fair value, a credit valuation adjustment is included to reflect the credit worthiness of the counterparty, representing the movement in fair value attributable to changes in credit risk.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Investments and other financial assets (continued)

Financial instruments held for trading

A financial instrument is classified as held for trading if it is acquired or incurred principally for the purpose of selling or repurchasing in the near term, or forms part of a portfolio of financial instruments that are managed together and for which there is evidence of short-term profit taking, or it is a derivative not in a qualifying hedge relationship.

Financial instruments designated as measured at fair value through profit or loss

Upon initial recognition, financial instruments may be designated as measured at fair value through profit or loss. A financial asset may only be designated at fair value through profit or loss if doing so eliminates or significantly reduces measurement or recognition inconsistencies (i.e. eliminates an accounting mismatch) that would otherwise arise from measuring financial assets or liabilities on a different basis.

A financial liability may be designated at fair value through profit or loss if it eliminates or significantly reduces an accounting mismatch or:

- if a host contract contains one or more embedded derivatives; or
- if financial assets and liabilities are both managed and their performance evaluated on a fair value basis in accordance with a documented risk management or investment strategy.

Where a financial liability is designated at fair value through profit or loss, the movement in fair value attributable to changes in the Association's own credit quality is calculated by determining the changes in credit spreads above observable market interest rates and is presented separately in other comprehensive income.

(c) Impairment of financial assets

The Association applies a three-stage approach to measuring expected credit losses (ECLs) for the following categories of financial assets that are not measured at fair value through profit or loss:

- debt instruments measured at amortised cost and fair value through other comprehensive income;
- loan commitments; and
- financial guarantee contracts.

No ECL is recognised on equity investments.

Determining the stage for impairment

At each reporting date, the Association assesses whether there has been a significant increase in credit risk for exposures since initial recognition by comparing the risk of default occurring over the remaining expected life from the reporting date and the date of initial recognition. The Association considers reasonable and supportable information that is relevant and available without undue cost or effort for this purpose. This includes quantitative and qualitative information and also, forward-looking analysis.

An exposure will migrate through the ECL stages as asset quality deteriorates. If, in a subsequent period, asset quality improves and also reverses any previously assessed significant increase in credit risk since origination, then the provision for doubtful debts reverts from lifetime ECL to 12-months ECL. Exposures that have not deteriorated significantly since origination are considered to have a low credit risk. The provision for doubtful debts for these financial assets is based on a 12-months ECL. When an asset is uncollectible, it is written off against the related provision. Such assets are written off after all the necessary procedures have been completed and the amount of the loss has been determined. Subsequent recoveries of amounts previously written off reduce the amount of the expense in the income statement.

The Association assesses whether the credit risk on an exposure has increased significantly on an individual or collective basis. For the purposes of a collective evaluation of impairment, financial instruments are grouped on the basis of shared credit risk characteristics, taking into account instrument type, credit risk ratings, date of initial recognition, remaining term to maturity, industry, geographical location of the borrower and other relevant factors.

(d) Recognition and derecognition of financial instruments

A financial asset or financial liability is recognised in the balance sheet when the Association becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the instrument, which is generally on trade date. Loans and receivables are recognised when cash is advanced (or settled) to the borrowers.

Investments and other financial assets (continued)

Financial assets at fair value through profit or loss are recognised initially at fair value. All other financial assets are recognised initially at fair value plus directly attributable transaction costs.

The Association derecognises a financial asset when the contractual cash flows from the asset expire or it transfers its rights to receive contractual cash flows from the financial asset in a transaction in which substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership are transferred. Any interest in transferred financial assets that is created or retained by the Association is recognised as a separate asset or liability.

A financial liability is derecognised from the balance sheet when the Association has discharged its obligation or the contract is cancelled or expires.

(e) Offsetting

Financial assets and liabilities are offset and the net amount is presented in the balance sheet when the Association has a legal right to offset the amounts and intends to settle on a net basis or to realise the asset and settle the liability simultaneously.

Property, plant and equipment

Plant and equipment is stated at historical cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment. Historical cost includes expenditure that is directly attributable to the acquisition of the items.

Depreciation is calculated on a straight-line basis to write off the net cost of each item of property, plant and equipment (excluding land) over their expected useful lives as follows:

Office equipment	3-10 years

The residual values, useful lives and depreciation methods are reviewed, and adjusted if appropriate, at each reporting date.

An item of property, plant and equipment is derecognised upon disposal or when there is no future economic benefit to the East Perth Football Club Inc. Gains and losses between the carrying amount and the disposal proceeds are taken to profit or loss.

Impairment of non-financial assets

Non-financial assets are reviewed for impairment whenever events or changes in circumstances indicate that the carrying amount may not be recoverable. An impairment loss is recognised for the amount by which the asset's carrying amount exceeds its recoverable amount.

Recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's fair value less costs of disposal and value-in-use. The value-in-use is the present value of the estimated future cash flows relating to the asset using a pre-tax discount rate specific to the asset or cash-generating unit to which the asset belongs. Assets that do not have independent cash flows are grouped together to form a cash-generating unit.

Interest-bearing loans and borrowings

All loans and borrowings are initially recognised at the fair value of the consideration received less and directly attributable transaction costs.

After initial recognition, interest-bearing loans and borrowings are subsequently measured at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

Gains and losses are recognised in profit or loss when the liabilities are derecognised.

Note 1. Significant accounting policies (continued)

Trade and other payables

These amounts represent liabilities for goods and services provided to the East Perth Football Club Inc prior to the end of the financial year and which are unpaid. Due to their short-term nature they are measured at amortised cost and are not discounted. The amounts are unsecured and are usually paid within 30 days of recognition.

Employee benefits

Short-term employee benefits

Liabilities for wages and salaries, including non-monetary benefits, annual leave and long service leave expected to be settled wholly within 12 months of the reporting date are measured at the amounts expected to be paid when the liabilities are settled.

Other long-term employee benefits

The liability for annual leave and long service leave not expected to be settled within 12 months of the reporting date are measured at the present value of expected future payments to be made in respect of services provided by employees up to the reporting date using the projected unit credit method. Consideration is given to expected future wage and salary levels, experience of employee departures and periods of service. Expected future payments are discounted using market yields at the reporting date on national government bonds with terms to maturity and currency that match, as closely as possible, the estimated future cash outflows.

Defined contribution superannuation expense

Contributions to defined contribution superannuation plans are expensed in the period in which they are incurred.

Fair value measurement

When an asset or liability, financial or non-financial, is measured at fair value for recognition or disclosure purposes, the fair value is based on the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date; and assumes that the transaction will take place either: in the principal market; or in the absence of a principal market, in the most advantageous market.

Fair value is measured using the assumptions that market participants would use when pricing the asset or liability, assuming they act in their economic best interests. For non-financial assets, the fair value measurement is based on its highest and best use. Valuation techniques that are appropriate in the circumstances and for which sufficient data are available to measure fair value, are used, maximising the use of relevant observable inputs and minimising the use of unobservable inputs.

Goods and Services Tax ('GST') and other similar taxes

Revenues, expenses and assets are recognised net of the amount of associated GST, unless the GST incurred is not recoverable from the tax authority. In this case it is recognised as part of the cost of the acquisition of the asset or as part of the expense.

Receivables and payables are stated inclusive of the amount of GST receivable or payable. The net amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the tax authority is included in other receivables or other payables in the statement of financial position.

Cash flows are presented on a gross basis. The GST components of cash flows arising from investing or financing activities which are recoverable from, or payable to the tax authority, are presented as operating cash flows.

Commitments and contingencies are disclosed net of the amount of GST recoverable from, or payable to, the tax authority.

Comparative Figures

When required by Accounting Standards, comparative figures have been adjusted to conform to changes in presentation for the current year.

Going Concern

The financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis which contemplates the continuity of normal business activities and the realisation of assets and the settlement of liabilities in the ordinary course of business.

Note 2. Critical accounting judgements, estimates and assumptions

Estimation of useful lives of assets

East Perth Football Club Inc determines the estimated useful lives and related depreciation and amortisation charges for its property, plant and equipment. The depreciation and amortisation charge will increase where the useful lives are less than previously estimated lives, or technically obsolete or non-strategic assets that have been abandoned or sold will be written off or written down.

Impairment of non-financial assets other than goodwill and other indefinite life intangible assets

East Perth Football Club Inc assesses impairment of non-financial assets other than goodwill and other indefinite life intangible assets at each reporting date by evaluating conditions specific to East Perth Football Club Inc and to the particular asset that may lead to impairment. If an impairment trigger exists, the recoverable amount of the asset is determined. This involves fair value less costs of disposal or value-in-use calculations, which incorporate a number of key estimates and assumptions.

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the accompanying financial report, of East Perth Football Club Inc. ("the Club"), which comprises the statement of financial position as at 31 October 2021, statement of changes in equity, the statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income and the statement of cash flows for the year ended on that date, notes comprising a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, and the directors' declaration.
